BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles and Yankees conclude a four-game set tonight in the Bronx...The clubs meet four times in the next 10 days, as New York travels to Camden Yards for a three-game series from May 11-13...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, having dropped two of three to the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Astros.

Following yesterday's 11-3 defeat, the Birds have suffered four straight losses by 5+ runs, tying the longest such streak in franchise history (7x, last: 6/8-11/17)...The three straight such defeats opposite New York mark the longest skid for Baltimore since a franchise-record four-game stretch from September 7-16, 2017.

Yesterday, **Trey Gibson** became the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make his first career start opposite the Yankees in New York, and the third Bird to make their MLB debut in 2026, joining **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN) and **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE).

Rico Garcia tossed a perfect inning yesterday with one strikeout...He has allowed one hit through his first 16 appearances to open the season, becoming the only pitcher in MLB since 1900 to allow one or zero hits through their first 16 appearances of the year.

Baltimore is 0-8 against left-handed starting pitching this season, the second-longest season-opening losing skid in franchise history behind the 1988 Orioles, who dropped each of their first 11 contests, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

Tonight, the Birds look to avoid their second series sweep of 2026 (4/3-5 at PIT)... Baltimore was last swept by New York to close the 2025 campaign in the Bronx (3 G, 9/26-28)...The O's have not been swept in a four-game set at the hands of the Yankees since September 11-13, 2020...Overall, Baltimore has not been swept in a four-game series since August 25-28, 2025 vs. Boston.

REMEMBERING A LEGEND: The Baltimore Orioles share their condolences with the New York Yankees on the passing of legendary broadcaster, **John Sterling**...For more than three decades, Baltimore was fortunate to have "The Voice of the Yankees" on the call for countless match-ups between the Orioles and Yankees...Our thoughts are with John's family, friends, and loved ones at this time.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Baltimore hitters own a collective .476 slugging percentage off fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the best mark in the AL and fifth-highest in MLB behind Arizona (.523), Atlanta (.514), Chicago-NL (.497), and Los Angeles-NL (.484).

The O's .301 slugging percentage on all other pitches is fifth lowest in the majors ahead of the Padres (.300), Brewers/Diamondbacks (.299), and Twins (.287).

Tonight's opposing starter, Cam Schittler, has held opponents to a .148/.187/.219 (19-for-128) line with four doubles, one triple, and one homer on his fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), compared to .300/.300/.400 (6-for-20) with two doubles off his curveball and slider.

STREAKS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN: Baltimore has dropped eight straight games at Yankee Stadium since June 21, 2025, its longest losing skid since a franchise-record 12-game losing streak from May 15 (G1), 2019-April 6, 2021...The Birds active eight-game losing streak overall to the Yankees is their longest since a team-record 19-game skid from April 4, 2019-September 4, 2020 (G1).

POLAR BEAR PETE: Pete Alonso has recorded an extra-base hit in each of his last four games, going 5-for-13 (.385) with two doubles, two home runs, five runs, three RBI, and two walks... It is the longest active streak in MLB and marks his longest such streak since another four-game stretch from September 14-18, 2025...His career-best stretch is six straight, done from September 4 (G2)-9, 2021.

Alonso has also scored a run in an MLB-best six straight games, ahead of DET's Riley Greene (5 G)...It is tied for the second-longest such streak of his career behind a seven-game run from August 16-22, 2021.

He is slashing .328/.425/.746 (22-for-67) with four doubles, eight home runs, 19 runs, 19 RBI, and 11 walks in his last 19 games opposite the Yankees since July 26, 2022.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward has reached base safely 66 times through his first 34 games with the O's (36 H, 29 BB, 1 HBP), the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (72 TOB, 1966) and **Roberto Alomar** (68 TOB, 1996)...The record through 35 games is also held by Robinson (72 TOB).

Ward's .423 on-base percentage ranks sixth in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

Ward has reached safely in 31 of the last 33 games since March 28 while slashing .298/.434/.430 (36-for-121) with 13 doubles, one homer, 19 runs scored, 12 RBI, 29 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: Rico Garcia has posted a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP) with 16 strikeouts across 16 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

His .022 (1-for-45) opponent average and 0.34 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.065, 3-for-46) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

'PEN PALS: Grant Wolfram has not allowed a home run in 32.2 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 38.1 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

The O's 15.2 percent inherited runners scored rate (7 IRS/46 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

ROAD TRIPPIN': O's hitters have posted a .624 OPS on the road, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Phillies (.623), Pirates (.622), and Royals (.611)...Their .777 OPS at home ranks ninth highest in MLB.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his seventh start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win as an Oriole on April 28 vs. Houston...Tossed 5.2 innings, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR) and one walk with a season-high-tying six strikeouts (also 4/16 at CLE)...Threw 98 pitches, 65 strikes.

⚡ Allowed one free pass after issuing multiple walks in each of his previous four outings.

⚡ Has thrown at least 98 pitches in a career-high five straight starts, surpassing his previous high of two straight (2x, last: 7/27-8/1/25)...He is the first Oriole to accomplish the feat since John Means did so in five straight starts from May 24-June 16, 2019...The last to do so in six straight was Alex Cobb, who did so in six consecutive starts from August 7-September 4, 2018.

EVIL EMPIRE: Baz is set to make his seventh career start opposite the Yankees, having gone 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (16 ER/21.1 IP) in his previous six starts.

⚡ Last faced New York as a member of Tampa Bay on August 19, 2025 at Steinbrenner Field and permitted a career-high five home runs...Threw 3.0 innings in the outing, allowing six runs on seven hits and two walks with three strikeouts.

CUTTING IT UP: Baz has held opponents to a .143/.231/.286 (5-for-35) line with two doubles, one home run, and an 17.8 percent strikeout rate off his cutter.

⚡ The .143 opponent average is the fourth lowest among any cutter in MLB (min. 30 AB ending in pitch), trailing NYY's Cam Schlichtler (.094), TB's Drew Rasmussen (.111), and MIL's Chad Patrick (.132).

⚡ The opposition has combined to slash .357/.396/.561 (35-for-98) with 14 doubles, two home runs, and a 19.8 percent strikeout rate on all his other offerings.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 15 doubles, ahead of SEA's Logan Gilbert (14) and SF's Adrian Houser (13)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his six starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 12 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted three home runs over 62.1 innings (0.43 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

LEFT SIDE STORY: Left-handed hitters are slashing .361/.424/.542 (26-for-72) with 10 doubles, one home run, and nine walks, compared to .230/.262/.426 (14-for-61) with six doubles, two home runs, and two walks by righties.

⚡ Baz's .965 opponent OPS vs. lefties is fifth-highest in MLB (min. 80 BF), ahead of SF's Adrian Houser (1.190), WSH's Zach Littel (1.130), HOU's Mike Burrows (1.016), and STL's Dustin May (.976).

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 2-for-18 (.111) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

⚡ Baz has allowed hitters to go 11-for-22 (.500) with six doubles and one home run on the first pitch of an at-bat.

⚡ Has limited opponents to a .234 (11-for-47) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 29-for-86 (.337) clip the second, third, and fourth time through.
