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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight through Toronto (1-2) and New York-NL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardians...Baltimore is 4.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (2.0 GB) also in the mix.

- 👤 **Pete Alonso** registered his 100th RBI of the year yesterday with a run-scoring single in the fifth frame...His 50 RBI on the road are second most in the AL behind CWS' Colson Montgomery (52) and rank seventh in the majors.
- 👤 The Birds struck out 15 times in yesterday's defeat...Baltimore has double-digit strikeouts in each of its last four games and in eight of its last 10 contests...The O's have 10+ strikeouts in 67 games, tied for the most such games in franchise history (since 1954) with the 2021 club (67 G)...The 67 such games are fifth most in the majors ahead of the Angels (73 G), Reds (71 G), White Sox (70 G), and Pirates (69 G).
- 👤 After going 4-for-9 with runners in scoring position on Friday, the Birds went a combined 2-for-18 on Saturday and Sunday, including 1-for-12 yesterday...Baltimore left 13 runners on base yesterday, its second-highest figure of the year behind April 7 at Chicago-AL (14 LOB).
- 👤 Oriole pitching has permitted multiple home runs in a season-high-tying four straight games, joining a four-game stretch from April 30 (G2)-May 3...The O's have not allowed 2+ homers in five straight since August 25-29, 2025.

QUEENS GAMBIT: **Pete Alonso** hit his 299th career home run Saturday...He looks to become one of 19 active players in the majors to reach 300 career home runs, led by NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (456) and LAA's Mike Trout (425).

- 👤 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Alonso can become the 20th player in MLB history to hit his 300th career home run against his former club...Andrew McCutchen was the last to accomplish the feat, homering at Philadelphia during his second stint with Pittsburgh on April 14, 2024.
- 👤 Since Citi Field opened in 2009, Alonso's 123 home runs and 350 RBI are the most at the venue by any player, outpacing NYM's Francisco Lindor (80 HR, 232 RBI).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 17 straight games, slashing .283/.358/.600 (17-for-60) with one double, six home runs, 13 runs, 13 RBI, and six walks.

- 👤 It is the second-longest on-base streak by an Oriole this season, trailing Taylor Ward's 20-game run from July 1-27.
- 👤 Mayo's .568 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is second highest in the AL (min. 100 AB) behind TB's Victor Mesa Jr. (.609).
- 👤 Since August 31, he is 6-for-23 (.261) with three home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.
- 👤 Mayo is batting .321/.384/.737 (44-for-137) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.121) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

MORE ON THE POLAR BEAR: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 100), total bases (T-3rd, 280), home runs (4th, 35), OPS (5th, .863), slugging percentage (5th, .499), extra-base hits (T-6th, 59), hits (T-6th, 151), and runs (8th, 89).

- 👤 Alonso has started all 150 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with PHI's Bryce Harper and ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- 👤 He's played in 566 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (932 G).
- 👤 Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (96) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- 👤 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 45 homers since August 9, tied for third most in MLB during that time behind the Cubs (61) and Mets (47).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 556 walks this season behind the Cubs (631 BB), Brewers (620 BB), and Dodgers (572 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 540 free passes.

- 👤 Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.
- 👤 The team's 32 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).
- 👤 The Birds are averaging 3.97 pitches per plate appearance, ranking second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.98).

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 16 games (14.0 IP) since August 6...It's the longest scoreless streak, by games, by an Oriole since **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023.

- 👤 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 48-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the second-most such games in the majors this year behind the Guardians (100 G, 52-48)...The .485 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

- 👤 Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage is 27th in the majors.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 26th start of the season and the 38th of his career...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss of the season on September 8 vs. Cleveland after allowing a season-high six earned runs on eight hits (1 HR), two walks, one hit batter, and one wild pitch with two strikeouts across a season-low-tying 3.2 innings pitched (also 5/17 at WSH)... Threw 86 pitches, 53 strikes.
⚡ Last allowed at least six earned runs on August 21, 2025 vs. Houston (7 ER).

THE BIG APPLE: Didn't factor into the decision of his lone start vs. New York-NL on July 8, 2025 at Camden Yards after allowing two runs in 5.1 innings on five hits (1 HR) and zero walks with six strikeouts in an Orioles 7-6 loss.
⚡ Threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat.

SWEET VICTORY: The Orioles are 18-7 (.720) in Young's 25 starts but have lost back-to-back games for the first time this season... According to *STATS Perform*, his 18 team wins are tied for the ninth most by an Orioles pitcher through the first 25 starts of a season in team history (since 1954) trailing leader Dave McNally (21 team wins in 1969).
⚡ Young is 9-4 (.692) in 25 starts this season...The .692 winning percentage is fifth highest in the AL (min. 15 GS) trailing leader TB's Nick Martinez (.778, 14-4).
⚡ According to *STATS Perform*, after going 1-7 (.125) in 2025, his +.567 increase in winning percentage would be the third largest in MLB history from a pitcher's first major league season to his second (min. 10 GS each season)...The record currently belongs to George "Stump" Weidman, who went 0-9 in 1880 with the Buffalo Bisons and 8-5 in 1881 with the Detroit Wolverines (+.615).

HOMER HAPPY: Young has allowed a home run in a career-high five consecutive starts (8 total HR) since August 17, over which he holds a 2.67 HR/9.0 IP...That included a start on August 17 at Tampa Bay where he allowed a season-high three home runs.
⚡ He allowed 12 home runs over his first 20 starts of the season with a 0.95 HR/9.0 IP.

ROAD TRIPPIN': Young is on a four-decision winning streak over his last six road starts since June 21, the longest such single-season streak of his career...In that span, he holds a 3.18 ERA (12 ER/34.0 IP) and three quality starts, with the O's going 5-1 (.833) in those games.
⚡ Young's .875 (7-1) winning percentage on the road is tied for the second-highest mark among qualified AL pitchers, trailing only TOR's Dylan Cease (.889, 8-1).

FASTBALL FOCUS: Over his last six starts since August 11, opponents are slashing .320/.424/.580 (16-for-50) on his four-seam fastball with six extra-base hits (2 2B, 3B, 3 HR), eight walks, and five strikeouts.
⚡ Over his first 19 starts of the season, Young held opponents to a .191/.293/.322 (29-for-152) slash line on the pitch with 10 extra base hits (5 2B, 5 HR), 21 walks, and 28 strikeouts.
⚡ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is tied for the sixth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB, including the highest by a starting pitcher.

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.5 mph and 1,407 revolutions per minute (RPM) on the pitch over his last 19 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .241 (21-for-87) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 22 strikeouts to two walks.
⚡ Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.
⚡ Holds a 50.0 strikeout rate on the pitch over his last three starts since August 28 (8 total K)...Recorded a career-high five strikeouts with it on September 3 at Boston.
