**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles fell to the Nationals, 7-0, last night at Nationals Park...Baltimore has lost three of the last four games after winning back-to-back games from April 16-17 for the first time this season...This six-game road trip continues today and tomorrow in the nation's capital before heading to Detroit for a three-game series.

- 👤 Baltimore was shut out for the third time in 2025, tied for the second most in MLB behind the Pirates (4 SHO).
- 👤 The O's were one-hit for the first time since September 13, 2024 at Detroit, when **Gunnar Henderson** broke up a no-hit attempt with a two-out triple in the ninth inning... The one total base was tied for the fewest in the majors this season, along with the Braves (3/30 at SD) Mariners (4/1 vs. DET), and the fewest by the Orioles since August 30, 2022 at Cleveland (also 1 TB).
- 👤 Baltimore has been held to four hits or less an MLB-high eight times this season.
- 👤 The Birds have surrendered at least 10 hits in 13 games this year, second most in the majors behind the Rockies (14 G).
- 👤 Over the last four games, the 92 baserunners allowed (63 H, 27 BB, 2 HBP) are the team's most in a four-game stretch since August 30-September 2, 2008 (96 TBR).

**CED AND DONE:** **Cedric Mullins** ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .443), walks (2<sup>nd</sup>, 17), slugging percentage (3<sup>rd</sup>, .623), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, 1.066), and RBI (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 19).

- 👤 He was on base three times (1 H, 2 BB) last night...He's reached safely at least three times in seven games this year, second most in the AL behind NYY's Aaron Judge (10).
- 👤 He is one of five MLB players leading their team in hits (20), homers (6), RBI (19), and walks (17), along with CHC's Kyle Tucker, DET's Spencer Torkelson, NYY's Aaron Judge, and SD's Fernando Tatis Jr.

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The O's are 9-2 when scoring four or more runs this year and winless (0-11) when scoring three or fewer.

- 👤 Since 2024, Baltimore is 89-21 (.809) when scoring four or more runs, the fourth-best winning percentage in MLB during that time behind Cleveland (87-15, .853), San Diego (89-16, .848), and Houston (83-19, .814)...During that same period, the Birds are 11-63 (.149) when scoring three runs or fewer, the second-worst mark in the majors ahead of the White Sox (12-110, .098).
- 👤 The O's have lost 21 straight games when scoring three runs or fewer dating to September 7, 2024, with their last such victory coming on September 6, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (2-0).

**LONG BALL LIVING:** The Birds hit 19 homers during the eight-game homestand from April 11-20, tallying multi-homer performances in six of the contests...This follows a 10-game stretch from March 30-April 9 in which they hit an MLB-low two homers...Baltimore's 31 home runs on the season are fifth in the AL behind the Yankees (41), Athletics and Angels (34), and Mariners (33).

- 👤 Despite being shut out last night, the O's have hit 14 total homers in the last six games.
- 👤 Baltimore had homered in eight straight games until yesterday, the team's longest such stretch since doing so in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024...The team set a club record by going deep in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, 2024.
- 👤 The O's have received 14 long balls from their 6-9 hole hitters, tied for the most in MLB with the Yankees...The club led MLB with 87 such homers in 2024.

**'PEN PALS:** The O's bullpen ERA has risen from 2.97 (25 ER/75.2 IP) to 4.55 (43 ER/85.0 IP) since Sunday...Entering Sunday's game, the bullpen ranked second in the AL and fifth in MLB in ERA, before falling to 14<sup>th</sup> in the AL and 23<sup>rd</sup> in MLB entering today...Orioles relievers had allowed four home runs entering Sunday before surrendering two, both by position players.

- 👤 **Seranthony Domínguez** has thrown 8.1 scoreless innings across nine appearances to open the season, allowing two hits and six walks with 10 strikeouts.
- 👤 **Yennier Cano** has yet to allow a run across 8.1 innings, scattering five hits and one walk while fanning eight.
- 👤 **Bryan Baker** has allowed one run with three walks and 11 strikeouts in 10 outings.

**BATTLE OF THE BELTWAY:** The Orioles and Nationals meet for their first of two three-game series this season this week at Nationals Park...The clubs will face off at Camden Yards from May 16-18...The Birds have won nine of the last 12 matchups and 12 of the last 16 in the series since July 23, 2021.

- 👤 From 2011-17, Orioles Broadcaster **Kevin Brown** worked for the Syracuse Chiefs, the Triple-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, serving as the Assistant Director of Broadcasting and Media Relations from 2011-14, and Director from 2015-17, where he was the lead voice of the team, calling radio and television broadcasts.
- 👤 Orioles right-handed pitcher **Matt Bowman** played baseball and soccer at St. Albans High School in Chevy Chase, Md...Led his baseball team to three Interstate Athletic Conference championships and was an all-conference sweeper in soccer.
- 👤 Nationals Third Base Coach **Ricky Gutiérrez** was selected by the Orioles in the first round of the 1988 First-Year Player Draft.
- 👤 Washington Senior Director, Amateur Scouting **Brad Ciolek** spent 12 season with Baltimore, most recently as its director of draft operations (2022-23).
- 👤 Nationals Senior Advisor to the General Manager, Player Development **Dave Jauss** served as the Orioles Bench Coach from 2008-09.
- 👤 Washington Vice President, Amateur Scouting **Danny Haas** worked with Baltimore from 2012-18, first as a national crosschecker (2012-14) before being promoted to special assistant to the executive vice president of baseball operations (2015-18).

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY	
<b>April 23, 1954</b> - Ray Murray doubles in the go-ahead run in the 10 <sup>th</sup> inning as the O's beat the White Sox, 3-1, at Comiskey Park, the first extra-inning victory in Orioles history.	
<b>April 23, 1989</b> - Bob Milacki allows five baserunners, but faces the minimum 27 batters in a 3-0 shutout of Minnesota at Memorial Stadium. Milacki gives up three hits and two walks, but the O's turn four double plays and one runner is caught stealing. He becomes the third of four Orioles pitchers to face the minimum 27 batters, along with Jim Palmer (1967), Mike Flanagan (1982), and John Means (2021).

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his fifth career MLB start and first of the season against the Nationals...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers Shintaro Fujinami (2023) and Koji Uehara (2009-11)...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (4 GS), going 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) on 11 hits (1 HR) and five walks with 15 strikeouts...His first four outings (10.1 IP) of the spring were scoreless...In his debut, at 35 years, 170 days old, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since New York-NL's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his second career MLB win on April 17 vs. Cleveland after tossing 7.0 innings of two-run ball on five hits (2 HR) with three strikeouts...Both runs scored off of back-to-back solo homers to begin the third inning...Set season highs in innings and home runs and a season low in walks (0)...Is one of six starts by an O's pitcher this season with no walks (last: Kremer, 4/22 at WSH)...Threw 87 pitches, 55 strikes.

**LUCKY NUMBER 7:** With his start on April 17 vs. Cleveland, Sugano became the first Orioles starter to pitch into the seventh inning this year...Is the first O's pitcher to get through the seventh since Corbin Burnes on September 20, 2024 vs. Detroit (also 7.0 IP)...Sugano is one of two MLB rookies to complete seven innings this year, joining Texas' Kumar Rocker (4/17 vs. LAA, 7.0 IP).

- 2024 RECAP:** Spent the entire season with the Yomiuri Giants of Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball's Central League...Went 15-3 with a 1.67 ERA (29 ER/156.2 IP), 132 hits (6 HR), 16 walks, four hit batters, and 111 strikeouts in 24 games, all starts...Tossed three complete games, including one shutout...Led NPB in wins and finished second in ERA.
- 🏆 Named Central League MVP.
  - 🏆 Earned a Mitsui Golden Glove Award.
  - 🏆 Surrendered four or fewer runs in all 24 starts, three or less in 23, and one or no runs in 17; tossed six scoreless outings, including his lone complete game shutout on July 28 vs. DeNa (9.0 IP, 7 H, 8 K).
  - 🏆 Opened the season with a 20.0-inning scoreless streak; pitched two scoreless games (13.0 IP) to begin the year before allowing an eighth-inning run on April 18 at Hanshin.
  - 🏆 Won seven of eight starts from July 21 to September 10, including four straight from July 21 to August 11.
  - 🏆 Posted a 1.16 ERA (10 ER/77.1 IP) in his final 11 games beginning July 21.
  - 🏆 Helped the Giants secure a bye to the Final Stage of the 2024 Climax Series, NPB's playoff format, with the best record in the Central League (77-59-7)...Suffered two defeats in the series as Yomiuri was eliminated against DeNa...Took the loss in Game 2 after allowing two runs on six hits and one walk with five strikeouts in 7.0 innings...Entered in the ninth inning of a tie game in winner-take-all Game 7 and surrendered one run on two hits.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Sugano compiled a 136-74 record with a 2.43 ERA (501 ER/1,857.0 IP) with 1,568 hits (142 HR), 347 walks (12 IBB), 52 hit batters, and 1,585 strikeouts in 276 career games (248 GS) with the Giants...Was a three-time Central League MVP (2014, 2020, 2024), a three-time Central League Mitsui Golden Glove Award winner (2016-18), an eight-time All-Star (2013-19, 2022), a two-time Eiji Sawamura Award honoree (2017-18), presented to the top pitcher in NPB each season, and MVP of the 2013 Central League Climax Series, the playoff format in NPB...Led the Central League in wins four times (2017-18, 2020, & 2024), ERA four times (2014, 2016-18), and strikeouts twice (2016, 2018)...Earned the triple crown in 2018 after leading NPB in wins, ERA, and strikeouts.

**ON THE WORLD STAGE:** Pitched for Team Japan at the 2017 World Baseball Classic, pitching to a 3.14 ERA (5 ER/14.1 IP) with one walk and 16 strikeouts in three starts...Tied for the tournament lead in strikeouts with teammate Kodai Senga...Started the semifinal game against Team USA on March 21, 2017, at Dodger Stadium, allowing one unearned run on three hits and one walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.
