BACK TO THE BAY: The Giants return home from a brief three-game, four-day trip down south to San Diego...SF won its first series of the season after taking each of the first two games against the Padres (Monday-Tuesday) before dropping yesterday's finale.

- ▶ SF's success in San Diego was due in part to its pitchers inducing a 58.0% groundball rate from Padres hitters, marking the highest rate for a pitching staff in any MLB series this season...according to *Stats, LLC*, Giants pitchers had only one series with a higher rate in all of last season (62.3% in May against the Athletics).
- ▶ The Giants are still seeking their first win at Oracle Park this season...SF dropped all its first three games here vs. the Yankees, scoring just one run in the three contests.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the Giants placed **RHP José Buttó** on the 15-day IL (right arm fatigue) and recalled **RHP Blade Tidwell** (#46).

- ▶ Tidwell was drafted by the Mets in the second round in 2022 out of University of Tennessee, where he played under Giants **Manager Tony Vitello**...both he and Buttó joined the Giants organization at the deadline last year as part of the return in the trade that sent RHP Tyler Rogers to the Mets.

NEW YORK...AGAIN?: After hosting the Yankees last weekend and making a quick trip to San Diego early this week, SF is back home to host yet another New York team this weekend...the Giants enter this series having lost each of their last four home games against the Mets dating to April 24, 2024 and were outscored 23-7 in the four contests.

- ▶ Overall, SF has lost five of its last seven games against New York-NL, with Giants pitchers posting a 5.05 ERA (35er, 62.1ip).
- ▶ Former Mets **OF Harrison Bader** has a career .351 batting average (40x114) and .920 OPS vs. the Mets, both his highest against any team.

RAYGUN: LHP Robbie Ray takes the mound for SF tonight as he makes his second start of the 2026 season...the lefty threw 5.0 shutout innings to start his outing last Friday vs. the Yankees before giving up a pair of runs on a homer by Aaron Judge in the 6th inning...he was charged with the loss after working 5.1 innings with two runs and four strikeouts in SF's 3-0 loss to New York-AL.

- ▶ Since the start of 2025, the Giants have won 22 of Ray's 33 starts, tied for the fourth-most team wins with the same starting pitcher in MLB and second in the NL, trailing only the Phillies' 25 wins with Cristopher Sanchez on the mound (*Stats, LLC*).

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: Entering this series, **IF Luis Arraez** owns a .417 career batting average against the Mets...the .417 clip ranks as the highest average all-time against the Mets (min. 80 PA) and makes him one of two players to hit .400 or better vs. New York-NL, joining Stan Musial (.405) (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ Arraez has multiple hits in 13 of his 21 starts against the Mets.

PICK-SIX: The Giants have started the same nine position players in each of their six games so far this season, marking the first time since 1995 that SF has started the same fielders for six consecutive games (*Sportradar*).

- ▶ In contrast, the Mets have started five different defensive lineups (including DH, pitcher excluded) in their first six games of the season (*Sports Info Solutions*).

THE HIGHS AND LOWS: Through six games, the Giants have turned 82% of grounders and bunts into outs, the second-highest rate in MLB behind the Braves (84%)...the Mets rank sixth at 79% (*Sports Info Solutions*).

- ▶ Conversely, SF has turned just 59% of balls hit in the air into outs, the lowest percentage in MLB early this season (SF ranked last in 2025 as well).

50 FOR 5: IF Matt Chapman's next home run will be the 50th of his Giants career...per *Stats, LLC*, there have only been 10 Giants players with 50 or more homers as third basemen.

- ▶ Chapman, who enters today with 288 games played in a Giants uniform, could become just the second Giants player this century with at least 50 home runs in his first 300 games with the team, joining **Mike Yastrzemski**.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner enters his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors...the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Faced the Yankees last Friday, March 27 in the Giants second game of the season and suffered the loss as he threw 5.1 innings, allowing two runs on five hits with four strikeouts.

LOOKIN' SHARP IN CACTUS LEAGUE: Made six starts in Arizona's Cactus League this spring and posted a 2-0 record with a 1.37 ERA (3er, 19.2ip)...he struck out 21 batters, allowed just five hits and posted a 0.86 WHIP overall his six outings...had a two-start stretch from March 9-15 where he did not allow a hit (9.0 total innings) hit one, walked four and struck out 12...his last start came on March 21 against Cleveland where he threw 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits with six strikeouts.

AGAINST THE METS: Is scheduled to face the Mets for the 10th time in his career...has posted a 4-2 record with a 3.11 ERA (16er, 46.1ip) and 46 strikeouts over nine career starts against New York-NL...he last faced them on August 1, 2025 at Citi Field and tossed 7.0 innings, allowing just one earned run with six strikeouts in the Giants' 4-3 victory over the Mets.

2025 RECAP: Was selected to the NL All-Star team for the second time in his career (also 2017 with the Diamondbacks), pitching the best first half of his 12-year MLB career, as he posted his lowest career ERA (2.65) before the break (min. nine starts)...overall he started 32 games for SF, finishing the year with a 11-8 record and 3.65 ERA after posting a 5.54 ERA in 12 starts after the break...the 3.65 season ERA was his lowest since his Cy Young season in 2021 (2.84) and fourth-lowest in his 12-year career.

LUCKY CHARM: The Giants won each of Ray's first nine starts in 2025, making him the first Giants starter to have the team win each of his first nine starts of a season since **Bill Swift** in 1992 (11 wins to start the season).

SEVEN UP: Last season, he carried a perfect 7-0 record into his final start of May before taking a loss in his 12th start of the year on May 31st at Miami...became the first Giants starter since Hall of Famer **Juan Marichal** (1966) to tally at least seven wins and remain undefeated through his first 11 starts of a season...he also joined **Kevin Gausman** (2021) as the only Giants starters in the Wild Card Era to start a season 7-0.

ROBBIE RAY MAY: Was named the National League Pitcher of the Month for May 2025 after going 4-1 with a 1.38 ERA (6er, 39.0ip), 45 strikeouts, a 0.87 WHIP and a .169 opposing batting average in six May starts...the southpaw became the first Giant with an ERA of 1.38 or lower in a month and at least 39.0 innings pitched since **Madison Bumgarner** in May 2016 (1.05 ERA, 42.2ip)...the honor was the second Pitcher of the Month award of Ray's career (also: AL Pitcher of the Month in August 2021 with Toronto).

CHANGING THINGS UP: Last spring, he told reporters that he added a changeup to his pitch mix after connecting with 2024 AL Cy Young Tarik Skubal in the offseason to learn about his grip...Skubal sent Ray pictures, video and was available to chat with him about the pitch...Ray threw it 399 times (13.0% of the time) through 32 starts last year (all to righties), with batters going 17-for-73 (.233) with 16 strikeouts off the pitch.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers slashed .188/.282/.318 off him last season...the .188 average was third-best in the National League, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.174) and SD's Nick Pivetta (.185).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Batters hit .208 (75x361) off his four-seamer last season, his most used pitch (52.0%)...the pitch had a +9 run value, his highest of any pitch since 2022 (slider)...additionally, Ray's 108 strikeouts with a four-seamer were most in the NL and ranked second in the Majors behind only MIN's Joe Ryan (109).

GOOD LUCK CHUCK: The Giants were 22-10 in his starts last season...the .688 winning percentage ranked as the second-best record of any NL team behind the same starter, trailing only the Phillies 23-9 (.719) record with Cristopher Sánchez on the mound...it also tied NYY's Max Fried for the third-best team record among starters in MLB, (other: Boston's Garret Crochet at 23-9).

- ▶ Will make his second start in a Giants uniform.
- ▶ Made his SF debut on Saturday vs. the Yankees and worked 4.0 innings with two runs on five hits, a walk and five strikeouts.
- ▶ Mahle will face the Mets for just the third time in his career and first since 2019...he's 0-2 with a 4.00 ERA (4er, 9.0ip) with nine strikeouts in the two starts.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 4/1 at SD; 0.2ip (3 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with the Pirates in 2025 and 2024 and with the Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
- ▶ Left-handed batters were 7-for-60 (.117) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) off him last season...has held lefties to a .179 clip (67-for-374) in his MLB career.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 3/31 at SD; 2.0ip, 2h, k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career OD roster (also: 2020-2022 with Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Began 2025 on NYY's injured list with left rib fractures...made six rehab appearances before appearing in 12 games with NYY (3.38 ERA, 6er, 16.0ip)...was then DFA'ed on Aug. 5.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.
- ▶ Hasn't allowed a HR in his last 35.2 MLB innings since Oct. 4, 2022, the 12th-longest active streak in MLB.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 3/30 at SD; 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...has appeared in three of SF's first six games, tossing 3.0-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 36.2 innings dating to June 11, 2023, the 11th-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/1 at SD; 1.2ip, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Worked in two of SF's first six games (both lopsided losses) but has struck out three in 2.2 combined hitless, scoreless innings.
- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

Last Game: 3/28 vs. NYY; 0.2ip, h, bb, k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third career Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco)...did not pitch in the San Diego series.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 47.0 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the sixth-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Walked 20 batters in 30.0 innings in 2025 (15.6% walk rate).

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

Last Game: 3/29 vs. ELP (w/AAA); 2.2ip, bb, 3k (51 pitches) (start)

- ▶ Recalled today with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played collegiately for Giants manager Tony Vitello while at the University of Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 Draft.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with the Mets on May 4, 2025 at St. Louis as part of a doubleheader...pitched four total games with the Mets before being traded at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.
- ▶ Went 6-4 with a 3.62 ERA (39er, 97.0ip) with 111 strikeouts over 21 games between Triple-A Sacramento and Triple-A Syracuse.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 3/30 at SD; SV, 1.0ip, h, 2r, 2er, hr, bb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ On his third Opening Day roster (all with SF)...has appeared in three of SF's first six games.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Enjoyed his best stretch of the 2025 season from July 4-September 3 where he posted a 1.64 ERA (4er, 22.0ip) in 23 games.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 3/30 at SD; 1.0ip, 3k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made three appearances and tossed 3.0-scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- ▶ Made his second career Opening Day roster (also 2024 with SF).
- ▶ Appeared in seven Cactus League games for the Giants...allowed five runs in 7.1-innings of work...four of those five runs came in his outing in March 14 vs. ARI.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Hit his second career leadoff HR on Tuesday...is 5-for-13 with two runs, a double, homer and two RBI when batting leadoff in 2026.
- ▶ Had four hits on Tuesday...had just two four-hit games all last year.
- ▶ Made his eighth Opening Day roster, second with the Giants.
- ▶ Last season became the first Giants player to reach 30 home runs in a season since **Barry Bonds** had 45 home runs in 2004...he became the first Giants infielder and right-handed hitter to reach 30 homers in a season since **Jeff Kent** (37 homers in 2002).
