### THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY

On this date in 1999, the Orioles played final game at Tiger Stadium.. Albert Belle tied the Major League record with four doubles in the game as the Orioles defeated Detroit, 11-4.



THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: INF Hanser Alberto went 4-for-5 on Friday night at Buffalo's Sahlen Field for his sixth career four-hit game and his first of 2020...Since the start of the 2019 season, Alberto leads the majors with 99 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .402 (99-for-246) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks second in the AL and fifth in the majors with a .331 (42-for-127) average against all pitchers... He leads the AL and ranks second in the majors with 12 doubles...His 14 multi-hit games rank second in the AL and are tied for third-most in the majors.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The Orioles lead the majors with 11 bunt hits this season...OF Cedric Mullins leads the majors with six bunt hits, while INF Hanser Alberto ranks second in the majors with three bunt hits and INF/OF Andrew Velazquez is tied for third in the majors with two bunt hits.

SCORING CHANGE: Major League Baseball and the official scorer have made a change to a play from Friday night's Orioles-Blue Jays game...In the top of the sixth inning, INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle reached base on what was originally scored a single with two RBI...This has been changed to a single, one RBI, with the second run scoring on a throwing error by 3B Travis Shaw (runner on first also advanced to third on the error)...The second run on the play is now unearned.

CH-CH-CHANGES: Thursday night's postponed game at Tampa Bay has been rescheduled as part of a doubleheader on Thursday, September 17, starting at 5:05 p.m. ET in Baltimore... The Orioles will be the home team for the first game and the Rays will be the home team for the second game...Both games will be seven-inning regulation games.

Ox Also, the start time for the September 2 game against the New York Mets at Camden Yards has been changed to 4:05 p.m. ET.

BUFFALO WILD THINGS: The Toronto Blue Jays home ballpark for the 2020 season is Sahlen Field in Buffalo...The Blue Jays have called the park "home" since August 11.

- According to ESPN Stats and Info. 2020 marks the first time that Buffalo has hosted Major League regular season games since the Buffalo Buffeds/Blues of the short-lived Federal League called the city home from 1914-15.
- Ox It's been nearly 105 years since a team from Baltimore last played a Major League game in the city of Buffalo...On September 8, 1915, the Baltimore Terrapins were swept in a doubleheader (4-0, 5-4) by the Buffalo Blues at Federal League Park...The games of that day were the last Major League games played in Buffalo prior to 2020.
- Ox According to the Elias Sports Bureau, this series in Buffalo marks the first regular season games played at a non-Major League ballpark in Orioles history (since 1954).

ROAD WARRIORS: At 8-4 (.667), the O's own the third-best road record in the AL and fourth-best in the majors...Tuesday's loss at Tampa Bay was the O's first loss on the road since Opening Day at Boston...O's hitters lead the AL and rank second in the majors with a .288 team batting average on the road, trailing only Washington's .314 road batting average...The Orioles rank second in the AL and rank fourth in the majors with a .803 team OPS on the road...O's pitchers own a 4.05 ERA (48 ER/106.2 IP) in 12 games on the road this season to rank fourth in the AL and eighth in the majors.

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: OF Anthony Santander went 0-for-5 on Friday night, but has hit safely in 19 of his last 21 games...His recent hitting streak of 18 games marked a career high...Santander hit .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI from August 5 [2]-23...It was the longest stretch by an Oriole since Nick Markakis' 18-game mark from April 21-May 11, 2014.

Os Santander's 10 home runs on the season lead the Orioles, are tied for seventh in the AL, and are tied for 10th in the majors...He ranks second in the AL and is tied for third in the majors with 28 RBI this season...22 of his 34 hits have been for extra-bases (11 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs) and leads the majors with 22 extra-base hits

CATCH THIS: The O's catching corps of Pedro Severino, Chance Sisco, and Bryan Holaday ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks fifth in the AL with a .318 (27-for-85) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The O's have been one of the more successful teams in baseball when swinging at the first pitch...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.430) and OPS (1.194), rank second in extra-base hits (22), lead the AL and are tied for first in the majors in doubles (13), and lead the AL and rank sixth in the majors in hits (49) as a team on the first pitch.

- OF Anthony Santander leads the Orioles with eight hits on the first pitch...He is tied for 12th-most in the majors and is tied for fifth in the AL...Hanser Alberto and Renato Núñez are tied for 13th in the AL with six hits each on the first pitch of an at-bat
- Ox Santander is tied for second in the majors with five extra-base hits on the first pitch, while **C Pedro Severino** is tied for eighth in the majors with four extra-base hits on the first pitch.

ALL ABOUT THAT (ON) BASE: The O's rank fifth in the AL with a .763 team OPS (on-base percentage plus slugging percentage)... C Pedro Severino (.937) leads the team and ranks  $12^{\text{th}}$  in the AL, while **OF Anthony Santander** (.922) ranks 13th in the AL in OPS among qualifying hitters.

INJURED LIST: Six players are on the Injured List...INF Chris Davis (left knee patellar tendinittis), RHP Hunter Harvey (right forearm strain), and OF Austin Hays (non-displaced rib fracture), are on the 10-day Injured List...LHP Wade LeBlanc (left elbow stress reaction), INF/OF Trey Mancini (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and INF Richie Martin (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

## **#17 RHP ALEX COBB**

**LAST START:** Faced the Red Sox at home for his sixth start of the season on 8/22...Did not factor in the decision after allowing two runs on six hits, one home run, and one walk with one strikeout through 5.0 innings of work...Marked the first time he has struck out only one batter (or less) in a start since 6/27/18 vs. SEA...Has now surrendered a home run in five of his six starts this year...Cobb allowed four-or-fewer hits in each of his first four starts this season, becoming only the seventh starter in team history (since 1954) to do so.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: Owns a 3-6 record and 4.87 ERA (37 ER/68.1 IP) with 55 strikeouts in 12 career outings (all starts) against the Blue Jays...His last start against Toronto came at home on 8/17, and he was charged with the loss after allowing five runs on eight hits, one home run, and one walk through 6.2 innings, his longest outing of the season...His last start on the road against Toronto was on 7/21/18 and he was dealt the loss after surrendering four runs in 5.0 innings of work.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Owns a career record of 24-21 with a 3.57 ERA (153 ER/385.2 IP) in 66 starts against AL East opponents...Among all pitchers with at least 300.0 innings pitched against the division since his rookie season of 2011, Cobb ranks fourth in ERA and ninth in winning percentage against the AL East...He has recorded 33 Quality Starts against AL East foes...Has thrown 6.0-or-more innings in 36 of 66 starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Cobb is a career 31-25 in 77 road starts with a 4.12 ERA (205 ER/448.1 IP)...Opponents have batted .270 (473-for-1752) against Cobb on the road in his career, while batting just .236 (395-for-1674) against him at home...Each of Cobb's last eight wins have come on the road, with his last home victory coming nearly three years ago on 9/4/17 vs. MIN.

SECOND HALF STRENGTH: In his only full season with the Orioles in 2018, Cobb posted a 2.56 ERA (17 ER/59.2 IP) in the second half of the season, compared to his 6.41 ERA (66 ER/92.2 IP) in the first half...Opponents batted .232 (51-for-220) against Cobb in the second half of 2018, compared to .313 (121-for-386) in the first half...In his career, Cobb has posted a 10-8 record and 2.82 ERA (57 ER/181.2 IP) through 30 starts in the month of August, which marks his lowest monthly ERA.

AS AN ORIOLE: Since signing with the Orioles in March 2018, Cobb has started 37 games and pitched to a 6-19 record with a 5.10 ERA (111 ER/196.0 IP) and 132 strikeouts...In his 37 starts, opponents have batted .280 (220-for-787) with 94 extra-base hits (50 doubles, five triples, and 39 home runs)...Through the first six seasons of his career with the Tampa Bay Rays, Cobb owned a 48-35 record and 3.50 ERA (272 ER/700.0 IP) with 570 strikeouts, and held opponents to a .246 (648-for-2639) dip opponents to a .246 (648-for-2639) clip.

SEASON DEBUT: Made his 2020 season debut on 7/25 at BOS...Earned the win after surrendering just one run on a Mitch Moreland solo home run...Allowed only four hits with no walks and six strikeouts through 5.1 innings of work...Marked his 8th career start in which he threw at least 5.0 innings, allowed one run or fewer, and issued no walks, with his last coming on August 1, 2018 against the New York-AL.
