RAY REPORT—The Rays begin a six-game road trip against the Yankees (three to play) and Orioles (three to play) tonight at Yankee Stadium...are a season-high-18 games above .500, the third-earliest date they have reached that mark in franchise history behind 2023 (23-5, April 29) and 2010 (29-11, May 19)...own the best record in the majors for the fourth consecutive day, their first time leading MLB since June 30, 2023 (57-28)...have won four straight, eight of 10, 15 of 18, 21 of 25, and 28 of their last 36 games...the 21-4 run is tied for the best 25-game span in franchise history (7x, last: Aug. 8 [G2]-Sept. 4, 2020)...since Opening Day, have boosted their postseason odds from 28.9 pct. to 91.6 pct., an MLB-leading 62.7 pct. increase (FanGraphs)...are tied with the 2010 Rays for the second-best start in club history, behind only the 2023 Rays (34-14), in spite of having the fourth-toughest strength of schedule in the majors thus far...hold a 4.5-game lead in the AL East, their largest since July 5, 2023 (5.0 GA, 57-32)...have led the division for 13 consecutive days (May 9-pres.), their longest reign at the top since a club-record 113-day streak in 2023 (Opening Day-July 19)...have spent 19 days leading the AL East, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth...are 12-3 on a stretch of 22 games (May 4-27) that includes 19 meetings with divisional opponents.

★ The Rays secured their major league-leading sixth sweep of the season on Wednesday with a 5-3, come-from-behind victory over the Orioles...their six sweeps are tied for the most before the end of May in franchise history (2023, 2021, 2010).

★ The Rays earned their 13th comeback win behind a four-run 8th inning, third most in the AL behind the Athletics and Guardians (both 14)...their six wins when trailing after the 6th inning are tied for the most in MLB with the Phillies.

★ Ryan Vilade stole home on a double steal with Richie Palacios to cap the 8th-inning rally, the 13th successful steal of home on a double steal in club history and the first since June 3, 2025 vs. TEX (Junior Caminero)...overall, it was the Rays 18th time stealing home, including postseason games.

★ They improved to 13-2 vs. AL East clubs, tying seven other clubs (last: 2016 Cubs) for the second-best intradivision start in the divisional era (since 1969), trailing the 1981 Athletics (14-1)...they are 9-0 at home against the AL East.

★ Per Stats Perform, the Rays are an MLB-best 15-3 during May, tied for their second-best start to any calendar month (April 2023 & June 2004) behind a 16-2 run to open July 2013 (see note "May Flowers" below).

★ The Rays have won eight straight series openers, their longest run since a 10-game streak between May 23-June 24, 2025...extending the streak to nine games tonight would tie the third-longest streak in franchise history (see table on the right).

NICK-NICK-NICKELODEON—Tonight's starter Nick Martinez, holds the second-best ERA (1.51/53.2IP, 9ER) in the majors among qualified pitchers behind NYY Cam Schlichter (1.50)...it marks the lowest ERA by any Rays traditional starter through his first nine starts of a season, surpassing Scott Kazmir (1.76) in 2008, and is the lowest in franchise history through a traditional starter's first nine outings as a Ray...it is the lowest ERA by a pitcher 35 or older through nine starts since HOU Justin Verlander in 2018 (1.21, March 29-May 11).

★ The right-hander has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his nine starts this season, tied with MIL Kyle Harrison for the longest streak in 2026...he is the second pitcher age 35 or older in the modern era (since 1900) to turn the trick, joining PIT A.J. Burnett (9G, April 9-May 23, 2015), and has the chance to pass Burnett's streak with tonight's outing.

★ He has not allowed a home run in his last 39.2 innings, which marks the seventh-longest active streak in the majors and the longest by a starting pitcher.

★ Martinez pitched against the Yankees on April 11 and went 4.2 innings with one run allowed on five hits, three walks, and one home run with four strikeouts.

MAY FLOWERS—The Rays are 15-3 (.833) to begin May, tying April 2023 and June 2004 for their second-best start to a calendar month behind July 2013 (16-2)...entering play today, it is the best winning pct. during any month in franchise history...if the club wins seven of its final nine games this month, it will surpass July 2013 (21-5, .808) for best winning pct. in a single month in franchise history...at their current pace, the Rays would finish the month 23-5, surpassing April 2023 and May 2021 (both 22-6) for the most wins in during a calendar month in team history.

★ Jonathan Aranda is slashing .339/.434/.435 (21-for-62) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 12 RBI, 10 BB, and an .870 OPS over 18 games during May...he ranks highly in the majors in on-base pct. (4th) and average (.76th) in May, and has reached base safely in 15 of the 18 games.

★ Sunday afternoon's probable starting pitcher, Shane McClellanahan, has pitched to a 3-0 record and a 1.66 ERA (21.2IP, 4ER) with 22 strikeouts, four walks, and a 0.83 WHIP during May...his 0.83 WHIP is the second best in the AL over that span and his 1.66 ERA is fifth-best.

★ Rays pitchers have produced a 2.74 ERA (164.1IP, 50ER), this month, the third best in the majors, trailing only the Brewers (2.21) and Red Sox (2.56).

EARLY AND OFTEN—The Rays have scored first in 28 games this season, tied for the sixth most in the majors and tied for fourth most in the AL (also: CLE & MIN)...their 23 wins when scoring first are tied for the second most in MLB with the Braves and Pirates, trailing behind only the Yankees (24)...the Rays have scored first in nine of 10 and 19 of their last 25 games (April 22-pres.) compared to three of their prior 22 contests (April 15-May 8)...they have won 21 of the last 23 games in which they scored first, and their 23-5 (.821) mark in such games on the season ranks second in MLB to the Rangers (18-3/.857).

★ The club is 13-3 when scoring in the opening frame, including nine straight wins...the Rays have scored in the 1st inning in seven of their last 10 games...the club has scored within the first three frames in a season-high-tying six straight games (3x, last: April 8-15).

★ The Rays are averaging 4.83 runs per game, second in the AL to the Yankees (4.90)...in games they score first (28G), they are averaging 5.6 runs per game compared to 3.7 when yielding the first run.

★ Yandy Diaz is 11-for-24 (.458) with 3 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, and a 1.477 OPS over a six-game hitting streak on the heels of a 1-for-17 (.059) skid in his previous four games (May 8-12).

★ Ryan Vilade has reached safely in nine of his last 12 plate appearances...since May 4, he has produced a .364/.464/.773 (8-for-22) slash line with a 1.237 OPS in nine games.

THE ENTERTAINER—Cedric Mullins is batting .324 (12-for-37) with 1 HR, 5 RBI, 8 R, and 4 SB over his last 11 games (May 6-pres.), which included a season-high six-game hitting streak (May 12-19)...he slashed .409/.500/.545 (9-for-22) with 1 HR, 3 RBI, 7 R, and a 1.045 OPS during the streak...Mullins has batted .310 (9-for-29) against fastballs in May compared to a .129 (8-for-62) during March/April...he is one of eight players in the majors (CWS Sam Antonacci, SEA Randy Arozarena, CLE Travis Bazzana, PIT Konnor Griffin, SEA Josh Naylor, CLE Brayan Rocchio, KC Bobby Witt Jr.) batting .280 or better with four stolen bases or more this month.

THE UNSLEEPING CITY—The Rays and Yankees meet this weekend for the second of four sets this season...the clubs played at Tropicana Field between April 10-12, with the Rays sweeping the Yankees in the three-game series...it marked the Rays first sweep of the Yankees since April 16-18, 2021 at Yankee Stadium...the Rays are 3-3-1 in series opposite the Yankees since July 2024.

★ In his career, Jonathan Aranda is batting .423 (11-for-26) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, and a 1.215 OPS over eight games at Yankee Stadium, including a five-game hitting streak.

★ Taylor Walls has reached base safely in 14 straight games at Yankee Stadium (Aug. 17, 2022-pres.), tied for the seventh-longest streak in Rays history...during the streak, he has slashed .347/.411/.571 (17-for-49) with 6 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI and a .982 OPS...min. 40 AB, marks the fourth-best average by any player at Yankee Stadium over that span, trailing LAA Mike Trout (.386), PIT Ryan O'Hearn (.370), and BOS Rafael Devers (.347 - by pct. points).

★ Yandy Diaz has gone 14-for-44 (.318) with 2 2B and 2 HR in his career vs. NYY Gerrit Cole...his 14 hits off of Cole are tied with Nestor Cortes for his most hits vs. any pitcher in his career...ties Matt Carpenter and SF Rafael Devers for the most hits by any player vs. Cole.

★ Gerrit Cole is set to make his season debut tonight, his first major league start since Sept. 26, 2024 vs. BAL...Cole is 5-7 with a 3.45 ERA (122.2IP, 47ER) and the Yankees are 10-10 in his 20 career starts against the Rays.

THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY—Today marks the nine-year anniversary of Corey Dickerson hitting a leadoff home run on his birthday at Tropicana Field against the Angels on May 22, 2017...he joined Randy Winn (June 9, 2002 vs. SD) as the only players in team history to produce a leadoff homer run on their birthday...he is one of 14 players (17x) in franchise history to hit a home run on his birthday...Dickerson, who joined the Rays coaching staff as first base coach this season, turns 37 years old today.

TONIGHT'S START—Nick Martinez will make his 10th start with the Rays and sixth on the road...marks his 290th career appearance (139th start) and 12th opposite the Yankees (seventh start)...is seeking a team-high sixth quality start of the campaign...has recorded 993.2 IP in his career, 6.1 shy of 1,000.0 IP...is in the midst of his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

✦ Ranks second among MLB qualifiers with a 1.51 ERA (53.2IP, 9ER), behind only NYY Cam Schlichtler (1.50).

LAST TIME OUT—Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, but did not receive a decision after allowing 5 H and 1 BB with 4 SO in a 10-5 loss on May 16 vs. MIA...has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his first nine starts this season, matching PIT A.J. Burnett (2015) for the longest season-opening streak by an MLB pitcher age 35 or older in the live-ball era (since 1920)...his nine-start streak is tied with MIL Kyle Harrison for the longest active run in the majors and is the longest such streak by a pitcher age 35 or older at any point in a season since TEX Jacob deGrom posted 14 straight from April 18–July 1, 2025.

✦ Martinez is 4-0 with a 0.85 ERA (31.2IP, 3ER), 4 BB, 21 SO, a 0.92 WHIP, and a .216 (25-for-116) opp. AVG over his last five starts...min. 30.0IP, his ERA is the best among MLB pitchers in that span and his WHIP is ninth best.

✦ He has gone 39.2 innings without allowing a home run, the seventh-longest active homerless innings streak in the majors and the longest by a starter...on the season, his 0.50 home runs per 9.0 innings ranks seventh among qualified AL pitchers.

FUHGEDDABOUDIT—The Fordham University product is 2-2 with a 4.73 ERA (40.0IP, 21ER) and 21 strikeouts in 11 career appearances (six starts) opposite the Yankees...is 0-1 with a 2.38 ERA (11.1IP, 3ER) over his last five outings (one start) against them...he has made one start opposite New York this season on April 11 at Tropicana Field, allowing only a solo homer in his shortest outing of the campaign (4.2IP, 5H, ER, 3BB, HR)...as a starter, has gone 2-1 with a 4.13 ERA (32.2IP, 15ER) 19 strikeouts, and a .224 (28-for-125) opp. AVG against the Pinstripes.

✦ Martinez is 8-10 with a 5.37 ERA (156.0IP, 93ER) and 90 strikeouts in 41 career appearances (24 starts) vs. AL East opponents...marks his highest ERA against any division he has faced...he has pitched to a 5.43 ERA (131.0IP, 79ER) with 70 strikeouts across those 24 starts...is 2-0 with a 1.76 ERA (15.1IP, 3ER) in three starts against the division this season.

CHANGE UP THE PACE—Martinez has posted a .121 (7-for-58) opp. average on his changeup this season with an opp. slugging pct. of .138...min. 30 AB, his opp. SLG is the fourth lowest in the AL behind KC Kris Bubic (.114/4-for-35), CLE Tanner Bibee (.122/4-for-41), and teammate Shane McClanahan (.132/6-for-53)...of those seven hits on Martinez's changeups, none of them have been barreled...min. 200 changeups, his 36.1 whiff rate on the pitch is the fourth best in the AL behind CLE Parker Messick (45.4%), CLE Joey Cantillo (42.5%), and McClanahan (38.3%).

✦ His combined .197 (36-for-183) opp. AVG on fastballs and offspeed pitches is fourth lowest among AL pitchers (min. 150AB), behind LAA José Soriano (.176), NYY Cam Schlichtler (.180), and KC Michael Wacha (.192).

RAISING THE BAR—Martinez ranks highly in multiple MLB pitching rankings, according to Baseball Savant...his Pitching Run Value (13), Fastball Run Value (10), and Offspeed Run Value (6) are all in the 98th percentile or higher, an improvement from his -2 Pitching Run Value, 0 Fastball Run Value, and -2 Offspeed Run Value in 2025.

✦ Since the start of 2023, Martinez's 32.0 pct. hard-hit rate is second lowest in the majors (min. 1,000BF) behind NYY Ryan Yarborough (29.9 pct.).

✦ Opposing hitters have an average exit velocity of 86.7 mph since the beginning of 2023, tied for third lowest in the majors during that span (min. 1,000BF) with NYY Max Fried (86.7), trailing SD Michael King (86.5), and LAA Kyle Hendricks (85.8).

NO FREE 90S—Since the start of 2024, Martinez has issued only 71 walks, good for the fifth-lowest walks per 9.0 innings (1.77) in the majors during that stretch (min. 250.0IP)...the veteran right-hander trails only SEA Bryan Woo (1.50), DET Tarik Skubal (1.55), SEA George Kirby (1.61), and CHC Shota Imanaga (1.67) during that span...min. 200 IP this season, his 5.1 pct. walk rate is tied with NYY Cam Schlichtler for third best in the majors behind TOR Kevin Gausman (3.9%) and CWS Davis Martin (4.7%).

NOT JUST QUALITY—On April 28 at CLE, Martinez became the oldest Ray to turn in consecutive ultra quality starts (7.0IP or more with 2ER or fewer) in franchise history (April 22–28) and the oldest pitcher to turn the trick since HOU Justin Verlander registered five straight (May 10–June 1, 2019).

✦ The last Ray to record back-to-back ultra quality starts was Taj Bradley between May 27–June 1, 2025.

SOFT CONTACT KING—Among qualified pitchers last season, Martinez's 34.5 pct. hard-hit rate tied MIL Freddy Peralta for the fifth lowest in the majors, higher than only HOU Hunter Brown (32.2%), DET Tarik Skubal (33.0%), CIN Andrew Abbott (33.7%), and LAA Kyle Hendricks (34.3%).

✦ He also ranked fourth among qualified AL pitchers in barrel pct. (6.9%) behind only Brown (5.9%), ATH Luis Severino (6.0%), and HOU Framber Valdez (6.7%).
