SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 11 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...

AT THE OPEN: The Texas Children's Houston Open completed Day 2 of the tournament yesterday at Memorial Park Golf Course with Gary Woodland leading the way by shooting 13 under through two rounds of play...

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros fell to 0-2 on the season last night after a 6-2 loss to the visiting Angels...DH Yordan Alvarez homered for Houston to record the Astros only RBI...

LAMBERT RE-SIGNED: The Astros have re-signed RHP Peter Lambert to a minor league contract and assigned him to Triple A Sugar Land...

OUT ON REHAB: RHP Enyel De Los Santos began a rehab assignment with Triple A Sugar Land last night, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout on 14 pitches...

ABOUT THE ROSTER: The Astros Opening Day roster includes 13 pitchers and 13 position players...nine players made their first appearance on an active Opening Day roster...

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing RHP Mike Burrows and RHP Kai-Wei Teng in trades and RHP Tatsuya Imai and RHP Ryan Weiss off the international free agent market...

OPENING DAY CORNERSTONE: 2B Jose Altuve, who's under contract for the next four seasons (2026-29), made his 14th career Opening Day start on Thursday...

HE'S BACK: SS Jeremy Peña, a 2025 All-Star, made his season debut last night, going 2x5 with a stolen base and a run scored...

UPCOMING MILESTONES: 1B Christian Walker has 499 career runs needing just one to reach the 500 mark...meanwhile, LF Yordan Alvarez (494 RBI) is six RBI shy of reaching 500 career RBI...

YOUR-GONE: LF Yordan Alvarez connected for his 171st career home run last night, a total that ranks eighth in franchise history...he's now just three homers shy of matching franchise icon OF George Springer (174HR) for seventh on that all-time list.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican pitcher is in his 7th MLB season with the Astros and has gone 35-22 with a 3.66 ERA (219ER/538IP) and 598 strikeouts in 124 appearances, including 90 starts...among AL pitchers since 2022 (min. 300 IP), he ranks T-2nd in opponent batting average (.210), behind only **DET LHP Tarik Skubal** (.208)...also ranks 13th among AL pitchers strikeouts per 9.0 innings at 9.75...including his time as a reliever, has held opponents to a .202 opponent batting average (397x1956) throughout his career (2020-25)...it's the 4th lowest opponent batting average in the Majors over that stretch (min 500 IP)...among Astros pitchers with at least 500 innings pitchers with the club, his .203 career opponent batting average ranks 3rd, behind only **LHP Billy Wagner** (.186) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (.199)...was signed by the Astros as a non-drafted free agent from the Dominican Republic on March 19, 2015...signed a 5-year contract extension in Feb. 2023 that will keep him in Houston through the 2027 season.

LAST START - 3/22 vs. STL: In his last outing in Spring Training, he allowed 1 run on 4 hits with 2 walks and 2 strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

SPRING TRAINING: Made 3 official Spring Training starts, recording a 1.69 ERA (2ER/10.2IP)...also recorded 10 strikeouts and a .184 opponent batting average in his 3 starts.

HOME COOKING: has been a dominant pitcher at Daikin Park in his career...has gone 22-10 with a 2.82 ERA (89ER/284.1IP)...also has recorded 314 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average at Daikin Park...his career 2.82 ERA is the 3rd-lowest among AL pitchers since 2020 behind **DET LHP Tarik Skubal** (2.54 ERA) and **SEA RHP Luis Castillo** (2.80 ERA)

VS. THE HALOS: Has made 13 appearances, including 9 starts against the Los Angeles Angels in his career...has recorded a 2.93 ERA (19ER/58.1IP) with 82 strikeouts, a .195 opponent batting average and a 1.01 WHIP...in his last against the Angels on Aug. 29, 2025, he walked 3 hits and struck out 6 in 6.0 no-hit innings...at Daikin Park against the Angels, he's gone 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (9ER/37.1IP), 44 strikeouts and a 0.91 WHIP...has held former AL MVP Mike Trout to a .000 batting average (0x14) with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.

2025 RECAP: Returned from Tommy John surgery in early August...went 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP)...also recorded 34 strikeouts, a .230 opponent batting average and a 1.27 WHIP in eight starts...made five rehab starts on his way back from surgery...in the five starts, had a 5.14 ERA (8ER/14IP) with 15 strikeouts and a .208 opponent average.

POSTSEASON CAREER: Has been a strong postseason performer in his career, posting a 6-2 record with a 2.68 ERA (13ER/43.2IP) with 4 holds in 17 appearances, including 5 starts...has allowed just 22 hits in his 43.2 innings of work for a .146 opponent average, while striking out 60 hitters...his opponent batting average is the lowest opponent batting average in MLB history (min. 40 IP).

SPRING TRAINING: shined in his third Major League Spring Training, hurling for a 0.93 ERA (1ER/9.2IP)...did not give up a walk and struck out 13 in 9 appearances.

FREE AGENT SIGNING: signed to a minor league contract with an invitation to Major League Spring Training on Dec. 20, 2025...was born in Houston and went to Memorial High School, which is approximately 25 minutes from Daikin Park...pitched collegiately at Texas A&M.

2025 SEASON: spent his entire season in the Marlins organization and reached the Majors for the first time in his career, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings with 3 strikeouts through 2 relief appearances...spent majority of his year with Triple A Jacksonville, where he went 10-2 with a 2.83 ERA (19ER/60.1IP), two saves, 64 strikeouts, a .180 opponent average and a 1.09 WHIP in 50 games.
