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BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore continues a 10-game, 11-day road trip through Texas (1-2), Minnesota (3 to play), and Tampa Bay (4 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 3-3 homestand, dropping two of three to the Phillies before taking two of three from the Angels...The Orioles begin play today 2.0 games back of the final AL Wild Card spot.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** (3-for-3, 2 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 2 BB) recorded his 27th career multi-homer game, including his first since September 2, 2025 at Detroit...He became the first Oriole to hit two home runs and reach base safely five times since Emmanuel Rivera on September 28, 2024 at Minnesota...The five times on base matched Alonso's season high, joining July 4 at Cincinnati (3-for-3, 2B, R, RBI, 2 BB).

🦅 Baltimore tallied 10 runs in yesterday's win after scoring 11 combined runs over its previous five contests...It marked the fourth time the O's plated 10 runs on the road this season (last: 10 R, 7/29 at DET), while their 15 hits on the road tied a season high, joining June 21 at Los Angeles-NL.

🦅 The O's tallied seven extra-base hits (2 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR), their fourth game of the year accomplishing the feat (last: 8 XBH, 6/21 at LAD)...The four long balls matched their road season high, joining June 21 at Los Angeles-NL.

🦅 **Colton Cowser** snapped a career-high 26-game streak without a multi-hit performance, going 2-for-4 with a home run and two RBI...His 441 ft. blast was the third-furthest of his career, trailing homers of 455 ft. (6/27/25 at ATH) and 443 ft. (6/16/24 vs. PHI).

SEESAW SERIES: Baltimore was swept by Minnesota in the 2025 season series (0-6) after the O's won 10 straight against the Twins from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024.

🦅 Each of the last eight meetings between the clubs have been decided by four or fewer runs, seven of which have been decided by three or fewer runs.

🦅 The Birds hit one long ball and scored five combined runs in three games at Target Field last season after hitting seven long balls and plating 22 runs in 2024.

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Over his last 11 starts since June 4, **Trevor Rogers** is 5-1 with a 2.28 ERA (17 ER/67.0 IP) and 1.00 WHIP.

🦅 Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 65.0 innings since June 4, his 2.28 ERA ranks third behind SD's Robbie Ray (2.08) and TB's Drew Rasmussen (2.20).

🦅 Rogers has 6+ strikeouts and zero walks in each of his last three starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in team history (since 1954), joining Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979...The only two pitchers in MLB to do so in four straight this season are SEA's Bryce Miller and PIT's Paul Skenes (both 4).

ACTION JACKSON: In 21 games following the All-Star break, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .313/.400/.422 (20-for-64) with four doubles, one home run, 10 runs, six RBI, 10 walks and two steals.

🦅 Over his last eight road games since July 22 (G1), he is 15-for-30 (.500) with three doubles, one home run, and four RBI.

🦅 His 1.063 OPS with two outs is fourth highest in the AL and seventh highest in the majors (min. 60 PA).

TYLER THE CREATOR: Over his last 21 games since July 8, **Tyler O'Neill** is slashing .321/.379/.755 (17-for-53) with two doubles, seven home runs, 11 runs, and 13 RBI.

🦅 Among all MLB hitters with at least 50 at-bats since July 8, his .755 slugging percentage is the highest in the majors, outpacing teammate **Coby Mayo** (.696) and TEX's Joc Pederson (.652).

🦅 During the 21-game stretch, he is 14-for-33 (.424) with two doubles, seven home runs, and 11 RBI off left-handed pitching.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.63 ERA in 67 games since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in MLB during that time behind the Tigers (3.11), Yankees (3.30), Red Sox (3.34), and Brewers (3.62)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.73 ERA since May 24, the fifth-best starter ERA in the AL... Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

🦅 Orioles relievers have a 3.17 ERA since June 16, fifth lowest in the majors behind the Astros/Red Sox (both 2.67), Yankees (2.81), and Rays (2.88)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles have played in 76 games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for fifth most in the majors behind the Guardians (82), Blue Jays (79), and Royals/Twins (both 78)... Their 36-40 (.474) winning percentage in such affairs ranks 20th in MLB.

🦅 Baltimore is 10-18 (.357) in one-run games, the third-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Giants (10-20, .333) and Mets (11-20, .355).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 28 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (25)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (7).

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962)

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Tyler O'Neill** and **Leody Taveras** are tied for second with three pinch-hit RBI each.

🦅 The team's 28 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1991 (30)...The team record is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 109 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (44 G).

🦅 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 109-game stretch is the second-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954) trailing a 112-game run in 1995.

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 459 walks.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 22nd start of the season and 124th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the victory on August 5 vs. Los Angeles-AL after working 6.0+ innings, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) with zero walks and a season-high nine strikeouts...Threw 93 pitches, 62 strikes.

- ⚡ The nine strikeouts were his most since fanning nine on August 24, 2025 vs. Houston.
- ⚡ Rogers has 6+ strikeouts and zero walks in each of his last three starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in team history (since 1954), joining Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979...The only two pitchers in MLB to do so in four straight this season are SEA's Bryce Miller and PIT's Paul Skenes (both 4).

TWIN CITIES: Rogers is set to make his second career start against the Twins...Faced Minnesota on Opening Day at Camden Yards on March 26 and earned the win after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits, four walks, and one hit batter with five strikeouts.

- ⚡ Is one of his two starts this season in which he has thrown 7.0 scoreless innings, joining June 20 at Los-Angeles-NL (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 6 K).

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last 11 starts since June 4, Rogers is 5-1 with a 2.28 ERA (17 ER/67.0 IP) and 1.00 WHIP.

- ⚡ Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 65.0 innings since June 4, his 2.28 ERA ranks third behind SD's Robbie Ray (2.08) and TB's Drew Rasmussen (2.20).
- ⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SUPPORT WELCOMED: Rogers has received three runs of support or fewer in nine of his last 10 outings (23 runs total), including one run in four of the outings.

- ⚡ He received 32 runs of support over his first 11 starts of 2026, including a season-high-tying eight runs on April 1 vs. Texas and June 4 at Boston.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past eight starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .140 (8-for-57) clip with three doubles and 19 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.
- ⚡ Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.
- ⚡ His .512 opponent OPS vs. lefties is sixth lowest in MLB (min. 125 BF) behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (.314), MIL's Jacob Misorowski (.384), PHI's Jesús Luzardo (.391), TOR's Louis Varland (.464), and HOU's Peter Lambert (.505).

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In eight starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 25.8 percent strikeout rate and 26.0 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.

- ⚡ During his most recent eight-start stretch, he owns a 28.7 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 27.0 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).

- ⚡ Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .286/.344/.388 (42-for-147) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 29 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- ⚡ Over his last 11 starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .195/.253/.260 (15-for-77) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.
- ⚡ Overall, opponents are slashing .408/.482/.612 (20-for-49) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.
