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THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 3-6 (1-2 at Seattle, 1-2 at Kansas City and 1-2 at Milwaukee), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a win over the Orioles last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against Baltimore and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...on Thursday morning, the Twins will travel to Dyersville, Iowa to play the Phillies at the Field of Dreams on Thursday night...they will enjoy an off-day on Friday, then complete the series with Philadelphia at Target Field on Saturday and Sunday...they will finish the homestand next week with three against the Braves, from Monday-Wednesday.

KREMER REVENGE GAME: The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 9-5, winning their fourth series opener in their last five chances...Dean Kremer (2-4) made the start against his former team, allowing one run on one hit in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...he retired 20 of 22 batters faced, with the only two to reach base coming in the fourth inning via a Gunnar Henderson walk and an infield single by Jackson Holliday...the offense recorded 14 hits, tied for third-most this season and most since June 26 vs. Colorado (also 14)...Austin Martin set a single-game career-high with four hits, one being a home run, his third of the season and fifth of career.

TWINS-OS: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the fifth of six games in 2026...Twins need two wins to take the season-series for the second-straight season.
✦ Twins are 8-2 vs. Baltimore in their last 10 (since the start of 2025) after going 0-10 head-to-head prior to this stretch (from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024).
✦ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 76 home runs in 48 games against the Orioles, their third-most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central (88 vs. SEA & 81 vs. TOR).
✦ Josh Bell is hitting .337 (32-for-95) with eight home runs, 21 RBI, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.013 OPS in 26 career games vs. the Orioles...he has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 vs. the O's...he has homered in six of his last 13 vs. the O's.
✦ Victor Caratini is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with six walks, eight RBI, a .407 on-base percentage and an .816 OPS in 16 career games vs. Baltimore.
✦ In four games against Baltimore this season, Royce Lewis is hitting .308 (4-for-13) with two home runs, four RBI and two walks.

TWINS ON TARGET: Twins have gone 31-27 at home...they entered this Baltimore series having gone 6-1-0 in series play at home since June 12.
✦ Since June 28, they have gone 10-4 at home, posting a .714 winning percentage, tied with Milwaukee (.714, 15-6) for best in baseball since that date.
✦ Over their last 14 home games, Twins starters have combined to go 4-3, 2.94 ERA (82.2 IP, 27 ER) with 20 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .202 opponent batting average.
✦ Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in 10-straight home games...over his last 18 games at Target Field, he is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with a .960 OPS.
✦ Royce Lewis has hit safely in six-straight home games...he has reached safely via hit or walk in 14-straight games overall.

SAINT LEWIS: In nine games this month, Royce Lewis is hitting .405 (15-for-37) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.112 OPS.
✦ Lewis' OPS by month: March/April - .666 // May - .318 // June - .841 // July - .722 // August - 1.112
✦ Among all AL players with a minimum of 35 plate appearances this month, Lewis ranks fourth in batting average (.405), and fifth in OPS (1.112) and slugging percentage (.676).
✦ Royce has now reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 games, since July 19.

✦ Among all AL players with a minimum of 100 plate appearance since July 1, he ranks fifth in OPS and on-base percentage, and tied for fifth in batting average.

SERIES BUSINESS: Twins are seeking their 19th series victory of the season tonight...they have gone 18-18-2 in series play, 11-5-1 at home and 7-13-1 on the road.
✦ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 10-5-1 in their last 16 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
✦ Twins are seeking their sixth-straight series win at home, which would be their longest stretch since winning nine-straight here in 2020.
✦ Twins last series win over the Orioles was a three-game sweep in Baltimore from May 14-15, 2025.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: Over their last 17 games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 3.32 ERA (57.0 IP, 21 ER) with 31 walks, 61 strikeouts (9.6 K/9.0 IP) and a .236 opponent batting average.
✦ Since the trade deadline on August 3, Twins relievers have struck out 26 of 96 batters faced (27.1%).

THE INKREDIBLE KODY CLEMENS: Kody Clemens hit his 20th home run on Sunday afternoon in Milwaukee, setting a single-season career high (19 in 2025)...since being acquired by the Twins in late April of 2025 (from Philly for cash), he has 39 home runs in 799 plate appearances...prior to joining Minnesota, he had 14 home runs in 402 plate appearances for Detroit (2022) and Philadelphia (2023-25).
✦ Since June 1, he's homered 14 times, tied for sixth-most in the AL.
✦ Among AL players with at least 400 plate appearances this season, he ranks 12th in slugging percentage (.465).
✦ On the season, Clemens ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball in average exit velocity (92.4 mph).

OH MY JOSH: Josh Bell drove in three more runs last night, giving him 71 on the season, seventh-most in the AL.
✦ He is on pace to record 95 RBI, which would be the second-most of his career (116 - 2019)...the last Twin to drive in 90 in a season was Jorge Polanco with 98 in 2021.
✦ Twins are 31-13 when Bell drives in at least one run and 14-4 when he drives in at least two.

YO-GO: Since being acquired in a trade with Tampa Bay (for cash considerations), Yoendrys Gómez has appeared in 40 games for the Twins, going 2-2, 1.80 ERA (35.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .189 opponent batting average and is 15-for-15 in save opportunities...since the start of May, he is one of just two relievers in baseball with a 100% save percentage (minimum of 10 saves) and an ERA under 2.00, the other being Josh Hader (16-for-16, 1.00 ERA).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 2008, Ron Gardenhire earned his 600th managerial win in a 4-0 defeat of New York-AL at the Metrodome...Glen Perkins was the starter and winner that day, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed.
