LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-4 vs. Brewers in walkoff fashion, overcoming a 4-0 deficit in the ninth inning.

- Marked the D-backs first walkoff victory in 2025.
- The D-backs' are the only MLB team this season with 2 comeback wins after trailing by 4+ runs in the eighth inning or later (also: March 30 vs. Cubs)...the only other team with an occurrence is the Mariners (1).
- Alek Thomas delivered a 1-out triple to plate Gabriel Moreno (walk)...
 Corbin Carroll then doubled to plate both Thomas and Garrett Hampson (walk)...Jake McCarthy delivered the game-tying single to score Carroll and move Geraldo Perdomo (walk) to third...Lourdes Gurriel Jr. ended the game with a sacrifice fly to right field.

LAST NIGHT'S HISTORICAL WALKOFF: Per @OptaSTATS, the D-backs are the first MLB team to have a 5+-run walkoff inning to snap a 17.0+ scoreless-inning drought since the Tigers did so against the Senators on August 22, 1941.

HISTORY ALMOST REPEATED VS. MILWAUKEE: Last night marked the second occurrence vs. Brewers (third occurrence all-time) where the D-backs overcame a 4+-run deficit in the ninth inning (also: July 3, 2008 vs. Brewers, down 5-0 and scored 6 runs without recording an out).

 The only other occurrence was last year on July 29, 2024 vs. Nationals, down 8-4 and scored 5 to win 9-8.

JUST SHY OF A HOMER: This season, there have been 14 hits tracked at a distance of 400+ feet with a 105+ exit velocity that DID NOT result in a home run (was only a double or triple), and the D-backs account for 4 of those instances, the most in MLB (the Rockies are only other team with multiple occurrences with 2)...under those same metrics, there have also been 135 hits that DID result in a home run.

CARROLL WATCH CONTINUES: Over his last 8 games, since April 4, **Corbin Carroll** has 8 extra-base hits (3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers)...in the span, is slashing .406 AVG/.472 OBP/.938 SLG/1.410 OPS...his 8 extra-base hits, 1.410 OPS and 30 total bases are the most in MLB in the span.

- Carroll ranks among MLB leaders in extra-base hits (3rd, 11), total bases (3rd, 41), SLG (4th, .695), home runs (T-7th, 5) and OPS (8th, 1.107).
- Carroll's 25 homers since July 7, 2024 rank tied for fifth in MLB with Brent Rooker/ATH, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (32), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (30), Eugenio Suárez/AZ (29) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (27).

CARROLL'S 15-GAME ON-BASE STREAK: Corbin Carroll's 15-game on-base streak to start the season is the longest by a D-back since David Peralta (16 G from 3/29-4/20/2018)...only 5 D-backs have recorded on-base streaks of 16+ games: Peralta, Miguel Montero (16 G from 4/1-21/2011), Gerardo Parra (17 G from 5/13-6/1/2009), Orlando Hudson (33 G from 4/2-5/6/2007) and Luis Gonzalez (35 G from 4/5-5/18, 1999).

- Dating back to Sept. 23, 2024, Carroll has reached base in 21 straight games to match his career high (also: July 7-Aug. 4, 2024)...is the second longest active streak in the span, behind Jacob Wilson/ATH (22).
- Entering today, 3 players in the Majors have reached base in 15+ straight games to start their respective seasons: Corbin Carroll (15 G), Jacob Wilson/ATH (15 G) and Kristian Campbell/BOS (15 G).

CARROLL IN THE LEADOFF: Corbin Carroll ranks among the Majors in the leadoff spot (min. 30 PA) in SLG (1st, .872, ahead of F. Tatis Jr.-SD/.615), OPS (1st, 1.290, ahead of F. Tatis Jr.-SD/1.049), isolated (raw) power [SLG-minus-AVG] (1st, .513, ahead of K. Schwarber-PHI/.343), home run rate (1st, 11.6%, ahead of K. Schwarber-PHI/9.3%) and extra-base hits (1st, 9, ahead of 3 others/6).

EXIT VELOCITY: Corbin Carroll's 106.5 average exit velocity on his hardest 50 pct. of batted balls ranks sixth in MLB, behind James Wood/WSH (108.0), Aaron Judge/NYY (107.7), Pete Alonso/NYM (107.3), Gunnar Henderson/BAL (107.2) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (107.0).

STARTING PITCHER RHYTHM: D-backs starting arms have tossed 4 consecutive quality bids for the first time since June 18-21, 2024 (3 G @ WSH, 1 G @ PHI): **Merrill Kelly** (W) on April 8 vs. Orioles, **Brandon Pfaadt** (W) on April 9 vs. Orioles, **Eduardo Rodriguez** (L) on April 11 vs. Brewers and **Corbin Burnes** (ND) on April 12 vs. Brewers...Arizona's last string of 5+ consecutive quality starts was from July 3-12, 2018.

TRENDING BATS:

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 14 of his 15 games played this season...is hitting .340 (17-for-50)/.929 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 13 RBI, 10 walks and 2 stolen bases.
- Pavin Smith, in 9 starts, is hitting .393 (11-for-28)/1.112 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 4 walks
- **Josh Naylor** has hit safely in 5 of his last 6 games, hitting .381 (8-for-21)/1.107 with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI, 3 walks and 1 stolen base.

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

• Named the 2024 D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona Chapter of the BBWAA for the fourth time ('20, '22, '23) after going 14-6 with a 3.65 ERA (62 R-60 ER in 148.0 IP), opponent .237 AVG (133-for-561), 54 walks and 156 strikeouts over 28 starts.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Fourth start of the season, third home start.

• The D-backs are 4-0 in Gallen's last 4 starts vs. Brewers dating back to April 10, 2023 (3-0; 3.00 ERA (8 ER in 24.0 IP, 5 BB, 27 K).

LAST START: Took the loss on April 7 vs. Orioles (5 ER in 4.2 IP, 7 H, 4 BB, 2 K).

VS. BREWERS: Ninth career start...in 2 starts in 2024, went 1-0 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER in 10.0 IP, 3 BB, 12 K).

• Has tossed 5.0+ innings in each start, walked 2 or fewer batters in 7 of his 8 starts and struckout 7+ batters in 5 of his 8 starts.

VS. NL CENTRAL: In 27 career starts (12 quality), has gone 12-9 with a 3.06 ERA (56 R-53 ER in 156.0 IP) and 166 strikeouts.

• In 14 home starts, is 6-4 with a 2.55 ERA (24 ER in 84.2 IP) and 97 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES: Holding righties to a .080 AVG (2-for-25)/.179/.080/.259 with 3 walks and 7 strikeouts.

HEART OF THE ORDER: Against hitters 3-5 in opposing lineups, owns an opponent .136 AVG (3-for-22)/.558 OPS with 3 walks and 7strikeouts.

WHIFF RATE: His 20.9% whiff rate ranks eighth among NL right-handed starting pitchers.

AMONG THE MAJORS: Is 1 of 11 active MLB starters to collect 10+ wins in each of the last 3 seasons (since 2022) with Corbin Burnes/BAL, Kevin Gausman/TOR, Chris Bassitt/TOR, Zack Wheeler/PHI, Framber Valdez/HOU, José Berríos/TOR, Aaron Nola/PHI, Pablo López/MIN, Michael Wacha/KC and Logan Webb/SF].

• Since 2019, his 21 starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings, 6+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer hits allowed are second most in the Majors, behind Blake Snell/SF (24), ahead of Corbin Burnes (19).

HOME COOKIN: In 15 home games in 2024, went 8-3 with a 3.36 ERA (33 R-31 ER in 83.0 IP), 90 strikeouts, .235 opponent average and 5 home runs allowed.

• Ranks among D-backs pitchers all-time at home (min. 50 starts) in ERA (2nd, 3.08), WHIP (3rd, 1.10), home runs allowed (3rd, 41), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (3rd, 10.08), wins (3rd, 32), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4th, 3.84), walks (5th, 120) and strikeouts (5th, 461).

2024 RECAP: Posted his third straight season of 12+ wins.

- In 15 home games in 2024, went 8-3 with a 3.36 ERA (33 R-31 ER in 83.0 IP), 90 strikeouts, .235 opponent average and 5 home runs allowed.
- On June 29 vs. Athletics (6.0 IP, 2 BR), recorded his fourth start as a D-back of 6.0+ innings pitched and 2-or-fewer baserunners allowed (H, BB, HBP), which tied for second most such outings in team history (also: Josh Collmenter), behind Randy Johnson (6).
- Recorded his 750th strikeout as a D-back on June 29 vs. Athletics (sixth in franchise history).
- On July 4 @ Dodgers, recorded his 800th career strikeout in the fourth inning (S. Ohtani).
- Recorded his 50th career win on Sept. 4 @ Giants
- Struck out a season-high 11 batters on Sept. 25 vs. Giants.

SUPPORT FOR ZAC: In 2024, went 6-2 with a 2.61 ERA (15 ER in 51.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts in 9 games when the offense scores 3-5 runs for him... when the offense scored 6+ runs, Gallen went 8-0 with a 3.77 ERA (32 R-31 ER in 74.0 IP) and 76 strikeouts over 14 games.

UNCORK FOR A CAUSE: His first charity event, Uncork For A Cause benefitting the Zac Gallen Charitable Fund, on May 15, 2024, raised \$100,000 for St. Mary's Food Bank to ensure children will receive milk during the difficult summer months.

 The 250 guests enjoyed an exclusive wine tasting soiree featuring limited-edition autographed bottles of Gallen's very own Sonoma Reserve Red Wine.

2023 ALL-STAR STARTER: Named to his first All-Star Game in 2023 and earned the starting nod...tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with 1 strikeout.

- At 27 years old, became the youngest D-backs pitcher, third overall (fourth time) and first since Curt Schilling (35 in 2002) to start an All-Star Game (also: Randy Johnson; 36 in 2000 and 37 in 2001.
- Was the youngest NL starting pitcher since Matt Harvey/NYM in 2013 (24).

MILKMAN DELIVERED: Tossed his first career 9.0-inning shutout on Sept. 8, 2023 @ Cubs with 3 hits allowed and 9 strikeouts.

- Previously had a 7.0-inning, complete-game shutout on April 25, 2023 – Game 1 @ Braves (7.0 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- Fourth D-backs pitcher (sixth time) to toss 9.0 or more innings, 0 runs, 3 or fewer hits, 1 or fewer walks and 9 or more strikeouts (also: Curt Schilling on April 10, 2001 and May 14, 2003; Randy Johnson on Sept. 14, 2003 and May 18, 2004; Ian Kennedy on April 25, 2011).

HOW HE STARTED: Cardinals' third-round pick in the 2016 draft out of the University of North Carolina.
