TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 3-city, 10-game road trip with the 1st of 4 games against the Oakland Athletics...are coming off a series win at Kansas City (2-1)...will also travel to Los Angeles-AL (3 G, 9/24-9/26) on the trip...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners defeated the Royals by a 7-1 score yesterday to capture the series victory...have won 10 of their last 17 games and 11 of their last 19...are 21-14 over their last 35 games, 22-15 over their last 37, 24-20 over their last 44, 29-23 over their last 52, 35-27 over their last 62, 46-33 over their last 79, 49-34 over their last 83 and 59-43 over their last 102...are 32-22 in day games and 48-47 at night...are 42-33 at T-Mobile Park and 38-36 on the road...are 64-25 when scoring at least 4 runs and 16-44 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 52-9 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **80 Grade** - The Mariners clinch at least a .500 season with their next victory, which would be win #81.
- **Series Openers** - The Mariners are 29-19 (.604) in series openers this season.
- **Vs. Lefties** - Seattle is 31-26 (.544) in games against left-handed starting pitchers.
- **Series Record** - The Mariners own a 16-9-2 series record since June 14, winning or splitting 18 of their last 27...the Mariners own a 24-19-5 overall series record this season.

LONG DIVISION...the Mariners close out the 2021 regular season with 13 consecutive American League West Division games starting with tonight's matchup at Oakland...Seattle owns a 37-26 (.587) record against divisional opponents this season.

KELENIC IN SEPTEMBER...Jarred Kelenic reached base a career-high 4 times in yesterday's game...he went 3-for-4 with 2 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 1 walk...in 16 September games, Kelenic is batting .283 (17x60) with 12 runs, 4 doubles, 6 home runs, 15 RBI, 6 walks and 2 stolen bases...he's gotten on-base at a .348 clip, slugging .650 with a .998 OPS...his 6 home runs and 39 total bases lead American League rookies during the month, while his 15 RBI are tied for the lead with Bobby Dalbec-BOS.

FRANCE FRANCE REVOLUTION...Ty France reached base safely 4 times yesterday....he went 3-for-4 with a run, double, RBI and walk...he's reached base safely in 11 of his last 13 plate appearances...this season, France is batting .294 (15x523) with 74 runs, 29 doubles, 1 triple, 16 home runs, 63 RBI, 40 walks and a league-leading 24 hit-by-pitches, getting on-base at a .368 clip, slugging .446 with an .814 OPS...he's batting .336 (77x229) since the All-Star Break, leading the American League with 77 hits in that span.

162 GAMES OF TY...Ty France made his 162nd career appearance with the Mariners yesterday...in 162 games with Seattle, France is batting .296 (180x609) with 84 runs scored, 34 doubles, 2 triples, 18 home runs, 76 RBI, 46 walks and 26 hit-by-pitches...he has a .367 on-base percentage, .447 slugging percentage and an .814 OPS with the Mariners...he's compiled 4.5 WAR (*Baseball-Reference*) with Seattle.

GOING DOWN THE ONLY 'ROAD' I'VE EVER KNOWN...the Mariners are 13-5 over their last 18 road games...their .722 road winning percentage is best in the American League since Aug. 8 and 3rd-best in the Majors to San Francisco (.813/13-3) and St. Louis (.737/14-5)...Seattle has won 4 of its last 6 road series since Aug. 17.

PITCHING OVER THE LAST 50 DAYS...since August 1, the Mariners pitching staff has the fewest walks (110) and lowest walks-per-9 innings (2.46) in the Majors...in 44 games since August 1, the pitching staff has the 2nd-highest strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.21) in the American League, trailing only Toronto (3.74).

GETTING ON BASE AT THE TOP...J.P. Crawford has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games, hitting safely in 14 of 18...he's batting .292 (21x72) with 14 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 10 RBI and 12 walks in that span, getting on-base at a .388 clip, slugging .417 with an .805 OPS since August 30.

SADLER'S STREAK...Casey Sadler has not allowed a run over his last 22 appearances since July 27...the streak has spanned 19.2 innings, with Sadler walking 4 and striking out 16 during the streak...opponents are batting just .143 (9x63) against him in that stretch...his 22-outing scoreless streak is tied for 2nd-longest in Mariners history with Lucas Luetge (Apr. 17-June 15, 2012) and Ed Vande Berg (Aug. 30, 1982-Apr. 16, 1983)...the trio trail only Shigetoshi Hasegawa's franchise record 25-game scoreless streak...Hasegawa did not allow a run in 25 consecutive appearances from June 3-Aug. 17, 2003.

THE BULLPEN...the Mariners have the 3rd-best bullpen in the Majors this season by *FanGraphs* WAR (6.3), trailing Tampa Bay (7.0) and Chicago-AL (6.8)...Seattle relievers are 40-27 with 43 saves and a 3.98 ERA (251 ER, 567.2 IP) with 193 walks and 561 strikeouts.

SECOND-HALF SEAGS...Kyle Seager has 18 home runs and 46 RBI since the All-Star Break...the 18 home runs are tied for 3rd-most in the American League since the break with Vladimir Guerrero Jr.-TOR and Marcus Semien-TOR, trailing Salvador Perez-KC (24) and Jorge Polanco-MIN (19)...Seager has 34 home runs and 96 RBI this season...he is 3 RBI away from matching his season-high 99 RBI in 2016...he is 4 RBI away from becoming the first Mariners player with at least 100 RBI in a season since Nelson Cruz had 119 RBI in 2017.

ONE-RUN GAMES...Seattle has played 49 one-run games, most in the American League and 4th-most in the Majors, trailing New York-NL (61), Atlanta (52) and Philadelphia (51)...the Mariners are 31-18 in 1-run games, with their 31 one-run wins leading the Majors and their .633 winning percentage ranking 2nd in the AL and 3rd in the Majors to Los Angeles-AL (.657/23-12) and San Francisco (.651/28-15).

PITCHES PER PLATE APPEARANCE...Seattle batters are averaging 4.00 pitches per plate appearance this season, 2nd-most in the Major Leagues...the New York Yankees lead MLB with 4.09 pitches per plate appearance...San Francisco (3.97), Detroit (3.96) and Baltimore (3.95) round out the top five.

WINNING MONTHS...the Mariners are 9-7 in September...they finished August 15-13 (.536), their 3rd straight winning month...the Mariners went 14-12 (.538) in June and 14-10 (.583) in July...Seattle last recorded 3 consecutive winning months from March/April-June 2017...this season, the Mariners have put together a winning record in 4 of 5 months...they went 15-12 (.556) in April and 13-15 (.464) in May...the Mariners have put together a winning record in 5 of their last 6 months, going 12-11 (.522) in Sept. 2020.

AS YOU KNOW...Jake Bauers homered off Kansas City starter Jackson Kowar yesterday...the home run traveled a projected 460 feet per Statcast, the longest hit by a Mariners player this season, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that it was the 7th-farthest home run hit by a Mariners player in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) and the farthest home run hit by a left-handed Mariners player?...only Mike Zunino (2 HR, most recent: 6/29/2018) and Nelson Cruz (4 HR, most recent: 6/22/2018) have recorded home runs for Seattle that traveled farther than Bauers' 460-foot blast...**AND LASTLY**...Bauers' home run surpassed Robinson Canó's 449-foot home run on Sept. 22, 2015, also in the 3rd inning at Kauffman Stadium, as the farthest home run hit by a Mariners left-handed batter in the *Statcast* era.

ABOUT ANDERSON...

- 31-year-old left-hander is making his 110th career start (114th appearance), his 28th start of 2021 (10th with Seattle) and 1st against Oakland this year.
- Acquired by the Mariners from PIT July 28 in exchange for minor leaguers Carter Bins (c) and Joaquin Tejada (rhp).
- Originally drafted by MIN in the 50th round of the 2008 MLB Draft but did not sign...selected 3 years later (2011) by COL in the 1st round (20th overall) out of the Univ. of Oregon.
- Made his Major League debut June 12, 2016 vs. SD, tossing 6.1 innings and allowing 1 run on 6 hits; 0 walks & 6 SO.
- Played 3 collegiate seasons at Oregon where he went 17-17 with a 3.60 ERA (117 ER, 292.1 IP) with 107 walks and 285 strikeouts in 47 career appearances (46 starts)...set UO records in single-game strikeouts (14), single-season innings pitched (107.2), single-season strikeouts (114), career starts (46) and career strikeouts (285).
- Has appeared in parts of 6 Major League seasons with Colorado (2016-19), San Francisco (2020), Pittsburgh (2021) and Seattle (2021).

LAST OUTING...ND in last start on 9/14 in Mariners loss against Boston...allowed just 1 run on 4 hits and 1 walk in 4.1 innings...failed to go 5.0 innings for the 2nd consecutive start after going 5.0 innings in each of his previous 27 starts.

GIMME FIVE...pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 25 starts this season and each of his previous 27 starts dating back to Sept. 20, 2020...his 25-game streak of 5.0+ IP is the 2nd-longest in the Majors this season, trailing only Walker Buehler (27 GS) while ranking ahead of Frankie Montas (24 GS)

LATELY...has allowed 3 runs or less in 8 of 9 starts with the Mariners and 2 or less in 5 of 9 starts...pitched to a 3.67 ERA (20 ER, 49.0 IP)...the Mariners are 5-4 in games started by Anderson

VALUE...has tallied 2.1 WAR (*Fangraphs*) this season ranking tied for 2nd-most among all Mariners pitchers (also: **Logan Gilbert**-2.1)...he trails only **Chris Flexen** (2.7) while ranking ahead of **Paul Sewald** (1.4), **Drew Steckenrider** (1.1), and **Yusei Kikuchi** (1.1).

WELL TRAVELED...Anderson made his 1st career start against Boston in his last time out, and has now faced 26 of the 30 MLB teams...has not pitched against Baltimore, Cleveland, Minnesota, and Pittsburgh.

(ALMOST) LONE RANGERS...Anderson made 3 of his first 4 Seattle appearances vs. TEX, posting a 1-0, 2.70 mark (5 ER, 16.2 IP) in the games.

WELCOME TO SEATTLE...Acquired by Mariners from Pittsburgh July 28 in exchange for minor leaguers Carter Bins (c) and Joaquin Tejada (rhp).

SEE YA STEEL CITY...ND in his last outing with Pittsburgh July 20 vs. Arizona...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 3 runs on 7 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts, using only 77 pitches (56 strikes)...start marked the 100th of his career.

JULY GUY...holds a career record of 6-2 with a 3.02 ERA (31 ER, 92.1 IP) with 26 walks and 73 strikeouts in the month of July...the 3.02 ERA is his lowest in any month during his career, ranking ahead of his 3.09 ERA in September...in 4 starts in July this season, was 2-0 with a 3.09 ERA (8 ER, 23.1 IP) with 3 walks and 17 strikeouts.

PIRATE'S LIFE...made 18 starts with the Pirates in 2021 before being acquired by the Mariners at the trade deadline...with Pittsburgh, went 5-8 with a 4.35 ERA (50 ER, 103.1 IP) with 25 walks and 86 strikeouts...signed with the Pirates as a free agent on Feb. 17.

SNAKE CHARMER...went the distance pitching for the Giants in a 5-1 win over the Diamondbacks on Aug. 22, 2020 to record his first career complete game...tossed 9.0 innings and allowed 1 run (unearned) on 3 hits with no walks and 4 strikeouts...also marked his first win of the 2020 season.

#100...made his 100th career start (104th appearance) on July 20, 2021 at Arizona with Pittsburgh.

#500...recorded his 500th career strikeout on August 5, against the Yankees when he got Gleyber Torres to strike out swining for the 1st out of the 4th inning.

POST-SEASON...made his first post-season start in Game #2 of the 2018 NLDS with the Rockies at Milwaukee...tossed 6.0 strong innings, surrendering only 1 run on 4 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts...has made one other post-season appearance, tossing 1.0 inning in relief in the 2017 NLWC with Colorado at Arizona...overall, is 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (3 ER, 7.0 IP) with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts in post-season play.

29-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 23rd start of the season tomorrow against the Athletics ...is 7-0, 2.70 (22 ER, 73.1 IP) in last 12 GS since July 9...ND in last start 9/15 vs. BOS (6.0,3,3,3,2,7,HR)...W #8 on 9/10 (6.0,4,3,0,1,3, 1 HR), marked his career-best 7th consecutive win dating back to 7/20...W#5 on 8/18 at TEX w/5.1 ShO IP...threw 3rd career CG 8/12 vs. TEX (9.0,2,1,1,1,9,HR)...W#1 on April 15(#1) at BAL (5.0,3,2,2,5,HR); allowed 2R in 1st but retired 12 of last 13 BF in 2nd-5th...L#1 April 8 at MIN (4.1,9,7,7,2,6,HB,2HR)...ND in Opening Night start on April 1 vs. SF (6.0,8,5,5,3,2,3HR); made 3rd Opening Day start in his career...is the 4th Mariners pitcher in history to make 3 or more Opening Night starts, joining Félix Hernández (11), Randy Johnson (6) and Jamie Moyer (4)...**CAREER:** Drafted by St. Louis with 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...made MLB debut with the Cardinals on June 25, 2014 at Colorado...was acquired from STL on July 21, 2017 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...is 47-32 with a 4.08 ERA (283 ER, 624.0 IP) with 503 strikeouts in 115 games (107 starts) in parts of 7 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c)...**vs. OAK** Gonzales is making his 14th career start against the A's...is 1-0 with a 3.45 ERA (6 ER, 15.2 IP) in 3 games against the A's this season.
