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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore and Chicago-NL wrap up their three-game series today before the Orioles close out the pre-All-Star schedule with a three-game set against the Royals at Camden Yards beginning Friday...The O's enter play 13.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 4.5 games back in the Wild Card.

👉 The Birds have dropped three games in a row after winning three straight games from July 1-4...The club has lost nine of 13 since June 23, matching a season-low at nine games under .500 (also 39-48 on 6/30).

👉 The Orioles tallied 14 hits and hit four homers yesterday, their most in a game since June 21 at Los Angeles-NL (15 H & 4 HR)...It's the most hits for the team at Camden Yards since May 27 vs. Tampa Bay (16 H) and the most homers at Oriole Park since April 24 vs. Boston (6 HR).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** hit two home runs, including a pinch-hit blast...He's the second player in the majors this year with two home runs after not starting the game, joining NYY's Trent Grisham on April 13 vs. Los Angeles-AL...O'Neill is the sixth Oriole (since 1954) to homer twice after not starting the game and the first since Ramón Laureano on April 19, 2025 vs. Cincinnati.

👉 **Coby Mayo** and O'Neill hit back-to-back home runs in the eighth inning, the fourth time the O's have hit consecutive homers this season (last: 6/19 at LAD, 6th, Henderson & Alonso)...Mayo's was also a pinch-hit home run, marking the fifth time in O's history (since 1954) that the team has hit two pinch-hit homers in the same game (last: 8/8/20 at WSH, 8th, Pat Valaika & Pedro Severino)...Valaika and Severino did so back-to-back.

👉 **Jackson Holliday** tied a career high with four hits last night (3x, last: 7/6/25 at ATL)...He entered the game 4-for-29 (.138) in his previous 13 games (10 GS)...With his second hit, he collected his 200th career knock.

OPENING STATEMENTS: The Orioles rotation has posted a 3.71 ERA in 44 games since May 20, the fifth-best starter ERA in the AL and eighth best in the majors during that time.

👉 Prior to this stretch, the club posted a 5.20 ERA from its starters, third worst in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.69) and Nationals (5.25) through May 19.

NO CUBS NO: The Orioles and Cubs meet this week for the only series between the teams this season...Chicago took two of three against Baltimore at Wrigley Field last year, which was the first series for both teams following the trade deadline.

👉 The O's are 8-19 (.296) against the Cubs since the teams first met in 2003, their lowest winning percentage against one opponent all-time...The Birds have lost six home games in a row and are 2-11 (.154) against Chicago at Oriole Park, the lowest winning percentage against one team at the ballpark (since 1992).

ALL-STAR ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024).

👉 Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).

👉 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).

👉 Baseball Savant credits Rutschman with a Fielding Run Value of nine, tied with DET's Dillon Dingler and TOR's Brandon Valenzuela for the highest figure among all catchers and tied for the seventh-highest clip among all position players behind STL's JJ Wetherholt (17), CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (16), KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (13), BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (11), and LAD's Andy Pages and WSH's Jacob Young (both 10).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 84 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Athletics (80 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in 13 straight games, their third such streak this season (15 G, 5/29-6/13 & 14 G, 4/28-5/11).

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

👉 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 355 walks this year.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** ranks third in the AL and 10th in the majors with 62 RBI...He is batting .276/.358/.522 (64-for-232) with nine doubles, 16 homers, 38 runs, 49 RBI, 30 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 62 games since May 1.

👉 Last night, he became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 37 home runs in 2013.

👉 Alonso is the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...The last Oriole with more than 63 RBI before the break is Manny Machado, who had 65 in 2018...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 93 RBI in 2013.

👉 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and has played 509 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (872 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .362/.407/.517 (54-for-149) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 19 runs, 27 RBI, 10 walks (1 IBB), six stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 54 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 125 PA) in batting average (1st) and on-base percentage (T-4th)...He has eight three-hit games since the beginning of May, tied for second most in the majors during that time with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, behind MIA's Otto Lopez (9).

👉 Alexander is batting .373 (19-for-51) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, and 25 RBI with runners in scoring position.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 70) and times on base (4th, 161)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 Ward's .264 slugging percentage at home is .182 points lower than on the road (.446)...He has yet to homer at Camden Yards as a member of the Orioles while 15 of his 19 doubles have been on the road.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 17th start of the season and 119th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third straight win on July 3 at Cincinnati after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits and five walks with four strikeouts...Threw 93 pitches, 57 strikes.

👉 Rogers became the first O's starter to throw 5.0+ scoreless innings while issuing 5+ walks since Wade Miley on April 9, 2017 vs. New York-AL (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 7 BB, 5 K)...He became the first to earn a victory in such an outing since Bud Norris on September 17, 2014 vs. Toronto (5.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 5 BB, 4 K).

👉 Has not permitted a home run in a season-high four consecutive starts.

THE NORTH SIDE: Rogers is set to make his second career start opposite the Cubs...Faced them on August 1, 2025 at Wrigley Field and took the loss despite tossing his first career complete game, allowing one run on four hits with zero walks and eight strikeouts.

👉 Is 5-5 with a 3.42 ERA (30 ER/79.0 IP) in 15 career starts against the NL Central.

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last four starts since June 14, Rogers is 3-1 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER/24.1 IP), .155 (13-for-84) opponent average, and 0.90 WHIP...Over five June starts, Rogers went 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER/30.2 IP) and a .510 opponent OPS.

👉 Among all MLB pitchers who threw at least 30.0 innings in June, Rogers' 2.05 ERA was ninth lowest in the majors, including third lowest in the AL behind TB's Drew Rasmussen (0.82) and CLE's Tanner Bibee (1.89).

👉 He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past three starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .048 (1-for-21) clip with one double and eight strikeouts.

👉 Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.

👉 Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .324/.390/.450 (36-for-111) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 28 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

👉 Opponents are slashing .463/.542/.707 (19-for-41) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

ORDER OF OPERATIONS: Rogers has held the opposition to a .191 (26-for-136) batting average the first time through the order... However, they are hitting .293 (36-for-123) the second time through and .294 (20-for-68) the third time around.

👉 Nine-hole hitters are slashing .367/.406/.467 (11-for-30) with three doubles off Rogers.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

👉 His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).

Thirty-two of his 39 outings this year have been scoreless, including 12 of his last 13 since 6/4...His 25 hitless appearances are tied for fourth in the majors...Has allowed 16 hits in his last 15 appearances (9.2 IP) since 5/27

His 61.4 percent ground ball rate is sixth lowest in MLB (min. 25.0 IP)
