FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their season-ending six-game road trip with the second game of a three-game series against the Colorado Rockies tonight at Coors Field ... St. Louis enters today a half game behind Chicago (81-77) in 3rd place in the National League Central Division ... The Cardinals need one more win to end at .500 and at least two victories for a winning season record (82+ wins).

TAP THE ROCKIES: A win tonight would give St. Louis a winning season series vs. the Rockies for the 24th time in 31 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993 ... The Cardinals have won three straight here at Coors (April 11, 2023-present) for the first time since June 10, 2015-Sept. 20, 2016 ... The Redbirds have won a franchise-best four in a row in Denver on four occasions, last doing so from May 30, 2007-May 6, 2008.

ROYCROFT RECALLED: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals recalled RHP Chris Roycroft from Memphis (AAA) and placed LHP JoJo Romero on the 15-Day Injured List with left forearm flex inflammation, retroactive to Sept. 22 ... Today marks Roycroft's 6th recall and 7th stint with St. Louis during his MLB debut season.

WINSANITY: Rookie shortstop Masyn Winn (age 22-187) homered in his first career game at Coors Field last night ... Among players to homer in Coors Field or Mile High Stadium debuts since 1993, Winn became the

youngest Cardinal and the 3rd-youngest MLB shortstop ever behind Houston's Carlos Correa (20 years & 268 days on June 17, 2015) & San Diego's CJ Abrams (21-281 on July 11, 2022) ... Younger Cardinals to ever go yard in Denver include 21-year-old Albert Pujols (3x) & Nolan Gorman (22-093). - Elias

• Winn's 150th hit of the season last night was also his 15th HR ... The 22-year-old is the only Cards rookie (any position) and the 4th MLB primary rookie SS all-time w/ 15+ HR, 10+ SB, and 150+ hits, joining 2006 ROY **Hanley Ramirez** (17-51-185 w/ FLA), 2003 ROY **Ángel Berroa** (17-21-163 w/ KC), and 1997 ROY **Nomar Garciaparra** (30-22-209 w/ BOS). - *min. 80% at SS* 

KID'S CLUB: The Cardinals lead MLB this season in combined games (984) by players age 25 or younger, 5th-most in franchise history behind 1937 (1,008 g), 1973 (1,042 g), 1977 (1,084 g), and 1974 (1,089 g) ... Over the last six seasons (2019-24) across Major League Baseball, only the Cleveland Guardians from 2023 (1,041 g) and 2022 (1,038 g) have had more.

NADO DINGERS: With his next home run, Nolan Arenado would pass Carlos "Cargo" Gonzalez (139 HR) for 3rd all-time at Coors Field, pass Whitey Kurowski (106 HR) for 4th all-time among Cardinals primary third baseman, and reach 342 for his career to tie Evan Longoria, Ron Santo, & Manny Machado for 13th all-time among primary third baseman.

AN ERA OF EXCELLENCE: It has been 65 years since the Cardinals last experienced back-to-back losing campaigns in full seasons from 1958-59 (excluding seasons shortened by war, work stoppages, or COVID), the 2nd-longest all-time timespan by any franchise of the four major North American sports leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, & NHL).

- The NHL's Montreal Canadiens hold the record of 80 years between consecutive full losing seasons occurring from 1938-39 to 1941-42 (4 seasons), and then again during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.
- The Los Angeles Dodgers have the 2nd-longest active streak, last experiencing losing seasons 37 years ago from 1986-87.

MATHEWS NAMED BA PITCHER OF THE YEAR: Baseball America yesterday named Cardinals 23-year-old left-hander Quinn Mathews as its 2024 Pitcher of the Year, joining RHP Rick Ankiel (1999 Player of the Year) as the only two Cards prospects to earn BA's Player/Pitcher of the Year honors in publication history ... The Cardinals 2023 4th round pick out of Stanford Univ. went 8-5 with a 2.76 ERA (143.1 IP) and a minor league-leading 202 strikeouts in 26 starts across four levels ... His 202 strikeouts rank 10th among Cardinals minor leaguers since 1962, while Mathews joins Arizona's Brandon Pfaadt (218 in 2022) as the only two with 200-strikeout seasons in the minors in the past 13 years (2012-24).

#### **COLORADO CONNECTIONS**

Nolan Arenado played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for Austin Gomber, Elehuris Montero, Tony Locey, Mateo Gil and Jake Sommers.

Nolan Arenado's cousin, Josh Fuentes, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist Univ. (2014).

Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

**Kyle Leahy** was born in and resides in Boulder... graduated from Erie High School, and selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

Austin Gomber pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitch ers of the Year honors with **Alex Reyes** in 2015.

Dakota Hudson pitched six seasons and the 2019 Postseason (2018-23) with St. Louis, where he made his MLB debut...selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#34) of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Daniel Bard made 10 appearances for Springfield (AA) in 2017.

John Mozeliak began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in base-ball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season... graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher. graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director Randy Flores pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Matt Holliday was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Rockies Special Assistant to the GM Clint Hurdle played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Rockies MLB.com Thomas Harding covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer Anne Rogers.

Louis Post-Dispatch columnist Benjamin **Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter Derrick Goold is originally from Boulder, Colo...attended Centaurus High School in Lafayette, Colo...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator Kevin Collins previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager Nora Farrell previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

Rockies VP Ticket Sales, Ops & Svcs. Sue Ann Mc-Claren worked 15 seasons (1978-92) in the Cards sales department before joining the Rockies in 1992.

- Makes his 31st start of the season and his 10th since joining the Cardinals.
- Established new single-season highs in starts (30), appearances (30), wins (8), innings pitched (170.1) and strikeouts (144). Currently sporting a single-season low 3.38 ERA.
- Needs four more strikeouts for 500 in his Major League career.
- · Making his 5th career start (6th app.) vs. Colorado and first as a member of the Car-
- Pitched 180.1 innings and 30 starts for the NC Dinos in the KBO in 2023, which were professional career highs.
- His 146 strikeouts this season are the most in his Major League career. He had 209 K's for the NC Dinos in the KBO last season.
- Is looking to snap a career-high four-game losing skid (Aug. 13-present). The Cardinals are 2-7 in his games started.
- Held his opposition to one run or less in 13 starts this season. T-10th among MLB pitchers.
- Has made nine starts with St. Louis, going 1-5 with a 4.07 ERA (48.2 IP) and 36 strikeouts. Is 1-2 with a 2.11 ERA at Busch Stadium in his four home starts as a member of the Cardinals and 0-3 with a 5.60 ERA in five road starts with St. Louis.
- Ranks in the Top-25 in MLB in both ERA (3.38, 18th) and opponent's BA (.232, 21st).
- His only win with the Cardinals was Aug. 7 vs. Tampa Bay at Busch, limiting the Rays to one run over 5.0 innings with four hits, while throwing 93 pitches.
- Has received one run of support or fewer in 11 of his 30 starts. Is 6-1 in starts during which he receives three runs of support or more this season. Received 2 runs or fewer in 8 of his 9 starts with St. Louis, and zero runs twice.
- · Struck out a career-high 11 batters over 6.0 innings at Minnesota on April 23.
- Ran off four straight winning decisions to start the year, establishing a new career-best winning streak from April 17-May 14, including consecutive scoreless starts vs. CLE (5/9) and vs. WSH (5/14) covering a season-high 14.0 inning scoreless streak.
- Had a positive home/road split after going 5-2 with a 1.87 ERA at Chicago's Guaranteed Rate Field, ranking 4th in Major League Baseball in home ERA.

- run over 6.0 innings and departed with a 2-1 lead. The Cardinals bullpen allowed two runs in a 3-2 loss to the Pirates at Busch Stadium giving him a no decision.
