BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game homestand today against Philadelphia (1-1, 1 to play) and Los Angeles-AL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a brief three-game road trip in Detroit, taking two of three from the Tigers...The Orioles have won 15 of 24 games since July 1 and are 11.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 1.5 games back in the Wild Card.

🦅 The Orioles were shut out for the third time this season...The three shutouts are third fewest in the majors behind the Dodgers and Nationals (both two).

🦅 **Shane Baz** has not allowed a home run in six straight starts, the second-longest such streak of his career trailing a career-high eight-gamer from August 26, 2025-April 4, 2026...His three walks allowed over his last four games tie a career low for a single four-game span in his career (also 9/17/24-4/1/25).

🦅 **Andrew Kittredge's** career-high 15-game streak without an earned run allowed came to an end in the eighth inning after allowing two earned runs on three hits, one walk, and one wild pitch in 0.1 inning pitched.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead all of MLB with 25 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (21) and Braves and Mets (both 20).

🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season while **Samuel Basallo**, **Colton Cowser**, **Christian Encarnacion-Strand**, **Jackson Holliday**, **Tyler O'Neill**, and **Adley Rutschman** are all tied for second with two pinch-hit RBI each.

🦅 The 25 pinch-hit RBI are the most by the Orioles since 1999 (also 25)...An O's club has not had more than 25 pinch-hit RBI in a season since 1991 (30).

ENCARNACION-DOES-NOT-STRAND: **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** is slashing .306/.375/.611 (11-for-36) with two doubles, three homers, 11 RBI, and four walks (1 IBB) in 10 games this season, all with the Orioles.

🦅 He is the second player in Orioles history (since 1954) to tally at least 11 hits, five extra-base hits, 11 RBI, and four walks in his first 10 games with the club, joining **Albert Belle** in 1999 (13 H, 5 XBH, 12 RBI, 7 BB).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 102 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Tigers (37 G).

🦅 Baltimore has secured a walk in 102 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025.

🦅 The current 102-game stretch is the third-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), trailing streaks of 112 games (1995) and 104 games (1975).

🦅 **Taylor Ward** has 87 walks this season, 25 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and nine more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 80 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since **Albert Belle** (101) in 1999.

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 434 walks.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: In 19 games since July 8, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .404/.500/.462 (21-for-52) with three doubles, seven runs, six RBI, and 11 walks (1 IBB).

🦅 Since July 22, his .441 batting average ranks third in MLB behind LAD's Freddie Freeman (.568) and HOU's Jeremy Peña (.442)...His .500 on-base percentage is tied for third in this span with HOU's Yordan Alvarez, trailing only Freeman (.579) and BOS' Willson Contreras (.513).

🦅 Holliday owns a 14.6 percent walk rate (28 BB/192 PA) across 59 games this season after recording an 8.6 percent clip (56 BB/649 PA) in 2025.

🦅 His 16 walks in July were third most in the AL, trailing teammate **Taylor Ward** (20) and HOU's Yordan Alvarez (17), and ranked tied for seventh in the majors.

MAKING A CASE FOR GOLD: **Colton Cowser** leads all Orioles defenders with eight outs above average (OAA) and six defensive runs saved (DRS).

🦅 His eight OAA are tied for third among all AL outfielders with TB's Cedric Mullins behind BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (13) and CWS' Tristan Peters (9)...Cowser accrued 0 OAA in 2025 after having a career-high 11 OAA in 2024.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** owns a career-high 4 OAA after posting -9 OAA in each of his last two seasons...The 4 OAA are tied for second among all AL first basemen with NYY's Paul Goldschmidt behind TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (5).

NOT A PHAIR PHIGHT: **Taylor Ward** has gone 11-for-33 (.333) with four doubles, two homers, eight RBI, and five walks (1 IBB) in nine career games against Philadelphia.

🦅 **Pete Alonso** has played in a team-high 106 career games against the Phillies, owning an .817 OPS with 25 doubles and 19 homers, including his two-run blast in the first inning on Friday.

🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** owns a .949 OPS against Philadelphia after having homered five times in 16 career games against them.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.60 ERA in 60 games since May 24, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Yankees (3.30), Tigers (3.33), and Red Sox (3.38)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

🦅 The rotation has posted a 3.79 ERA since May 24, the seventh-best starter ERA in the majors during that time...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

🦅 Orioles relievers have a 2.86 ERA since June 16, fifth lowest in the majors behind the Yankees (2.51), Rays (2.57), Red Sox (2.69), and Astros (2.79)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

HOME SWEET HOME: The O's have won six of their last nine games at home since July 9 after having dropped eight of their previous 10 games at Oriole Park from June 27-July 8.

🦅 O's hurlers have posted a 3.79 ERA in 58 games at home this season compared to a 4.70 ERA in 53 away games.

🦅 The Birds also own a .740 OPS when hitting at home compared to a .683 OPS when playing on the road.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 22nd start of the season and 89th of his career today in the series finale vs. Philadelphia...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

☯️ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of an 8-5 Orioles win on July 27 at Detroit, allowing a season-high-tying five runs (4x, last: 6/11 vs. SEA) on 10 hits and one walk in 4.2 innings pitched with four strikeouts...The 10 hits also matched a season high (4/20 at KC)... Threw 93 pitches, 60 strikes.

☯️ Held a 2.03 ERA (9 ER/40.0 IP) with an 0.88 WHIP over his previous five starts from June 17-July 22 (G2).

☯️ Owns a 16.7 percent strikeout rate over his last five starts since June 28...His 20 strikeouts in that span are his fewest over any five-game stretch in his career since April 3-May 6, 2023 (18 K).

UNFAMILIAR FOE: Bradish has made only two starts opposite Philadelphia in his career, going 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2 IP)... Last faced them on June 14, 2024 at Camden Yards, where he didn't factor into the decision of a 5-3 Orioles loss after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings with three hits (2 HR), one walk, and four strikeouts.

☯️ Is 0-3 with a 4.98 ERA (12 ER/21.2 IP) over four Interleague starts this season.

☯️ Has gone 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA (5 ER/29.0 IP) over five career home starts vs. the NL East.

DAY TRIPPER: Bradish is scheduled to make his 13th daytime start of the season...Entering today, his 12 daytime starts are fourth most in MLB behind WSH's Cade Cavalli, NYM's Freddy Peralta, and TB's Drew Rasmussen (all 13).

☯️ Has suffered the loss in a career-high-tying three consecutive day games since June 6 (also 8/20-9/17/22)...Holds a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP) with one quality start over that stretch.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .197/.269/.296 (14-for-71) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, and 26 strikeouts.

☯️ His two runs allowed in the first inning this season are tied for the third fewest in MLB (min. 15 GS) behind DET's Casey Mize (0) and PHI's Jesús Luzardo (1 unearned run).

A TALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES: Bradish has recorded a nine run value on his fastballs this season (sinker, four-seamer), including a run value of five on his sinker and four on his four-seamer...The nine run value ranks in the 91st percentile of MLB...Overall, opponents are slashing .265/.343/.352 (67-for-253) on his fastballs with 11 doubles, one triple, three home runs, and 51 strikeouts to 30 walks.

☯️ However, his breaking balls (slider, curveball) own a negative four run value, which ranks in the bottom 17 percent of MLB... Overall, opponents are slashing .222/.299/.439 (42-for-189) on his breaking pitches with 10 doubles, two triples, nine home runs, and 63 strikeouts to 21 walks.

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish held an 11.8 percent walk rate (47 BB/400 PA) over his first 17 starts of the season, which was the highest mark in the majors among qualified pitchers...Over four starts in July, he yielded just five walks in 101 plate appearances (4.95% walk rate) to lower his walk rate to 10.4 percent this season, tied for the fourth-highest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers.

☯️ His 4.95 percent walk rate in July ranked 10th in the AL (min. 4 GS) ahead of SEA's Logan Gilbert and LAD's Tarik Skubal (both 5.0%).

ABOVE THE CURVE: Opponents went 3-for-18 (.167) with one double off Bradish's curveball over four starts in July after going 6-for-17 (.353) on the pitch with one double and two home runs over five starts in June...Over his first 12 starts this season, he held opponents to a .154 (8-for-52) average on the curve with four doubles and no home runs.

☯️ Bradish's 40.5 percent whiff rate on his curve is the third-highest mark among all AL pitchers (min. 200 curveballs thrown) behind BOS' Ranger Suarez (43.6%) and TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (40.8%).

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 55.5 percent first-pitch strike rate, the second-lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers ahead of CLE's Joey Cantillo (55.1%)...Threw only 12 of 24 (50.0%) first pitches for strikes in his last start on July 27 at Detroit.

☯️ In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.
