AROUND THE HORN

FOURTH LARGEST D-BACKS GIVE BACK 50/50 RAFFLE: Monday night's D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle total of \$340,281 was the fourth largest all-time: 1. June 15, 2025 (Father's Day): \$560,331 | 2. Aug. 10, 2024 (Replica NL Champs Ring Giveaway): \$451,093 | 3. July 4, 2025 (Independence Day): \$397,476 | 4. March 30, 2026 (Home Opener): \$340,281.

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs secured their first series win of the season and seek their first-ever home sweep vs. Tigers [previously swept 3 road series from June 9-11, 2023 (3-0), June 13-14, 2017 (2-0) and June 27-29, 2003 (3-0)].

• The D-backs have swept in their season-opening home series 3 times: April 4-6, 2000 vs. Phillies (3-0), April 7-9, 2008 vs. Dodgers (3-0) and April 6-8, 2012 vs. Giants (3-0).

- The D-backs' last sweep: Aug. 8-10, 2025 vs. Rockies (3-0).
- The D-backs' last sweep vs. AL: June 9-11, 2025 vs. Mariners (3-0).

• **Zac Gallen** and **Tarik Skubal** face off for the first time...are 2 of 6 starters to have consecutive seasons of 13+ wins, 28+ starts and 150+ strikeouts (also: Sonny Gray/STL, Framber Valdez/HOU, Carlos Rodón/NYY and Logan Webb/SF).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-5 vs. Tigers after trailing 5-0 in the fourth inning and scoring 7 unanswered runs, including 6 in the eighth.

- First win after trailing 5+ runs and game with a 6+-run inning since June 5, 2025 @ Braves (7-run ninth).
- Third comeback win all-time of 5+ runs vs. an AL opponent (also: June 8, 2012 vs. Athletics and June 19, 2007 vs. Rays).
- **Corbin Carroll** went 1-for-3 with 1 double, 2 RBI and 1 walk...in 11 career games vs. Tigers, is hitting .341 (15-for-44)/1.259 OPS, with 4 doubles, 5 triples, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Brandon Pfaadt** made his season debut, allowing 5 runs on 6 hits over 6.0 innings with 1 walk and 3 strikeouts...faced the minimum in every inning except for the third.
- **Andrew Hoffmann** earned his first win with his second consecutive scoreless multi-inning appearance.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his second save in as many games...was his first back-to-back games with a save since July 19-20, 2024 @ Cubs with the D-backs.

FERNANDEZ-MANIA: Last night, **Jose Fernandez** became the second player this season and eighth since 1889 to hit 2 home runs in their first career regular-season game, joining Charlie Reilly/Columbus (Oct. 9, 1889), Bob Nieman/STL (Sept. 14, 1951), Bert Campaneris/KC (July 23, 1964), Mark Quinn/KC (Sept. 14, 1999), J.P. Arencibia/TOR (Aug. 7, 2010), Trevor Story/COL (April 4, 2016) and Chase DeLauter/CLE (March 26, 2026).

- His 4 RBI were the most by a D-back in their MLB debut, ahead of Mitch Haniger's 3 on Aug. 16, 2016 vs. Mets...seventh D-back all-time with 2+ RBI in a debut (also: Alex Cabrera on June 26, 2000 vs. Astros, Carlos Quentin on July 20, 2006 vs. Dodgers, Mark Reynolds on May 16, 2007 @ Rockies, John Hester on Aug. 28, 2009 vs. Astros and Corbin Carroll on Aug. 29, 2022 vs. Phillies).
- Became the third player at age 22 or younger in the expansion era (since 1961) to record a hit in their first career plate appearance and homer in their second career plate appearance in the same game, joining Joey Gallo/TEX (June 2, 2015) and Kendrys Morales/LAA (May 23, 2006) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- Became the third-youngest (age 22-190) D-back position player to record a hit in their first career plate appearance, behind Jerry Gil (21-313 on Aug. 22, 2004 vs. Reds) and Gerardo Parra (22-007 on May 13, 2009 vs. Reds) and ahead of Travis Lee (22-309 on March 31, 1998 vs. Rockies) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

WHO'S ON FIRST?: Jose Fernandez becomes the youngest D-back player all-time (22-191) to play first base, ahead of Travis Lee (22-309 on March 31, 1998), Conor Jackson (23-084 on July 30, 2005 @ Cubs and Brandon Allen (23-191 on Aug. 22, 2009 @ Astros).

PERDOMO'S ON-BASE STREAK: Geraldo Perdomo's 22-game on-base streak dating back to Sept. 9, 2025 is the Majors' second longest active on-base streak, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (36 since Aug. 24, 2025).

- Has hit safely in 20 of those 22 games, hitting .337 (28-for-83)/1.035 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 13 walks (12 strikeouts).

TRENDING: Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in his last 11 home games since Sep. 15, 2025, batting .310 (13-for-42)/.872 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 7 walks.

- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 3 games, is hitting .400 (4-for-10)/1.462 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 2 walks...has reached base safely in 26 of his last 27 home games since Aug. 6, 2025, batting .330 (33-for-100)/1.104 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 6 homers, 23 RBI, 17 walks and 12 stolen bases.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in his last 8 home games since Sep. 19, 2025, batting .364 (12-for-33)/.992 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 5 RBI.
- **Jordan Lawlar** has hit safely in his last 6 home starts since Sep. 2, 2025, batting .421 (8-for-19)/.981 OPS with 2 doubles and 3 RBI.

VS. TIGERS: Corbin Carroll's 12 extra-base hits (3 2B, 6 3B, 3 HR) vs. Tigers are his most vs. an AL team while his 3 homers vs. Tigers are tied for his second most vs. an AL opponent, with the Orioles (3 HR – 3 2B, 0 3B), behind the Rays (5 HR – 1 2B, 0 3B).

- Since 2022, his 12 extra-base hits vs. Tigers are the most by a NL player, ahead of Bryce Harper/PHI (8) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-TEX (8).
