ELIAS HAS CONFIRMED WE HAD A BLAST: Riley Greene's solo home run to lead off the ninth inning snapped a 1-1 tie and his two-run blast later that same frame made major league history, capping a ferocious eight-run, four-homer rally as the Detroit Tigers roared to a 9-1 win last night at the Los Angeles Angels ... Greene became the first player in Major League Baseball history to hit two home runs in the ninth inning of any game as the Tigers totaled eight runs in the eighth inning or later for the second night in a row.

- Beyond all of the history, the Tigers improved to a season-best nine games above .500 last night and maintained their perch atop the American League ... at 21-12, the Tigers have their best record through 33 games to start a season in 11 years when they began 21-12 in 2014.
- The Tigers have gone 21-9, a .700 winning percentage, in their last 30 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 21-9 record starting March 31 is tied with the Mets for best in all of baseball in that span.
- This stay in Anaheim is the middle stop of a season-long 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip through Houston (1-2), the Angels (2-0) and Colorado (three games starting Tuesday).
- The Tigers today continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through tomorrow.

IT'S NOT EASY BEING GREENE: While Riley Greene became the first player in major league history to hit two homers in the ninth inning, he also became the first Tiger in franchise history to hit two homers in the same inning on the road and just the third overall in club lore ... the other two? Magglio Ordóñez in the second inning on August 12, 2007 vs. the Oakland Athletics and Mr. Tiger, Al Kaline, in the sixth inning on April 17, 1955 vs. the Kansas City Athletics ... thanks to Elias.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: In addition to Riley Greene's history-making effort, the Tigers last night pulled off an array of rare feats ... let's go through some of them, shall we?

- The Tigers last night hit four home runs in the ninth inning for the first time in franchise history ... Detroit is the first team to hit four homers in the ninth since the Los Angeles Dodgers on September 18, 2006 vs. the San Diego Padres ... thanks to Elias.
- The Tigers became the first team to hit four homers in the ninth inning on the road in more than 20 years since Cleveland did so on July 16, 2004 at Seattle ... thanks to Elias.
- The Tigers are just the third team in major league history to score eight or more runs in the eighth inning or later in back-to-back games (no extra innings), joining the 1950 Boston Braves (May 3-4) and the 1921 Pittsburgh Pirates (May 21-22) ... thanks to Elias.

HOMER HAPPY: The Tigers have now hit multiple home runs in all five games this road trip ... it is the first time the Tigers have hit multiple home runs five games in a row on the road since a remarkable eight-game run from August 13-26, 2010, a stretch that included doing so seven days in a row ... the Tigers have now combined to hit nine home runs on back-to-back days on the road for the first time since June 17-18, 2006 at Wrigley Field (also nine: 1 on June 17, 8 on June 18).

A TASTE OF HOME: A native of nearby Burbank and graduate of Harvard-Westlake High School, Jack Flaherty tonight makes his seventh start of the season and his second in the Los Angeles area as he made his season debut on March 28 at Dodger Stadium ... Flaherty enters tonight's outing ranked fifth in the A.L. with an average of 10.58 strikeouts per nine innings (min. 30.0 IP).

A DANDY DOZEN: Zach McKinstry enters tonight riding an active 12-game hitting streak, surpassing his previous career best 11-game streak from August 17-31, 2024 ... his current run is tied with New York's Aaron Judge and Boston's Alex Bregman for the longest active streak in the majors and is already McKinstry's second hitting streak of eight or more games on the young season.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +54 run differential this year, the second-best mark in the A.L. just behind the Yankees (+55) ... the Tigers are one of five A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, but they and the Yankees are well ahead of the third-best Mariners (+35) ... overall, the Tigers are fourth in the majors with their +54 run differential.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.62 ERA (32 ER/110.0 IP) this season, the lowest relief ERA in the American League and the third-lowest mark in all of baseball, behind only San Diego (1.85) and San Francisco (2.30).

AND FINALLY: Javy Báez has homered in three-straight games for the first time since July 25-27, 2024 ... at .300/.804, Báez is one of four Tigers batting at least .300 with an .800+ OPS this year, joining Zach McKinstry (.311/.853), Gleyber Torres (.300/.835) and Dillon Dingler (.300/.808).

- Flaherty returned to the Tigers this offseason by signing a two-year contract...was with Detroit to start last season before being sent to the Los Angeles Dodgers for catcher Thayron Liranzo and infielder Trey Sweeney on July 30.
- Won the World Series with the Dodgers in 2024...went 1-2 with a 7.36 ERA in five postseason starts and started the final game of the World Series.
- Went 7-5 with a 2.95 ERA (35ER/106.2IP) in 18 starts with Detroit and was 6-2 with a 3.58 ERA (22ER/55.1IP) in 10 starts for the Dodgers in the regular season.
- Delivered 6.0+ innings in 16 of his 28 starts last season, including fours starts of 6.2 or more innings.

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
- Made his first career Major League start on Aug. 8 at Seattle...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, became the first Tigers pitcher to finish and then start consecutive games since Steve Sparks, who finished the July 26, 2000, game vs. Tampa Bay and started on July 27, 2000, at Texas.

- Tied for the team lead in strikeouts among relief pitchers with 12 in his 11.2 innings pitched to start the year.
- Spent the entire 2024 season with the Tigers, pitching in 66 games (nine starts) and going 7-2 with eight saves, a 2.19 ERA (23ER/94.1IP) and 77 strikeouts.
