**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Brewers play the first game of this four-game series here in Milwaukee tonight...SF dropped its first two games at Coors Field over the weekend, but avoided the sweep with an commanding 19-6 win over Colorado yesterday.

- ▶ The Giants scored runs in six straight innings (4th-9th) yesterday...according to *Stats, LLC*, it was only the fifth time this century the Giants scored runs in six consecutive innings in one game and first since 2020 (also at Coors Field, eight straight on Sep. 1).
- ▶ Every batter in SF's starting lineup yesterday recorded a hit, a run and an RBI...it marked just the sixth time in franchise history that this has happened and the first since August 8, 1972.
- ▶ The 19 runs scored were the most by any team in MLB this season and the most by SF since May 20, 2021 at Cincinnati (also 19).
- ▶ Giants batters lined 25 hits, most by SF in a game since Sept. 1, 2020 (27) and the most of any MLB team since the Royals recorded 27 hits on Sept. 19 of last season against the Blue Jays.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants have made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ **RHP Wilkin Ramos** (#71) and **IF Buddy Kennedy** (#41) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Joel Peguero** placed on the 60-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain.
- ▶ **C Jesús Rodríguez** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.
- ▶ **C Logan Porter** designated for assignment.

**DON'T STOP ME NOW:** **OF Jung Hoo Lee** put on a historic performance in Colorado this weekend, going 11-for-15 with two doubles, a triple, four runs scored, two RBI and 15 total bases...the 11 hits were the most by a Giant in any series since **Joe Panik** had 12 hits in a three-game series at Coors Field on Sept. 4, 2017.

- ▶ Lee's five-hit day yesterday, which included two hits in the 5th inning, made him the first Giant with five hits in a game since **Alex Dickerson** on Sept. 1, 2020.
- ▶ Entering today, he's hit safely in eight straight games, going 16-32 (.500) with two doubles, a triple, a homer, five RBI and seven runs scored.
- ▶ Lee hasn't struck out in nine straight games and his last 39 plate appearances, the second-longest active such streak in MLB behind PIT's Spencer Horwitz (42).

**YOUNGIN':** **IF Bryce Eldridge** lined a 453ft home run yesterday, the furthest homer by a Giant since **Jorge Soler** (478ft) on July 21, 2024 at COL, as part of his four-hit day...at 21 years, 223 days old, he became the youngest Giant with four hits in a game since **Tom O'Malley** (21y, 154d) on May 28, 1982.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **IF Rafael Devers** finished the month of May with 14 doubles, tied for the most ever by a Giants player in a month, matching **Will Clark** (August 1991) and **Jeffrey Leonard** (May 1987)...the Giants as a club set a new franchise record for a single month with their 68 doubles in the month of May.

**SLAM FRANCISCO:** **IF Willy Adames** lined his sixth career grand slam yesterday and first in a Giants uniform...it was SF's fourth grand slam in a two-week span, marking the second shortest span of days (15) for the Giants to hit four grand Slams in team history behind only the 13 days it took the club to hit them between April 14-26, 1970.

- ▶ SF's four grand slams this year are tied for most in MLB with the Orioles, White Sox & Angels.
- ▶ Adames returns to American Family Field this week, where he has hit 63 career home runs, eight most in the stadium's history and one shy of tying Richie Sexson for the seventh most...two of those were hit in August 22, 2026, one of just six multi-homer games by a Giants player in Milwaukee all-time.

**JUNE BLOOM:** According to *Stats, LLC*, **IF Luis Arraez** is now the second MLB player in the last 50 years to enter June with at least 70 hits and single-digit strikeouts, joining Tony Gwynn, who did it in 1991 and 1997.

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** Yesterday, **OF Jonah Cox** had his contract selected from Double-A before ever appearing in a game at the Triple-A level...the outfielder made his MLB debut off the bench in front of 60 family members who were in attendance...Cox lined a double in the 9th inning off Rockies catcher Brett Sullivan to become just the 11th player since 1974 to record their first career hit off a position player and the first Giant to ever do it (*Stats, LLC*).

# LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

**2026 RECORD: 5-5, 3.30 ERA**

**ROUPPER:** Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Received a loss after allowing four runs (two earned) on seven hits (one homer) and a walk while striking out seven over 5.0 innings vs. AZ on May 25.

**VS. MILWAUKEE:** Is slated to make his fifth career appearance (third start) vs. the Brewers...is 0-1 with a 3.65 ERA (5er, 12.1ip) and 10 strikeouts in the four games.

**MAY DAY:** Last month was unkind to Roupp's record...despite a decent ERA of 4.38 (12er, 24.2ip), Roupp went 0-4 in five May starts, receiving just seven total runs of support in the five starts.

**WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?:** Roupp has 68 strikeouts in 60.0 innings this season with his 27.4% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 27.4% strikeout rate is seventh best in the NL among qualified pitchers.

**WHAT'S THE COUNT?:** Roupp's 17.4 pitches per inning is tied for the second-highest in MLB among pitchers with at least 60.0 innings pitched this season (teammate **LHP Robbie Ray** leads with 18.2 pitches per inning)...his 4.21 pitches per batter faced is second highest in MLB (min. 60.0ip) behind only Ray's 4.24 mark.

**NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED:** The righty's 26.3% hard hit rate this season is lowest in the Majors (min. 150 batted ball events)...the next closest is PHI's Jesús Luzardo (27.2%)...Roupp's 55.7% ground ball rate this season is second-highest in MLB among qualified pitchers behind only PHI's Christopher Sánchez (57.3%).

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Roupp is 3-2 with a 2.67 ERA (10er, 33.2ip) and a .645 opposing OPS in six road starts...the 2.67 ERA is the 10th-best road ERA among qualified NL pitchers...in five home starts, Roupp is 2-3 with a 4.10 ERA (12er, 26.1ip) and a .576 opposing OPS.

**SINK OR SWIM:** His sinker has been his most-used pitch (36.8 usage rate) and has a +4 run value this season per *Baseball Savant*, which is a +10 improvement over the -6 run value his sinker has in 2025...he is one of three Giants with a sinker that has a run value of +4 or better, joining **RHP Logan Webb** (+4) and **RHP Trevor McDonald** (+5).

**CALLING CARD:** Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, opponents are batting .214 (15x70) vs. the pitch with 32 strikeouts, a 37.0% whiff rate and a 31.1% putaway rate...the curveball has a +5 run value, making it the third-most valuable curveball in MLB per *Baseball Savant*.

**CHANGING THE PACE:** His changeup has a .159 opposing batting average (7x44) with 12 strikeouts and a 32.4% whiff rate this season...the .159 opponent batting average is the ninth-lowest in MLB among all changeups (min. 190 changeups thrown).

**WE LOVE TO SEE IT:** Roupp averages 13.2 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is tied for the 11th-fastest in MLB...the league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds with the bases empty.

**NICE AND EASY:** There is almost a 100 point difference in batting average, and a drastic difference in OPS depending on the result of Roupp's first pitch in a plate appearance...if the opponent swung at the first pitch, they are batting .148 (9x61) with two doubles and a .342 OPS...if the opponent takes the first pitch, they are batting .247 (40x162) with nine doubles, a triple, three homers and a .711 OPS.

**TOP OF THE ORDER:** The top four spots in the batting order have combined for a .167/.234/.254 slash line (.488 OPS) with seven extra-base hits compared to the bottom five spots in the lineup having a .275/.358/.385 slash line (.743 OPS) and eight extra-base hits.

**2026 RECORD: 2-2, 4.34 ERA**

- ▶ Will make his sixth start of the season for SF tomorrow... has three quality starts in his first five starts with the Giants this year.
- ▶ Last pitched in SF's homestand finale last Wednesday vs. Arizona...worked in to the 7th inning and ended up allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits in 6.1 innings in SF's 3-2 loss.
- ▶ Outside of one bad inning vs. the White Sox on May 22 (0.2ip, 3h, 7r), he's been superb for SF (7er, 28.1ip).

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday (second stint with SF)...has gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role... recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/31 at COL; 1.2ip, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Has tossed 8.2 scoreless innings over his last four outings...has a 0.73 ERA (1er, 12.1ip) in his last seven games.
- ▶ Has a 0.61 ERA (1er, 14.2ip) in 11 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 11 of 20 contests (4.5 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .194 (6-for-31) off his slider, .222 (10-for-45) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COL; 0.2ip, h (6 pitches)

- ▶ Gage's 28 appearances this year are tied for sixth-most in MLB.
- ▶ Has surrendered six runs (five ER) in 23.0ip this year (1.96 ERA).
- ▶ Has allowed only nine of his 24 (37.5%) inherited runners to score.
- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-31 (.065) against him this season, and 19-for-114 in his career (.167).
- ▶ His 27.7% hard hit rate ranks in the top 5% of MLB while his 85.2 mph average exit velo is in the top 5%.
- ▶ Opponents are just 2-for-16 (.125) off his changeup and 3-for-22 (.136) off his four-seamer.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 5/30 at COL; 1.1ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, k (32 pitches)

- ▶ Has made eight appearances with SF, logging 7.2 innings, allowing four hits and eight walks with nine strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-13 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 5/31 at COL; W, 1.0ip, bb, 2k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Rebounded from a rough previous outing to earn the win in yesterday's game with a shutout inning of relief...had given up a season-high five runs and five hits on two homers in 9th inning on Friday.
- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0 innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 9-for-52 (.173) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-40 (.200) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 5/29 at COLP 1.0ip, h, k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed one home run in his last 61.1 innings pitched, dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 13 walks in his 16.1ip (7.16 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Right-handers are 5-for-30 (.167) off him while left-handers are 5-for-29 (.172).
- ▶ Holding opponents 0-for-20 off his slider and 5-for-31 (.161) off his sinker.
