**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals and Chicago White Sox play the rubber game of a three-game weekend series this afternoon at Busch Stadium ... This nine-game/10-day homestand against the Pale Hose (1-1), Giants (Sept. 14-16), and Nationals (Sept. 18-20) is their last and longest of the season ... With 13 games remaining, St. Louis enters today's game in 4th place in the National League Central and 7.5 games out of the final NL Wild Card spot ... St. Louis has been mathematically eliminated from the NL Central division race.

**INTERLEAGUE ACTION:** Alec Burleson and Jordan Walker both have 54 hits in Interleague play this season, most by any Cardinal since Interleague Play began in 1997 ... Burly's 33 RBI vs. AL teams ranks T-3rd all-time, while his 20 extra-base hits rank 2nd ... 2023 Nolan Arenado (36 RBI and 21 XBH) holds both Cardinals records.

**THE GRANDFATHER OF BASEBALL:** With one more win, the Cardinals will have reached 4,000 regular season victories since John Vuch was hired by the Cardinals organization before the 1979 season ... Oliver Marmol is two wins away from becoming the 9th Cardinals manager with 400.

**CHURCH BELLS:** Nathan Church is enjoying a career-best 11-game hit streak (14-39, .359), matching Tyler Soderstrom for MLB's longest active ... Among MLB rookies with 100+ at-bats in Interleague play (1997-present), Church's .336 batting average (43-125) currently ranks highest in single-season history among rookies.

**HEARTBURN:** St. Louis has played the 2nd-most one-run games (50, 23-27 record) in MLB, including seven of their last 12 games played since Aug. 30 ... The Cardinals lead the Majors in games decided by two runs or fewer (82, 41-41 record).

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** This series features the NL's and AL's top offensive productions from rookies this season (*see chart right*) ... The 2026 rookie class boasts the franchise's most plate appearances (1,707), at-bats (1,531), hits (367), homers (49), RBI (190), runs (207), and walks (127) over the last 66 seasons during the Expansion Era (1961-present), while ranking 3rd in fWAR (6.0) and 5th in stolen bases (29).

**ROOKIE SENSATION:** Through 11 career games, rookie backstop Leo Bernal has set Cardinals records with the most RBI (13) and RBI efforts (5) through a player's first 11 career games, while his 13 hits match Nelson Burbrink (1955) and Tom Nieto (1984) for most by a Cardinals rookie primary catcher.

**OUCH:** Ivan Herrera's MLB-high 29 hit-by-pitches are 2nd-most in Cardinals single-season history behind only Steve Evans (31 in 1910) ... Overall this season, St. Louis has been plunked 90 times, tying the Angels for the MLB lead this season and matching the 1901 Redbirds for most in franchise single-season history.

#### CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Cardinals broadcaster John Rooney spent 18 years (1988-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in radio...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

Erick Fedde and Tommy Pham were acquired from the White Sox on July 29, 2024 in a three-team, eight-player trade in which the White Sox received Miguel Vargas from the Dodgers...Fedde made 30 starts for the Cardinals from 2024-25... Pham was originally selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2006 MLB Draft and played in 385 games for St. Louis (2014-18, 2024).

Randal Grichuk began his MLB career with St. Louis and played in 404 games for the Cardinals from 2014-17.

Jordan Hicks was selected by St. Louis in the supplemental 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft and pitched in 187 games with 28 saves for the Cardinals from 2018-23.

José Fermín (July 7, 2023), Kyle Leahy (July 7, 2023) and Riley O'Brien (Sept. 28, 2021 w/CIN) made MLB debuts vs. the White Sox at Rate Field.

Brandon Allen was originally drafted by the White Sox in the 5th round of the 2004 MLB Draft out of Montgomery (Texas) High School...played five minor league seasons with the White Sox (2004-09).

Gordon Graceffo and Thomas Saggese were teammates with Sam Antonacci and Kyle Teel on Team Italy in the 2026 World Baseball Classic.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Willie McGee was originally selected by the White Sox in the 7th round of the 1976 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals broadcaster Ricky Horton pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988, and was their Opening Day starter against the California Angels (April 4, 1988 at Comiskey Park)...originally traded by the Cardinals with OF Lance Johnson and cash to Chicago for RHP José DeLeón.

Hall of Fame Manager Tony La Russa managed both the Cardinals (1996-2011) and White Sox (1979-86, 2021-22) and is currently a Special Advisor for the White Sox.

Tristan Peters played college baseball in 2021 at Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Ill.

White Sox 1B/OF Coach José Leger was a coach and manager in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-25.

White Sox Asst. Hitting Coach Joel McKeithan played for the Gateway Grizzlies and his brother, Aaron, was drafted by the Cardinals in 2021.

White Sox Physical Therapist Andrew Turpin is a Quincy, IL native and University of Missouri alum.

White Sox Head Groundskeeper Roger Bossard designed and built new playing fields at Busch Stadium II and Busch Stadium III, as well as Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter, Fla.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer Chip Caray's grandfather, Harry Caray, was a broadcaster for the White Sox from 1971-81.

The Cardinals inducted Charles Comiskey, who played for the St. Louis Browns in the 1800s, into the St. Louis Cardinals Hall of Fame in 2022...was the founding owner of the White Sox...the White Sox former ballpark (1910-90) was named Comiskey Park, as was Rate Field when it opened in 1991.

Cardinals Pro Scout Kerry Robinson hit his 1st career home run on June 17, 2001 vs. the White Sox at Busch Stadium II.

TODAY'S START:

- Making his 29th start of the season, extending his career-high in starts and appearances; it also marks his 50th career appearance (48th start).
- Is making his 2nd career start against the White Sox and his 1st at Busch Stadium.**
- Leads the Cardinals w/ career-high 154.0 innings. Pitched career-high 173.0 innings between Memphis-AAA (150.0) & St. Louis (23.0) in 2024.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 15 of his 28 starts this season, while his 13 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer runs allowed lead the Cardinals and rank T-10th in the NL.**
- Ranks among NL leaders in Pct. Pitches Taken (55.4%, T-3rd), Pct. Pitches Put in Play (19.4%, 4th) and Pct. Swings Put In Play (43.6%, 2nd).
- The Cardinals are 27-20 (.574 win pct.) in his 47 career starts, and since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 24 of his starts - most among all Cardinals starters.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 47 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. Seattle's **George Kirby** leads active pitchers with 140 such starts.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 28 of 47 career starts (24 quality starts), including 10 of his last 17 since June 1.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, September 7 at San Francisco): ND, L 5-4; 6.2.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 0 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO - 105 pitches.

- Threw a season high 6.2 IP and a career high 105 pitches on Labor Day, taking a no-decision in the Cardinals 5-4 extra innings loss at Oracle Park.
- Walked two batters in his 6th straight start, the longest such streak by a Cardinals starter since 6 straight by **Bob Forsch**, 4/23/77-5/18/77.
- Made his team-high 22nd start of 5.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks allowed (T-3rd in NL).

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Had his 1st error of season in Sept. 7 start vs. SF; ranks among NL pitchers in total chances (38, 3rd), assists (20, T-4th), and double plays (4, T-1st) ... Boasts 5 Defensive Runs Saved, T-1st among MLB pitchers with **Nolan McLean**.

RUN PREVENTION: Ranks T-1st among NL pitchers this season w/ 8 Net Bases Prevented (*a sum of advances prevented and outs added*), behind only **Shota Imanaga** (8) ... Since McGreevy's MLB Debut (July 31, 2024), he has conceded 3 SB on just 6 attempts, 3rd-fewest SB in MLB over timespan, while his 50% SB rate ranks 4th-best in MLB (min. 250 IP) ... Out of 1,623 SB career opportunities, McGreevy's SB attempt pct. (0.2%) is 3rd-lowest in MLB to **Mitchell Parker** (0.2%) and **Ryne Nelson** (0.2%) among starters.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's lowest percent (19.8) of Swing & Miss ... His difference in Opponent BA (.257) vs. xBA (.281) ranks 5th among qualified MLB starting pitchers (-.024) ... **The Cardinals have provided McGreevy with an 11 Fielding Run Value, tied with D-Backs Merrill Kelly for the highest for any MLB pitcher this season.**

ONE FOR THE ROAD: Posted a 3.80 ERA in 15 road starts this season with a team-high eight quality starts (T-9th in NL).

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Has induced a career-high 16 groundball double plays (T-6th in NL); last Cardinals pitcher with 20+ GiDP was **Kyle Gibson** (21) in 2024.

HERE'S SOME HELP: Has received 7+ runs of support in 3 of his last 4 starts (Aug. 15-present), and his 28 runs of support in that time are the most for any MLB pitcher ... Received 6 runs of support or fewer in each of his first 23 starts (March 28-Aug. 9), and his initial 3.93 run support average in that span was the NL's 8th-lowest (min. 100.0 IP) ... The Cardinals have been shut out 7 times this season, 4 of which were when McGreevy has started ... **Has been in position for 8 wins this season when the game was blown by the bullpen, most of any MLB pitcher.**

HERE COMES THE SUN...: Is 2-2 with a 2.81 ERA (20 ER/64.0 IP) in day games this season with a team-leading 1.09 WHIP and a team-high 7 quality starts; however, has allowed 9 of 20 HR in his 11 afternoon starts.

McGreevy vs. CHICAGO (A.L.):

- Is making his 2nd career appearance/start against the White Sox, his 1st at Busch Stadium.
