MILWAUKEE BREWERS (15-8) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-12)

APRIL 25, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA – 12:35 EDT – GAME #26/HOME #12 RHP FREDDY PERALTA (2-0, 1.90 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (2-2, 4.80 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 3-2 in the third game of their series last night against the Brewers...Were swept by the Red Sox in the first three games of this current homestand this past weekend...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Won nine of their first 11 games before losing nine of their next 11 from 4/9-21...Are in a stretch that has the

team playing 13 straight days before their next scheduled off day on 5/2 coming back from the west coast...Åre the only team in MLB that has yet to lose when scoring at least four runs in a game.

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Mitch Keller gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this four-game series and seven-game homestand...Keller is making his second start of the homestand after allowing four runs in 6.0 innings while taking the loss Saturday against the Red Sox...Prior to that, Keller won back-to-back starts on April 8 vs. Detroit and April 14 at Philadelphia.

GIMME FIVE: Mitch Keller tossed 6.0 innings on Saturday against the Red Sox, giving him 36 straight starts of working at least 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB coming into today...It's also the longest streak by a Pirate since A.J. Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8, 2012, to August 10, 2013.

HOME COOKIN': Mitch Keller will make his third home start of the season this afternoon... The 28-year-old Keller is 8-4 with a 3.09 ERA (102.0ip/35er) in 16 starts at PNC Park since the beginning of last season...Keller's 3.09 home ERA since the beginning of last year is the ninth-best in all of MLB among pitchers with at least 100.0 innings...Logan Webb has the lowest home ERA in that time (2.02).

GO WEST YOUNG BUCS: The Pirates will depart for their third road trip of the season following today's game that will take the team to San Francisco and Oakland for three games apiece...This will be Pittsburgh's first trip to Oakland since sweeping three games in 2016 from July 1-3.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: The Pirates are 1-0-1 in their first two fourgame series of 2024 after sweeping the Marlins in Miami to open the season while splitting against the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park from April 11-14...Pittsburgh's next four-game series will take place next month at Wrigley Field from May 16-19.

THE BEER BATTER: Bryan Reynolds is 22-for-66 with four Craig Wilsdoubles and five home runs in his last 19 games vs. Milwaukee... Reynolds is also 11-for-25 with a double, triple and home run in his career off Freddy Peralta...Reynolds' 11 hits against Peralta are tied for his secondmost against any pitcher in his career (he's 12-for-33 lifetime against Miles Mikolas).

ORDINARY AVERAGE GUYS: The Pirates allowed a season-low three hits in Tuesday's game against the Brewers...Coming into today, Pittsburgh's pitching staff has the ninth-lowest batting average against (.224) in all of MLB (the Tigers have the lowest batting average against at .212).

WINNING STARTS HERE: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 3.58 ERA (138.1ip/55er) this season...That's the second-lowest ERA among all National League teams and fifth-best in MLB...Philadelphia's starting rotation has a NL-best 2.20 ERA.

IFEEL GOOD: Colin Holderman made his fifth straight scoreless appearance (4.2ip) Tuesday night after allowing one earned run in 0.2 inning in his season debut on April 11...Holderman began the season on the 15-day injured list due to illness...During his current five-game stretch, Holderman has allowed just one hit in 15 at-bats (.067 batting average against).

CRUZING FOR A BREWZING: Oneil Cruz went 1-for-4 Wednesday night...Cruz has now hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games against the Brewers, going 15-for-41 (.366) with three doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI...Since the beginning of 2022, Cruz' 18 RBI against the Brewers are tied for the third-most by any player along with lan Happ...The only two players with more are Nolan Arenado (22) and Paul Goldschmidt (19).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 25, 2012: Pedro Alvarez homered in both games of Pittsburgh's doubleheader split against Colorado at PNC Park, becoming the first Pittsburgh player in the last 22 seasons to hit home runs for the Pirates in two games played on the same day. The other player to do that for the Bucs over that span was Rob Mackowiak on 5/28/04.

QUINN PRIESTER: The 23-year-old righthander will make his second start of the season tomorrow night when the Pirates open a weekend series against the Giants at Oracle Park...Allowed five runs (4er) in 4.1 innings while losing his season debut Friday night against the Red Sox...Began the season with Triple-A Indianapolis, where he went 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er), 20 strikeouts and .226 batting average against in three starts...Entered this season rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 8 prospect...Was rated among Baseball America's top 100 prospects in both 2022 (No. 88) and 2021 (No. 58)...Was drafted out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School with the 18th overall selection in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft...Made his big league debut last year on 7/17 against Cleveland and suffered the loss before winning each of his next two starts.
