**FLO RIDA AND HALFWAY TO THE PHOENIX OPEN ON SEPT. 5:** The D-backs will give fans the ultimate Friday night on Sept. 5 headlined by a free postgame concert featuring Flo Rida and celebrating the halfway mark to the WM Phoenix Open with Golf Night, including The Thunderbirds will join us at the ballpark to mark the occasion, highlighted by a ceremonial first pitch from 2025 Tournament Chairman Matt Mooney, exciting golf-themed activations throughout the game, and a special check presentation to the Arizona Alliance of Boys & Girls Clubs on behalf of the Thunderbirds and the D-backs Foundation.

**2026 SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED:** The D-backs 2026 schedule features the Opening Homestand vs. Tigers (March 30-April 1) and Braves (April 2-5), holiday weekends for Mother’s Day vs. Mets (May 9-10), Father’s Day vs. Twins (June 19-21), Fourth of July vs. Brewers (July 3-5), Interleague Play vs. Blue Jays (April 17-19) and Yankees (September 19-20), and marquee NL West matchups...for more information, visit [dbacks.com/2026](https://dbacks.com/2026).

**SNAKE BITES:** The D-backs are 5-4 vs. Dodgers -- winning each of the first 2 of this 3 game set, splitting 2-2 from May 8-11 @ Chase Field and going 1-2 from May 19-21 @ Dodger Stadium -- and seeking their first winning season vs. Dodgers since 2018 (11-8, .579).

- With a win today, the D-backs would secure their first 3-game series sweep over the Dodgers since April 2-4, 2018 @ Chase Field...the last time Arizona swept a 3-game set @ Dodger Stadium was Sept. 4-6, 2017.
- Geraldo Perdomo’s** .433 OBP in August ranks sixth in the NL, behind Jake Cronenworth/SD (.464), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (.444), Juan Soto/NYM (.441), Jared Triolo/PIT (.437) and Jurickson Profar/ATL (.436).
- 13 of the D-backs’ last 19 games, including 4 of their last 6, have been decided by 2 or fewer runs.
- Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.50 runs per game rank fifth in MLB, behind the Mets (7.05), Yankees (6.19), Braves (5.68) and Brewers (5.61).
- The D-backs’ 64 RBI with 2 outs in August rank third in MLB, behind the Phillies (72) and Mets (70).
- The D-backs’ 40 homers in August are fourth in the NL, behind the Mets (53), Phillies (43), Brewers (43) ...are 1 of 3 NL teams with 4 30+--homer months (April, May, June, August) with the Cubs and Dodgers.
- Arizona has recorded 156 runs this season in the 8th inning or later, the highest total in Major League Baseball.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-1 @ Dodgers, earning a series win over their division rivals...Arizona has allowed just 1 run over their last 20.0 IP against Los Angeles dating back to the seventh inning on May 21.

- Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just 4 hits with 4 strikeouts...it was his third scoreless outing of the season (also: June 23 @ White Sox (6.0 IP) and July 22 vs. Astros (6.1 IP).
- Corbin Carroll** has now reached base safely in 17 consecutive games since Aug. 13, the fifth-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Jackson Chourio/MIL (23), Wyatt Langford/TEX (19), Isaac Paredes/HOU (18) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (18).
- Ildemaro Vargas** belted his second homer of the season, a three-run shot in the ninth inning that traveled 423 feet...both of his homers this season have gone 420+ feet after having only 1 such home run in his previous 8 seasons combined.

**WINNING IN AUGUST:** The D-backs are 17-11 (.607) in August, their highest winning percentage of any month this season...their winning percentage this month ranks third in the Majors behind the Brewers (21-8, .724) and Phillies (18-10, .643).

**EXTRA! EXTRA!:** Corbin Carroll has recorded 71 extra-base hits this season (27 doubles, 16 triples, 28 home runs), tied with Aaron Judge/NYY for the highest total in baseball.

**PFAADT CHANCE:** **Brandon Pfaadt** is 4-0 with a 3.00 ERA (8 ER in 24.0 IP), an opponents .209 AVG, 7 walks and 23 strikeouts in his last 4 outings vs. Dodgers since May 21, 2024...Pfaadt is 1 of 4 D-backs pitchers all-time to win 4+ consecutive starts vs. Dodgers, joining Brandon Webb from Sept. 21, 2005-Sept. 22, 2007 (7), Curt Schilling from April 4-Sept. 23, 2001 (4) and Omar Daal from July 25, 1998-May 8, 2000 (4).

**BLAZING A TRAIL:** **Blaze Alexander** has hit all 7 of his home runs and 13 of his 17 extra-base hits this season in his last 25 games since August 3 (.554 SLG/.919 OPS).

- The D-backs are 12-3 when Alexander has an extra-base hit and 6-1 when he hits a home run.
- Has started all 30 games since July 29 and the team is 17-13 (.567).

**HOLLYWOOD LONG BALLS:** The D-backs have homered in 11 straight games @ Dodger Stadium since May 20, 2024, their second-longest streak in team history, behind a 16-game streak from April 13, 2018-Aug. 9, 2019.

**START ME UP:** The D-backs starting rotation has allowed 3 earned runs or fewer 10 times in their last 13 games since August 17, pitching to a 4-2 record with a 3.80 ERA (28 ER in 66.1 IP), 53 strikeouts, 18 walks and a .235 opponents average (60-for-255).

- The rotation has allowed just 2 homers in their last 10 games (48.2 IP).

**MONTHLY RBI LEADERS:** **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.’s** 32 RBI this month are a franchise record for August, ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (31 in August 2017), and third most all-time in any month:

**GO, GO GURRI:** **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.’s** 32 RBI in August are the most in a month in his career, the second-most in MLB behind Kyle Schwarber/PHI (33), and the third most in any month this season by a player, behind Rafael Devers/BOS-SF (33 in May) and Schwarber this month...it is the second time in his career with 30+ RBI in a month (also: 30 RBI in 26 G in Sept./Oct 2021).

**ON DECK: TEXAS RANGERS:** The D-backs will take on the Rangers for the second time this season, having taken 2 of 3 at Globe Life Field from Aug. 11-13...Arizona has won 4 of their last 5 games vs. Texas dating back to Sept. 10, 2024, as well as 7 of their last 10 regular season meetings since May 3, 2023.

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (7-3, 3.53)

- Earned the win after he allowed just 1 run on 6 hits in 6.0 innings of work in his last outing on Aug. 27 @ Brewers.
- Has won 5 of his last 6 decisions dating back to June 13, going 5-1 with a 2.93 ERA (26 ER in 80.0 IP), 70 strikeouts, 17 walks and a .221 opponents batting average (66-for-299) in that time.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Has a 4-game win streak vs. Dodgers, since May 21, 2024, going 4-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9 R-8 ER in 24.0 IP), opponent .209 AVG, 7 walks and 23 strikeouts.

- 4 strikeouts shy of 400 career.
- His career-high 12 wins are tied with Matthew Boyd/CHC, Sonny Gray/STL, Jesús Luzardo/PHI and Logan Webb/SF for third in in the NL, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (16) and Nick Pivetta/SD (13).
