YANKEE DOODLES: The New York Yankees will play the 18th exhibition game of their spring schedule today vs. the Philadelphia Phillies at GMS Field in Tampa, Fla.... it will be the last spring training game between the two teams in 2022 (three in Tampa and two in Clearwater)...are scheduled to play 19 total spring games (10 home games, nine road games)...marks the Yankees' 27th consecutive season at Steinbrenner Field (1996-2022), formerly Legends Field, and the 120th season in franchise history.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: On Sunday at TD Ballpark, the Yankees played their 17th Spring Training game and fell to the Toronto Blue Jays, 7-5...**RHP Luis Gil** made his third spring appearance and first start, surrendering 5ER over 2.1 innings (8H, 1BB, 2K, 1WP, 1BK)...**SS Isiah Kiner-Falefa** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) notched his first HR of the spring, a two-run HR in the first inning...**3B Josh Donaldson** (2-for-3, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) added a two-run HR of his own in the third inning, his third HR of the spring...**RHP Shelby Miller** made his spring debut, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning (1H, 1K)... **RHP Clarke Schmidt** struck out 5 batters over 4.1IP in relief (L, 2H, 2ER, 1BB, 1HR, 1HP).

LEADING THE PACK: Entering today's game, the Yankees offense leads the Grapefruit League in runs scored (103), RBI (98), total bases (279), hits (148) and stolen bases (17)...they also rank second in HR (33), SLG (.502) and OPS (.839), third in batting average (.266), fourth in walks (56), fifith in OBP (.337) and tied for fifth in doubles (30).

STAR POWER: Among notables performances this spring, **INF/OF Marwin Gonzalez** has accounted for 9RBI, the second-most on the team behind **C Kyle Higashioka**, who is tied for third in the Grapefruit League with 11RBI... Higashioka also leads the Majors with 7HR this spring and is tied for the sixth-most hits in the Grapefruit League (11H)... **INF Isiah Kiner-Falefa's** 11H are tied with Higashioka for the most on the team and tied for sixth in the Grapefruit League...**OF Tim Locastro** leads the way with a team-high 3SB.

"PITCH PERFECT": The Yankees have had 9 pitchers toss at least 3.0 scoreless innings: LHP Manny Bañuelos (3G/1GS, 6.0IP), LHP Aroldis Chapman (3G, 3.0IP), LHP Nestor Cortes (2G, 4.0IP), RHP Zach Greene (3G, 3.0IP), RHP Clay Holmes (4G, 4.0IP), LHP Matt Krook (1G, 3.0IP), RHP Jonathan Loáisiga (4G, 4.0IP), LHP Lucas Luetge (5G, 5.0IP) and RHP Greg Weissert (2G, 3.0IP).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Aaron Boone enters his fifth season at the helm of the Yankees in 2022...in 2021, he guided the team to a 92-70 record and fifth consecutive postseason berth...with the Yankees reaching the playoffs in each of his first four seasons, he became the second manager in Baseball history to reach the postseason in each of his first four managerial seasons, joining Mike Matheny (2012-15 w/ St. Louis, four straight)...is the third manager to make the playoffs in his first four seasons with the Yankees, joining Casey Stengel (first five from 1949-53) and Joe Torre (first 12 from 1996-2007)...has posted a 328-218 (.601) record in his first four seasons as manager. ▶ His 328 career regular season managerial wins rank ninth on the Yankees' all-time list.

WELCOME TO NEW YORK: On Sunday, the Yankees acquired **RHP Miguel Castro** from the New York Mets in exchange for LHP Joely Rodríguez....the right-handed pitcher went 3-4 with a 3.45 ERA (70.1IP, 48H, 30R/27ER, 43BB, 77K, 7HR) in a career-high 69 appearances, including two solds as an opener) with the Mets in 2021...his 3.45 ERA marked a Major League career-best, in addition to his 0.90 HR/9.0IP and 6.14 H/9.0IP...he led all Mets relievers in appearances and innings pitched, and held batters to a .189 (48-for-254) opponents' batting average.

The Yankees also announced on Saturday that they acquired **C Jose Trevino** from the Texas Rangers in exchange for RHP Albert Abreu and LHP Robert Ahlstrom...he batted .239 (68-for-285) with 23R, 14 doubles, 5HR, 30RBI and 12BB in 89 games for the Texas Rangers in 2021...additionally, he started exactly half of the Rangers' games at catcher (81), totaling more starts than his previous three seasons combined (44 starts from 2018-20)...over parts of four Major League season, the right-handed batter has hit .245 (120-for-489) with 51R, 31 doubles, 9HR, 55RBI and 18BB in 156 career games...the Corpus Christi, Tex., native was selected by Texas in the sixth round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Oral Roberts (Okla.) University.

NEW FACES: On 3/13, the Yankees acquired INF Josh Donaldson, INF Isiah Kiner-Falefa and C Ben Rortvedt from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for C Gary Sánchez and INF Gio Urshela.

- Donaldson, 36, is a three-time All-Star (2014-16), two-time AL SIlver Slugger Award winner (2015-16) and was the 2015 AL Most Valuable Player... over 11 Major League seasons, he has batted .269/.367/.505 (1,179-for-4,379) with 739R, 254 doubles, 12 triples, 251HR, 728RBI and 649BB in 1,201 games...in 2021, he hit .247 (113-for-457) with 73R, 26 doubles, 26HR, 72RBI and 74BB in 135 games with the Twins.
 Kiner-Falefa, 26, batted .271 (172-for-635) with 74R, 25 doubles, 3 triples, 8HR, 53RBI, 28BB and 20SB in 158 games for the Texas Rangers in 2021, finishing with Career highs in curve, hits, doubles, home runs, RBI and stolen bases...led the Majors with 136 singles...won the AL Gold Glove Award at third base with Texas in 2020.

- Rortvedt, 24, saw his first Major League action in 2021 with the Twins...the left-handed batter has hit .241 (271-for-1,123) with 21HR and 134RBI in 325 minor league games...was named "Best Defensive Catcher" in the Twins minor league system by Baseball America following the 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2021 seasons

WHO'S WHO: The Yankees currently have 38 players in camp, including 33 players on the active 40-man roster, two on the 60-day injured list and three non-

- The three NRIs consist of one left-hander pitcher (Manny Bañuelos), one outfielder (Ender Inciarte) and one infielder (Marwin Gonzalez)
 All three of these players have accrued Major League service time: Gonzalez (9 years, 128 days), Inciarte (7 years, 105 days) and Bañuelos (1 year, 146 days).

27 AND COUNTING: This year marks the 27th season the Yankees have held spring training at George M. Steinbrenner Field in Tampa, Fla....the complex originally opened prior to the 1996 season as Legends Field...during a pregame ceremony on 3/27/08, was renamed as George M. Steinbrenner Field in honor of the club's late principal owner...since its inception, GMS Field has also served as hold principal to the Yankees' Low-A minor league affiliate, which changed its name from the Tampa Yankees to the Tampa Tarpons for the 2018 season...prior to relocating to Tampa, the Yankees held spring training in Fort Lauderdale, Fla., from 1962-95.

FOR STARTERS: LHP JP Sears (0-1, 12.27 ERA, 3.2IP, 10H, 5ER, 0BB, 5K, 1HR, 2G in ST) will make his third spring appearance and first start...on Wednesday vs. Toronto, allowed 5ER over 1.2 innings in relief and recorded the loss (7H, 1K, 1HR)...made his spring debut on 3/24 at Detroit, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings in relief (3H, 4K)...went 10-2 with one save and a 3.46 ERA (104.0IP, 86H, 43R/40ER, 29BB, 136K, 11HR) in 25 appearances (18 starts) between Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 2021...was added to the Yankees' 40-man roster on 11/19/21...was acquired by the Yankees from the Seattle Mariners along with RHP Juan Then in exchange for RHP Nick Rumbelow on 11/18/17.

2021 SEASON IN REVIEW

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers posted a 3.74 ERA (1,435.1IP, 596ER) in 2021, the sixth-lowest ERA in the Majors and the third-lowest in the AL...was their third-lowest ERA in the last 36 seasons since 1986, trailing only their 3.72 ERA in 2017 and 3.73 ERA in 2011... Yankees pitchers also ranked fourth in the Majors in strikeouts (1,569K) and K/9.0IP (9.84), fifth in K/BB (3.19) and sixth in opponents' BA (.231) and WHIP (1.21)... their 1,569K were the second-most in franchise history, trailing only their 1,634K in 2018.

• Yankees starters posted a 3.91 ERA (829.1IP, 360ER) in 2021... was their lowest ERA since 2014 (3.77) and their third-lowest in the last 38 seasons since 1984 (also had 3.85 ERA in 1998).

• Yankees relievers posted a 3.50 ERA (606.0IP, 236ER) in 2021, the fourth-lowest bullpen ERA in the Majors and second-lowest in the AL... trailed only the San Francisco Giarda (3.21), Los Angelos Dedgers (3.12) and Tampo Bay Paye (3.22)

- the San Francisco Giants (2.97), Los Angeles Dodgers (3.12) and Tampa Bay Rays (3.23).

PLAYOFF RETURN: The Yankees clinched the 57th playoff appearance in franchise history (119 seasons, 47.9%), the most in Major League history (next: Dodgers - 35)...qualified for the postseason for the 23rd time in 27 seasons since 1995 (missing only in 2008, '13-14, '16).
▶ Fell to Boston, 6-2, in a "winner-take-all" Wild Card Game at Fenway Park...was the 30th "winner-take-all" game in club history (15-15 in those games).

Only fully-vaccinated credentialed media members will have access to restricted areas (clubhouse, press conference room, field, etc.). MLB defines fully vaccinated as vaccinated and boosted (if the individual medically qualifies for a booster). Media members must email a photo of their vaccination card to credentials@yankees.com.
