LAST APPEARANCE

Alvarez tossed 4.1 innings, allowing three earned runs on six hits while striking out two...He took a no-decision in the 7-3 victory over the Colorado Rockies on July 20.

vs. TORONTO

Alvarez is set to make his first career appearance against the Toronto Blue Jays.

STINGY WITH THE LONG BALL

Alvarez has not allowed a home run in 35.2 consecutive innings pitched, the second-longest active streak among starting pitchers behind only New York's **Max Fried** (37.2 IP).

- The last home run allowed came off the bat of Miami's **Esteury Ruiz** on June 3 in the top of the second inning...That home run hit the left field foul pole.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .189 (14-for-74) with five extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 35 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

The Nationals are 11-8 (.579) in Alvarez's 19 career Major League appearances since his Major League debut on Sept. 1, 2025 at Miami.

Tall left-hander ranked second in Washington's system (4th in all of Triple-A) with 123.0 innings and third in the organization (10th in Triple-A) with 114 strikeouts at the time of his Major League debut.
