THE LATEST:

★ The Blue Jays doubled up the Giants, 6-3, in the middle match of their three-game series at Rogers Centre on Saturday...Moved to 57-41 overall this season, 34-16 at home, and 17-9 against NL opponents...Extended their home winning streak to nine games, one shy of the franchise-record 10-game streak from July 21-Aug. 3, 1985...Improved to 18-12-2 in series play (10-5-1 in home series), having won 12 of the last 15 series overall...Are a season-high-tying 16 games over .500...Haven't been 17 games over .500 since Sept. 30, 2023 (89-72).

★ Toronto has won 15 of its last 19 games, 19 of its last 27, and has gone 31-13 in its last 44...With a win today, can earn its eighth series sweep of the season (five sweeps in 2024, nine sweeps in 2023).

THE HEINE-MAN:

★ Tyler Heineman drove in the eventual game-winning run on Saturday with an RBI double in the 6th inning, before adding a pair of insurance runs with a two-run jack in the 8th...Was his third longball of the year and his first since June 7 at MIN...Finished the day 2-for-3 with a career-high-tying three RBI, his ninth multi-hit game and first career MLB game with multiple extra-base hits.

★ Among players with 95+ plate appearances in the Majors this season, he ranks 2nd in AVG (.341), behind only Aaron Judge (.353)...His .341 AVG is the 2nd-highest by a Blue Jays catcher through their first 35 games of a season in franchise history, trailing only Darrin Fletcher in 2000 (.364)...Entering today's game, ranks 6th among AL catchers (min. 50 PA) in fWAR (1.8), while also compiling six DRS, tied for 6th most among catchers in the Majors.

TAKING BARGE:

★ Addison Barger recorded a career-high four hits in yesterday's contest, notching singles in the 2nd, 4th, and 7th innings to go along with a double in the 6th...Has racked up 22 doubles this season, tied for 11th-most in the AL, trailing only Bo Bichette (25) for the team lead...Finished the day 4-for-4 with a run scored, his 19th multi-hit effort and fifth game with at least three knocks...In 40 games played at Rogers Centre this season, is slashing .288/.352/.545 with 18 extra-base hits, 22 RBI, and an .897 OPS.

★ Since the beginning of May, the Bellevue, WA, native ranks T-1st alongside Byron Buxton among qualified hitters in the AL in hard-hit rate (56.7%), T-2nd in doubles (19), 4th in average exit velocity (93.4 MPH), and T-8th in extra-base hits (32)...Over his last 60 games, is slashing .295/.346/.562 with 32 extra-base hits, 38 RBI, and a .908 OPS.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL:

★ Will Wagner plated a pair of runs in the 6th inning yesterday with a two-run double down the right field line, before singling in the 8th, finishing the game 2-for-4 with two RBI and a run scored, his sixth multi-hit game...Since being recalled from Triple-A Buffalo on June 28, has gone 11-for-33 (.333) with five doubles, four RBI, eight runs scored, four walks, a .436 OBP, and a .921 OPS in 12 contests...With RISP this season, has gone 8-for-23 (.348) with two doubles, six RBI, a .464 OBP, and an .899 OPS.

FEEL THE ERN:

★ Ernie Clement got the Blue Jays on the board in the 6th inning with an RBI single off a full-count sweeper from RHP Logan Webb, before later coming around to score, finishing the day 1-for-3...Is putting the ball in play with RISP 50.6% of the time this season, the 3rd-best mark among qualified hitters in the AL.

OUT OF THE BREAK:

★ The Blue Jays kick off the second half of the season with a six-game homestand (2-0 so far), hosting each of the Giants (52-47) and Yankees (54-44) for a trio of games apiece...Have won nine straight home games, and have gone 21-4 over their last 25 home contests, scoring 6.5 runs per game while slashing .299/.370/.497 with an .868 team OPS...Have won at least 21 times in a 25-game home span (single-season) for the first time since May 2-June 19, 1984 (21W)...Own an MLB-leading .680 win% at home this year (34-16), the best single-season mark in team history (2nd: .675% in 1985).

★ Blue Jays hitters lead all American League clubs in home AVG (.275), home OBP (.346), and home OPS (.800), while ranking 3rd in home SLG (.454), and 3rd in runs per home game (5.30)...On the pitching side, Toronto hurlers sit 2nd in the AL in home strikeout rate (25.2%), 7th in home opponent average (.234), 8th in home WHIP (1.23), and 9th in home walk rate (8.6%).

LEADING THE WAY:

★ Over the last 10 weeks (since May 8th), the Blue Jays have gone 41-21, the best win percentage in the Majors (.661%)...Over that span, the Blue Jays lead the Majors in AVG with RISP (.306), in AVG (.272), and in OBP (.343), while ranking 2nd in hits (573), 3rd in runs per game (5.21), 3rd in OPS (.778), 3rd in walks (215), and 4th in SLG (.435)...Over that span, Blue Jay hitters lead the Majors in strikeout rate (16.4%) and sit 4th in walk rate (9.0%).

WITH GREAT LAUER:

★ Eric Lauer threw 6.0 innings on Saturday, allowing two runs on two hits and no walks with seven strikeouts, his second quality start of the year...Has posted a 2.80 ERA this season, the 4th-lowest through a pitcher's first 15 appearances with the Blue Jays in franchise history (min. 60 IP), trailing only Roger Clemens (1.90), Tom Candiotti (2.28), and Hyun Jin Ryu (2.51).

★ The Blue Jays took two of three games at Oracle Park last season, outscoring their opponents by an 18-13 margin...Last met the Giants in Toronto from June 27-29, 2023, winning two of three games while surrendering a total of five runs...Have hosted the Giants at Rogers Centre just 15 times in the franchise's history (9-6), tied for their sixth-fewest games against any single opponent in this building (COL/PIT/SD - 12G, AZ/STL - 14G)...Have won six of their last seven games against San Fran, and own a 15-8 record over the last 23 meetings between these sides, dating back to 2007.

★ Ernie Clement hit safely in all three games vs. SF last season, going a combined 5-for-11 (.455) with a pair of homers and seven RBI (1.000 SLG, 1.500 OPS)...Took RHP Logan Webb deep in the 5th inning on July 10, 2024, a pitch measured at 0.91 feet off the ground, the 3rd-lowest pitch hit for a home run in MLB last season.

★ George Springer has had a plate appearance in 12 career games vs. SF, hitting safely in 10 of those contests...Is a career .333 hitter (16-for-48) against the Giants, recording four doubles, two homers, and eight RBI for a .542 SLG and a .938 OPS.

★ Kevin Gausman signed with the Giants as a free agent before the 2020 campaign and spent two seasons in a San Francisco uniform, going 17-9 with a 3.00 ERA over 45 games (43 starts), posting a 1.06 WHIP and a 10.9 K/9...Was named an All-Star for the first time in his career in 2021 with San Francisco.

TODAY'S GAME:

- ✦ Making his 21st start of the season...In his last time out on 7/13 at ATH, surrendered 4 runs over 3.0 innings on 5 hits and 2 walks with 1 strikeout.
- ✦ Since making his first start with the Blue Jays in August 2021, has recorded 74 quality starts, trailing only Framber Valdez (83) for the most in the AL over that span.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✦ Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball on 2 hits and 2 walks with 4 punchouts on 7/7 AT CWS...Marked his 12th quality start of the year.
- ✦ Threw 7.0 shutout frames on 6/27 at BOS, scattering 4 hits and a walk with 8 strikeouts (91 pitches, 65 strikes)...Induced 14 whiffs on the night, including 10 with his slurve.
- ✦ Allowed just a single unearned run over a season-high 7.2 frames of work on 6/21 vs. CWS, scattering 2 hits and 3 walks with 5 strikeouts (98 pitches, 58 strikes)...Surrendered no earned runs for the 4th time this season, and the 3rd time in his last 5 games...Marked his 10th quality start of the season.
- ✦ Tossed 6.0+ innings of 2-run ball on 5 hits and 5 walks with a season-high 9 strikeouts on 5/7 vs. LAA...Marked his 4th quality start of the season... Struck out a career-high six consecutive batters from the 1st to the 3rd inning, becoming one of six Blue Jays pitchers to do so in a game, trailing only Alek Manoah (7 on July 12, 2022) for the most in franchise history.
- ✦ Threw 6.2 innings of 2-run ball on 7 hits and 1 walk with a season-high-tying 8 strikeouts on 5/1 vs. BOS...Notched 13 whiffs and 17 called strikes to go along with a 69.3% strike rate (61 strikes on 88 pitches)
- ✦ 4/7 at BOS, tossed a season-high 7.0 innings of 1-run ball on 4 hits and 3 walks with a pair of strikeouts... Earned his 100th career win, becoming one of just 15 active players to reach the mark.
- ✦ Made his 5th career Opening Day start (3rd as a Blue Jay) on 3/27, surrendering six runs on nine hits and a walk with five strikeouts...Joined Roy Halladay (2003-09); Dave Stieb (1983, 1985-86, 1991); and Jimmy Key (1987-89) as the only pitchers to start on Opening Day on at least three occasions for the Blue Jays (also: 2022 & 2024).

OTHER HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✦ Drafted in the 1st round (32nd overall) by the Twins in 2012.
- ✦ Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2013, 2017, and 2023 WBC.
- ✦ Acquired by Toronto from Minnesota on 7/30/21 in exchange for INF Austin Martin and RHP Simeon Woods Richardson.

VS. THE GIANTS:

- ✦ Making his 2nd career start against the Giants...Last met San Francisco on 6/10/17 as a member of the Twins at Oracle Park...In his one start vs. SF, tossed 5.1 innings of 2-run ball (6H, 3BB and 8K) and recorded the second of his two career hits with a single in the 3rd inning off Jeff Samardzija.

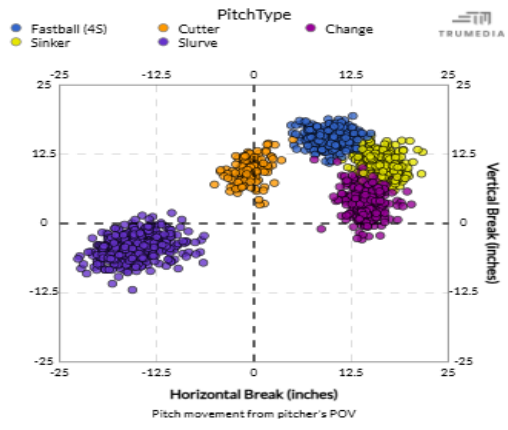
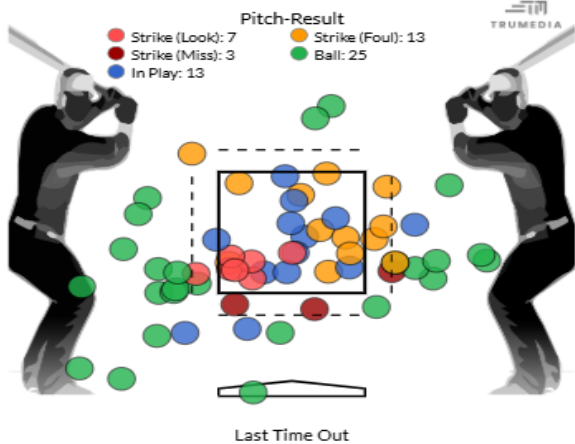

- Signed a minor league contract with TOR on 3/16.
- Has made 27 appearances with Triple-A Buffalo this season, posting a 3.56 ERA with a 3.07 FIP, 1.19 WHIP, 28.9% strikeout rate, 10.2% walk rate, and a 29.6% whiff rate.
- Held hitters at Triple-A to an 85.5 MPH AVG exit velocity and a 36% hard-hit rate.
- Opponents have hit just .203 against his sweeper with a .250 OBP, a 31.9% strikeout rate, 35.8% whiff rate, and a 32.3% chase rate between MLB and Triple-A.

- Against his slider this season, opponents are batting .200 while posting an 85.6 MPH AVG exit velocity with a 32.7% whiff rate.
