## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (59-97) vs. ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (90-66) SEPTEMBER 30, 2022 at BUSCH STADIUM, ST. LOUIS, MO -- GAME #157/ROAD #79 RHP JOHAN OVIEDO (4-2, 3.13 ERA) vs. RHP JACK FLAHERTY (1-1, 4.97 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...had the day off yesterday...Went 4-3 on their seven-game homestand against the Cubs (1-3) and Reds (3-0)...Have won three straight and four of their last five games...Are in the final six games of a stretch that has the team playing each of the last 13 games against the NL Central to close out the year.

**TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:** Infielder/outfielder Tucupita Marcano and right-handed pitchers Nick Mears and Junior Fernández have been added to the Major League taxi squad...In addition, infielder Michael Chavis and outfielder Greg Allen cleared waivers and have been outrighted to the minor leagues.

**GETTING TO KNOW YOU:** Tonight the Pirates begin their final road trip of the season here in St. Louis...Following these three games at Busch Stadium, the teams will meet at PNC Park for the final three games of the 2022 campaign from October 3-5...It will mark the first time the Bucs and Cards face each other in six consecutive games since July 15-18, 1943 (special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau).

**START ME UP:** Pittsburgh's starting rotation has posted a 3.12 ERA (147.1ip/51er) in the team's last 30 games dating back to August 28...The only three starting rotations in all of Major League Baseball to record a lower ERA in that time are the Astros (2.47), Cubs (3.01) and Dodgers (3.09)...In addition, since the beginning of this month, Pittsburgh's starting rotation has posted the lowest batting average against (.202) in all of Major League Baseball.

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** Johan Oviedo returns to St. Louis tonight for his first start against his former team...In his last start Saturday night against the Cubs, the 24-year-old Oviedo scattered three hits, struck out seven batters and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings while winning a 6-0 decision...Oviedo has now recorded a 1.69 ERA (16.0ip/3er) and .158 batting average against in his last three starting assignments.

**CRUZ'N IN SEPTEMBER:** Oneil Cruz has multiple hits in four straight games for the first time in his career, going 10-for-19...Cruz enters today second among National League rookies this month in slugging (.566) and OPS (.911), first in extra base hits (13) and tied for second in total bases (56).

**HELLO NEWMAN:** Kevin Newman enters today with a 10-game hitting streak, which is tied for the second-longest active streak in the NL and is the longest by a Pirate this season...Francisco Lindor of the Mets owns the longest active hit streak in the NL at 13 games...Newman now has four double-digit hitting streaks in his career (he had a 19, 13 and 11-game hit streak in 2019)...Newman also enters today one hit shy of 400 in his career.

**MAKING A GOOD FIRST IMPRESSION:** Miguel Andújar has knocked in a run in each of his first three games since being claimed off waivers by the Pirates on Sunday...It's the first time he has knocked in a run in three straight games since doing so in four straight games from August 17-21, 2018, while playing for the Yankees.

**GOLD AT THE CORNER:** Ke'Bryan Hayes enters today ranked first among all third basemen in MLB in Outs Above Average (16) according to Baseball Savant...According to The Fielding Bible, Hayes' 22 Defensive Runs Saved as a third baseman are also the most in all of MLB at that position (Nolan Arenado is second with nineteen).

**THE RETURN OF THE RENEGADE:** David Bednar picked up his 18th save of the season and first since July 23 in Tuesday's win against the Reds...Five different Pirates earned a save during the time Bednar was on the 15-day injured list with lower back tightness from August 3 to September 22...Eight different Pirates (Bednar, Wil Crowe, Duane Underwood Jr., Chase De Jong, Miguel Yajure, Yerry De Los Santos, Chris Stratton and Eric Stout) have recorded at least one save for the Pirates this season, the most since 1996 (also eight).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Pittsburgh's minor league system ended the 2022 season with a .517 winning percentage...The only three National League organizations to post a better winning percentage were the Rockies (.549), Dodgers (.454) and Padres (.522)...In addition, Pittsburgh had six players named among Baseball America's Top 100 prospects from earlier this month: Termarr Johnson (#44), Quinn Priester (#64), Liover Peguero (#76), Henry Davis (#80), Mike Burrows (#98) and Endy Rodriguez (#100) represent the Pirates in the new rankings.
