MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (437-416) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach Jason Lane (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach Quintin Berry.

HOUSER AT A GLANCE: Adrian Houser, 28, will make his second start of the season.....Houser made his first start of 2021 last Sunday vs. Minnesota and took an 8-2 loss (5ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 77 pitches).....he was acquired from Houston, along with LHP Josh Hader, OF Brett Phillips and OF Domingo Santana, in exchange for OF Carlos Gómez, RHP Mike Fiers and International Signing Bonus Slot #76 on 7/30/15.

LAST SEASON: Houser went 1-6 with a 5.30 ERA in 12 games / 11 starts last season.....the team went 5-6 in his starts.....he made 1 quality start.....opponents batted .285 (63-for-221, 8hr).....he went 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA in his first 2 starts last season (12ip, 1er) and 0-6 with a 6.70 ERA in his last 9 starts (43ip, 32er).

CAREER: Is 7-14 with a 4.12 ERA in 57 games / 30 starts [188ip, 86er].....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers [2015, 2018-21].....is 3-14 with a 4.86 ERA as a starter [140.2ip, 76er] and 4-0 with a 1.90 ERA in relief [47.1ip, 10er].....underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-7 with a 3.90 ERA in 28 games / 14 starts [85.1ip, 37er].....went 0-3 with a 6.95 ERA in 5 starts last season [22ip, 17er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 5-7 with a 4.30 ERA in 29 games / 16 starts [102.2ip, 49er].....went 1-3 with a 4.24 ERA in 7 games / 6 starts last season [34ip, 16er].

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 1-2 with a 4.64 ERA in 7 games / 4 starts [21.1ip, 11er].....his only appearance last season came in relief on 9/27 at Busch Stadium (1ip, 1h).....he induced a 5-4-3 triple play from Yadier Molina in that outing, the ninth triple play in franchise history.....Houser is 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA as a starter against St. Louis (17.1ip, 11er).
