BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game homestand tonight with game two against Chicago-AL after dropping two of three against Washington over the weekend...The O's have lost five of their last six after winning four of six from June 17-22...The Orioles enter play today 4.0 games back in the Wild Card and 11.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East.

👉 **Shane Baz** matched a season high by throwing 7.0 innings last night...He's now done so five times this year, all in nine starts since May 15.

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** batted leadoff for the first time since May 16 and finished 2-for-3 with a double, a walk, and a run scored...He doubled to begin the game last night and is now slashing .272/.323/.565 (50-for-184) with 15 doubles and 13 home runs in his career as the leadoff hitter in the first inning.

👉 The Orioles fell to eight games under .500, matching a season low from May 20 (21-29).

👉 Baltimore batters have struck out at least 10 times in six of the last seven games and in 11 of the last 14 games...The club's 255 strikeouts since the start of June lead the majors.

HIGH SOX: The O's had their nine-game winning streak against the White Sox snapped last night...The club has still won 15 of the last 17 meetings between the teams since 2024 and 24 of 30 since 2022...The nine-game winning streak was tied for the longest in franchise history against Chicago, joining September 4, 1977-September 2 (G2), 1978 and June 13-September 1, 1969.

👉 Baltimore has won nine straight series against Chicago...A win tonight and tomorrow would tie the team's longest winning series streak against a single opponent all-time, done vs. the Washington Senators from 1963-64.

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** has slashed .345/.462/.595 (29-for-84) with six doubles, five homers, 25 runs, 11 RBI, and 19 walks in 23 career games against the White Sox...The 1.057 OPS is his second highest against one team behind the Angels (1.165).

START ME UP: Over the last 27 games since May 30, Baltimore starters have posted a 3.62 ERA (64 ER/159.0 IP), ranked fourth in the AL and eighth in the majors...Prior to this stretch, the rotation had a 4.76 ERA (154 ER/291.1 IP) in the first 58 games of the year, ranked 14th in the AL and 26th in MLB.

👉 Overall, O's pitching owns a 3.87 ERA in 45 games at Camden Yards compared to a 4.98 ERA over 41 road games.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** ranks third in the AL and is tied for fifth in the majors with 58 RBI...He is batting .277/.386/.564 (26-for-94) with three doubles, eight homers, 19 runs, 22 RBI, 16 walks, and two hit-by-pitches in 26 games since June 1.

👉 He is one home run shy of becoming the 28th player in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and **Anthony Santander** (24) in 2024...Henderson, **Jackson Holliday**, and **Jordan Westburg** tied for the team lead with 17 long balls for the entire 2025 season.

👉 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on Saturday and has played 502 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (866 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .358/.407/.528 (44-for-123) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 24 RBI, eight walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 47 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

👉 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 80 PA) in batting average (1st) and on-base percentage (T-8th).

👉 His seven games with at least three hits since May 4 are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge, PHI's Bryce Harper, and PHI's Brandon Marsh.

👉 Alexander is batting .356 (16-for-45) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, and 22 RBI with runners in scoring position...His average with RISP ranks fourth in the AL (min. 40 AB).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-2nd, 66) and times on base (4th, 150)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

👉 Last night marked his first game not batting leadoff since May 16, spanning 39 team games.

👉 Prior to Ward, the only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June.

👉 Ward recorded 64 walks and 76 hits through 80 career games with the Orioles...The only other players to have at least 60 walks and 75 hits through 80 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) were Albert Belle (63 BB, 82 H), Bob Nieman (62 BB, 89 H), and Ken Singleton (68 BB, 89 H).

👉 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 77 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors...St. Louis had an 80-game stretch snapped on Sunday.

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh.

SCORING CHANGE: Major League Baseball has made the following scoring change:

👉 On June 24 at Los Angeles-AL, Nolan Schanuel reached on what was originally ruled a missed catch error by **Keegan Akin** in the 10th inning...This has been changed to an RBI-single with a throwing error by **Jeremiah Jackson**...Schanuel later scored, but his run is still unearned.

QUICK HITS: Gibson is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season (8th appearance) tonight vs. Chicago-AL...Made his MLB debut on May 3 at New York-AL, becoming the third Oriole to do so in 2026 along with **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE) and **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN)...He was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to his start on June 8 vs. Seattle, marking his fourth stint with the O's this season...Gibson is rated the No. 1 Orioles prospect by *Baseball America* and the No. 4 Orioles prospect by *MLB Pipeline*, while *Baseball America* tabs him the No. 97 overall prospect in baseball...Signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on August 9, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 7-6 loss at Los Angeles-AL on June 24 after allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) and two walks in 4.0 innings pitched with five strikeouts...The 4.0 innings marked the shortest start of his career...Threw 66 pitches, 42 strikes.

- Used his four seamer a career-high 27.3 percent of time, with opponents going 0-for-4 on the pitch with three strikeouts.
- Gave up his only runs on a two-run homer by Jorge Soler in the opening frame...Didn't allow a hit after the first inning.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: The Chicago White Sox will mark the eighth team Gibson has faced in his career and his first AL Central opponent...He's 1-1 with a 4.29 ERA (10 ER/21.0 IP) over five career appearances (4 GS) against the AL, including a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) over three games (2 GS) vs. the league at Camden Yards.

K ARTIST: Gibson has recorded a 13.5 K/9 over his last three starts since June 13, recording 20 strikeouts in 13.1 innings pitched...Through his first four MLB appearances (3 GS) from May 3-June 8, he tallied a 2.7 K/9 with two or fewer strikeouts in each of those outings.

- He's one of 10 pitchers in franchise history (since 1954) with 7+ strikeouts in at least two of his first six career appearances.
- However, his 13.6 percent walk rate ranks in the bottom six percent of MLB...He's allowed multiple walks in five of his six starts this season, including 4+ walks in three of those outings.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Gibson made his MLB debut on May 3 at New York-AL (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 2 HR, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K), becoming the first Orioles starter in franchise history (since 1954) to make his major league debut at Yankee Stadium and the eighth to do so vs. New York-AL, joining **Dean Kremer** (9/6/20), **Wei-Yin Chen** (4/10/12), **Jake Arrieta** (6/10/10), **Koji Uehara** (4/8/09), **John Parrish** (7/24/00), **John O'Donoghue** (6/27/93), and **Charlie Beamon** (9/26/56).

THE ARSENAL: Gibson is using his slider at a 21.1 percent clip, holding opponents to a .152/.222/.242 (5-for-33) slash line...Has tallied nine strikeouts with his slider, the most on any of his pitches...Over his last two starts since June 19, he's thrown the offering 31.3 percent of the time with opponents slashing .133/.235/.133 (2-for-15) off it.

- His most utilized pitch is his sinker (26.6%) but opponents went 2-for-3 (.667) with one home run on the offering in his last start on June 24 at Los Angeles-AL...It marked the first extra-base hit allowed on his sinker this season...Overall, batters are hitting .200 (6-for-30) on the pitch.

SPLITS: Opponents are 13-for-39 (.333) against Gibson with two outs, recording three doubles, two home runs, and seven walks...However, they are 18-for-80 (.225) with one double, three home runs, and 12 walks when there are one or zero outs...In the first inning, he's allowed a .400/.471/.833 (12-for-30) opponent slash line with one double and four home runs compared to a .172/.284/.266 (11-for-64) slash line from innings two to four with three doubles and one home run.

- In his last start on June 24 at Los Angeles-AL, his three hits and two runs allowed all came with two outs in the first inning.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Gibson began last season with High-A Aberdeen and made nine appearances (8 GS), striking out 67 batters across 38.2 innings...Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on June 3 and made 10 starts with the Baysox, going 3-2 with a 1.55 ERA (9 ER/52.1 IP) and 68 strikeouts...Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on August 12 and made seven starts to close the year, tallying 31 strikeouts over 29.1 innings...Went 5-8 overall with a 4.26 ERA (57 ER/120.1 IP) and 166 strikeouts in 26 appearances (25 GS) over three levels of the Orioles system.

- Named the 2025 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year, ranking among Orioles minor leaguers in strikeouts (1st), WHIP (2nd, 1.21), starts (T-2nd), opponent average (3rd, .224), ERA (4th), and innings (4th).
