BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles begin a six-game road trip tonight with a three-game series in the nation's capital against the Nationals...Baltimore wraps up the trip with three games at Tampa Bay beginning Monday...The Birds split the last homestand, losing two of three against the Athletics last weekend before taking two of three from the Yankees earlier this week... Yesterday was the team's first scheduled off day since April 27.

⚾ Wednesday's game against the Yankees was the first game this season in which the Orioles were involved in a shutout, for or against...The last MLB team to go at least 43 games without being part of one on either side to start a season was the 2017 Nationals (47 G), per *MLB.com's Sarah Langs*...The only longer such streak by the O's to begin a season was 1996 (66 G).

⚾ On Wednesday, the O's one-hit the Yankees, their first one-hitter since August 15, 2025 at Houston and first at home since July 21, 2019 vs. Boston.

⚾ Baltimore improved to 4-2 in rubber games this year...Wednesday's victory secured a series victory over New York-AL for the first time since April 28-30, 2025 (2-1)...The Birds had dropped nine games in a row and 12 of 13 to the Yankees entering the series.

⚾ **Kyle Bradish** turned in a scoreless start for the first time this season...Excluding openers (1.1+ IP), he's the fourth Oriole starter with a scoreless outing this season, joining **Chris Bassitt** (4/17 at CLE, 5.0 IP), **Brandon Young** (4/6 at CWS, 5.0 IP), and **Trevor Rogers** (3/26 vs. MIN, 7.0 IP).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** is slashing .291/.339/.553 (30-for-103) with nine doubles, six homers, 14 runs, 24 RBI, seven walks, and one hit-by-pitch in 28 games this season...In 18 games since returning from the Injured List with left ankle inflammation on April 21, he's hit all six of those home runs and driven in 21 of his 24 runs.

⚾ He's recorded three catcher framing runs, tied for third in the majors with four others behind SF/CLE's Patrick Bailey and TOR's Brandon Valenzuela (both 4)...Last season, he recorded two, tied for 14th among catchers.

⚾ Rutschman is batting .333/.368/.667 (21-for-63) with five home runs at home and .225/.295/.375 (9-for-40) with one homer on the road.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) with one hit, seven walks, and 22 strikeouts across 20 appearances to begin the season...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

⚾ His .018 (1-for-57) opponent average and 0.42 WHIP are the best among MLB relievers.

⚾ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 20 outings of a season was six (Jesse Orosco, 1997).

⚾ He has not allowed a hit in each of his last eight outings, tied for the longest active run in the majors with SEA's Matt Brash.

⚾ Garcia's 39.7 percent whiff rate trails only SD's Mason Miller (57.2%), SEA's Andrés Muñoz (44.4%), and NYY's Fernando Cruz (42.5%) this season (min. 15.0 IP).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .403/.439/.645 (25-for-62) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine runs, and 12 RBI over his last 18 games since April 20.

⚾ During this period, he is 15-for-34 (.441) with four doubles, one triple, and one home run off fastballs.

⚾ Basallo's 93.0 mph average exit velocity leads MLB catchers ahead of ATH's Shea Langeliers (92.9) and COL's Hunter Goodman (92.6).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** leads the majors with 42 walks and is tied for second in the majors with 83 times on base (40 H, 42 BB, 1 HBP) with ATH's Nick Kurtz, behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (85)...He's second in the majors with 14 doubles behind ATL's Matt Olson (15) and fourth with a .426 on-base percentage.

⚾ He doubled in the sixth inning on Tuesday to snap a career-long 16-game stretch without an extra-base hit...It marked his first double since April 22 at Kansas City.

⚾ His 83 times on base are tied for the third most in a players' first 43 games to begin his time with the Orioles with Albert Belle (1999), trailing Roberto Alomar (92 in 1996) and Frank Robinson (84 in 1966).

⚾ Ward has seen 888 total pitches this season, most in the majors ahead of WSH's James Wood (873) and ATL's Matt Olson (853)...An MLB-best 334 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count.

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's rank fifth in the majors with 9.47 plate appearances per walk this season, trailing the Yankees (8.28), Cubs (8.46), Brewers (8.65), and Guardians (8.89)...The Birds are tied for seventh in MLB with 174 free passes this season.

⚾ **Taylor Ward** is averaging an MLB-best 4.64 plate appearances per walk, ahead of ATH's Nick Kurtz (4.85) and LAA's Mike Trout (5.00).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has allowed one run or fewer in eight consecutive games since May 6 while posting a 1.04 ERA (4 ER/34.2 IP) with 23 hits, five total runs, 13 walks, and one hit batter with 28 strikeouts.

⚾ Baltimore has a 15.1 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/53 IR), second best in the majors behind Seattle (13.0%; 6 IRS/46 IR)...The Orioles posted a 27.6 percent rate last season, ranked eighth in MLB.

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

BATTLE OF THE BELTWAY: The Orioles and Nationals meet on Rivalry Weekend for the first of two series this season...Washington travels to Camden Yards from June 26-28.

⚾ The O's lost five of six meetings between the teams last year after entering the season having won nine of the previous 11 games and 12 of the prior 15 in the series.

⚾ **Pete Alonso** has hit 28 career home runs against the Nationals, second most in his career behind the Marlins (33)...He's hit 15 of those at Nationals Park, second most by a visiting player at the ballpark all time behind NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (22).

⚾ Orioles infield coach Miguel Cairo joined the Nationals as bench coach in 2024 and was the interim manager from July 7, 2025 until the end of the season.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his ninth start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on May 9 vs. the Athletics after working 4.2 innings, allowing five runs on five hits (1 HR) and three walks with five strikeouts...Threw 100 pitches, 62 strikes.

⚡ Has thrown at least 95 pitches in a career-high seven straight starts, surpassing his previous high of three (2x, last: 6/15-26/25)...He is the first Oriole to accomplish the feat since Alex Cobb, who did so in seven consecutive starts from August 1-September 4, 2018...The last O's hurler to do so in eight straight was Kevin Gausman's nine-start stretch from April 6-May 22, 2018.

NEW TO THE DISTRICT: Baz is set to make his first career start against the Nationals... Has made five career starts against NL East opponents, going 2-2 with a 4.33 ERA (13 ER/27.0 IP).

CUTTING IT UP: Baz has held opponents to a .195/.283/.390 (8-for-41) line with two doubles, one home run, and a 17.4 percent strikeout rate off his cutter.

⚡ The .195 opponent average is the fifth lowest among any cutter in MLB (min. 40 AB ending in pitch), trailing NYY's Cam Schlittler (.113), TB's Drew Rasmussen (.145), MIL's Chad Patrick (.163), and NYY's Max Fried (.170).

⚡ The opposition has combined to slash .323/.373/.531 (42-for-130) with 18 doubles, three home runs, and a 20.0 percent strikeout rate on all his other offerings.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 20 doubles, ahead of COL's Michael Lorenzen (16)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his eight starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 14 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted five home runs over 72.2 innings (0.62 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

LEFT SIDE STORY: Left-handed hitters are slashing .323/.400/.500 (31-for-96) with 14 doubles, one home run, and 14 walks, compared to .253/.301/.493 (19-for-75) with six doubles, four home runs, and five walks by righties.

⚡ He has limited lefties to a .207 (6-for-29) clip over his last three starts after they went 25-for-67 (.373) with 10 doubles over his first five outings.

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 3-for-20 (.150) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

⚡ Baz has allowed hitters to go 12-for-26 (.462) with six doubles and one home run on the first pitch of an at-bat.

⚡ Has limited opponents to a .234 (15-for-64) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 35-for-107 (.327) clip the second, third, and fourth time through.
