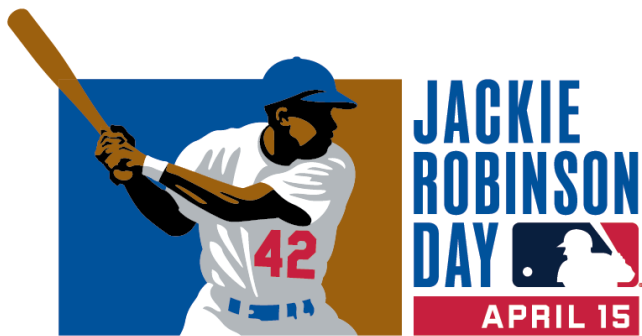

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants continue their six-game road trip to Florida with today's opener in Miami...SF can get back to .500 on the road this trip with a victory today after dropping two of three at Tampa Bay over the weekend.

- ▶ SF went an even 3-3 against the Marlins last season with a +2 run differential (21-19)...the Marlins took two of three at loanDepot park last April 17-19.
- ▶ Of the six games between these teams last season, five were decided by two runs or fewer, with the Giants going 2-3 in such games.
- ▶ SF has not won a series at Miami since the 2016 season (six consecutive series without a win)...according to *Stats, LLC*, this streak is SF's longest in Miami all-time, and tied for its second-longest active streak on the road against a single opponent (having not won their last seven series in Seattle).



**JACKIE ROBINSON DAY:** Major League Baseball, in coordination with the Robinson Family, MLB Clubs and various partners, announced Baseball's efforts to celebrate the legacy of Jackie Robinson through the MLB Together platform ([www.MLBTogether.com](http://www.MLBTogether.com)) on Jackie Robinson Day - Monday, April 15th.

- ▶ As is tradition, players, managers and coaches will once again wear Robinson's iconic number on April 15th, with all teams using Dodger blue "42" jersey numbers (regardless of their primary team colors).
- ▶ Additionally, Players, coaches, managers, and umpires will have New Era caps with a "42" side patch. Nike Breaking Barriers t-shirts will also be worn during batting practice.

**STAY HOT: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** added another hit yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 10 games.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 14 of 16 games this season, and is slashing .375/.479/.525 with seven runs, three doubles, a home run and four RBI.
- ▶ He ranks among MLB's leaders in batting average (T-4th), OBP (3rd), and BB% (16.7%, T-9th).

**BANG BANG:** The Giants are one of four teams to have two or more players inside MLB's top-15 of hard-hits (95mph+) this year according to *Statcast*...leading the club are **OF Jung Hoo Lee** (28) and **IF Matt Chapman** (27), who rank 11th and 14th, respectively.

**SOUTHPAW IN THE SOUTH: LHP Kyle Harrison** has thrown his fastball 67.2% of his pitches this season, with 14 of his 17 strikeouts coming on the pitch.

- ▶ Miami has struggled against four-seam fastballs this season, with their .204 batting average ranking third-lowest, and their .580 OPS ranking second-lowest in MLB, while their 76.3% out rate stands as the third-highest in the Majors.
- ▶ Against left-handers, Miami has a .179 average, which is 28th in MLB, and a .490 OPS, which is the lowest in MLB.

**CONFORTABLE ENVIRONMENT: OF Michael Conforto** has had solid success against the Marlins in his nine-year MLB career, slashing .290/.408/.562 with 56 runs, 17 doubles, 20 home runs, 58 RBI and a .326 BABIP over 92 games.

- ▶ At loanDepot park, Conforto has a .278/.391/.492 slash line with six home runs and 23 RBI over 41 games.

- ▶ **RHP Mason Black** was named Triple-A PCL Pitcher of the Week for his start on April 12 vs. El Paso in which he struck out seven while allowing two walks and no hits over 5.0 shutout innings...he is 1-1 with a 1.98 ERA (3er, 13.2ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.02 WHIP over three starts for Sacramento this season.
- ▶ **LHP Dylan Carmouche** also turned in a hitless performance to be named Single-A CAL Pitcher of the Week, striking out five while walking one across 4.0 shutout innings for the SJ Giants on April 10 at Visalia.

**TODAY'S START:** Harrison is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season tonight in the first game of this three-game series in Miami...Harrison is 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (9er, 17.0ip) in his three starts so far this season.

**ABOUT KYLE:** Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Tuesday vs. Washington in SF's 5-3 defeat...struck out a season-high eight in 6.0 innings but allowed three runs on five hits.

**FROM SIS:** According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 9-for-18 with two homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 8-for-46 (.174) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

**THE FASTBALL:** Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 67.2% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (James Paxton, 68%).

**NO FREE PASSES:** Has limited the walks through his first three starts, allowing just three free passes in 17.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

**2023 SEASON:** Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

### #58 NICKAVILA ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball  
**Last Game:** 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb, k (25 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Has appeared in just three of SF's 12 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach... would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker  
**Last Game:** 4/7 vs. SD; SV, 1.0ip, h, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Hasn't appeared in a game for SF since last Sunday (April 7).
- ▶ Recorded his first save of the season last Sunday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider  
**Last Game:** 4/13 at TB; 1.0ip, 2k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last four outings, Miller has struck out eight hitters over 4.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 14 at-bats (.071).
- ▶ Has appeared in seven games for SF, allowing six runs in 7.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

### #33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Cutter  
**Last Game:** 4/14 at TB; 0.1ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 5.0innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is 1-0-3 with a 2.00 ERA and 15 strikeouts (9.0ip) in 11 career appearances vs. the Marlins.
- ▶ Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- ▶ Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

### #71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider  
**Last Game:** 4/9 vs. WSH; 1.1ip, 2h, r, er, k (27 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's first 16 games, allowing three runs (two on HRs) in 5.1ip.
- ▶ Averaged just 5.64 pitches per inning this spring.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ 45 of his 60 strikeouts last year came with his slider, with batters hitting .187 off the pitch.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (267g).

### #65 LANDEN ROUPE ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter
