LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Tuesday vs. Washington in SF's 5-3 defeat...struck out a seasonhigh eight in 6.0 innings but allowed three runs on five hits.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues... opposing hitters are 9-for-18 with two homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 8-for-46 (.174) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 67.2% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (James Paxton, 68%).

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first three starts, allowing just three free passes in 17.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.
