RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their final homestand before the All-Star break against the Yankees (2-1) and Guardians (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...despite a 2-4 record in their last six games, the Rays 12-8 (.600) mark since June 19 is tied with the Twins for third best in the AL, trailing the Astros (16-4/800) and Red Sox (12-6/667)...have been at .500 an AL-most 19 times, tied with 2017 for most before the All-Star break in club history...have not been more than five games below or three games above .500...are in fourth place in the AL East for the 23rd consecutive day...in order to enter the All-Star break with a winning record for a franchise-record seventh consecutive season (excl. 2020), Tampa Bay must sweep this series...since 2008, the club has held a winning record at the break in 13 of 15 seasons (2016, 2014)...the Rays have the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .535 (Elias).

★ The Rays won their seventh straight rubber game with last night's 5-4 victory over the Yankees, the third-longest streak in club history behind a pair of eight-game runs, according to Elias (July-Sept. 2018; June-Sept. 2008).

★ Tampa Bay went 3-for-11 (.273) with runners in scoring position after being held to a 4-for-34 (.118) clip with RISP in their previous five games.

★ Since the beginning of May, the Rays are 27-6 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 5-24 with three runs or fewer...they have won nine consecutive games when scoring at least four times.

★ The Rays are 7-3 in their last 10 games at Tropicana Field on the heels of a 5-14 stretch...their 2.70 ERA (90.OIP, 27ER) at home over that timeframe (since June 13) ranks second in the AL behind the White Sox (2.61).

SERIES-IV SPEAKING—The Rays have won six of their last seven series after a 10-11-2 start in series play...they have won nine of 13, 11 of 17, and 13 of their last 20 sets...Tampa Bay has won each of its last four home series, its longest streak since claiming six straight from Aug. 11-Sept. 10, 2023...the Rays are 5-1 in their last six series openers and have won four straight series-opening contests at home, their longest single-season streak since claiming five in a row from July 25-Sept. 19, 2023.

TAJ TIME—Taj Bradley is 2-1 with a 1.29 ERA (35.OIP, 5ER) in his last six starts, the second-lowest ERA in the majors over that timeframe (since June 8) behind PIT Paul Skenes (1.14)...it marks the lowest ERA by a Ray over a six-start span (min. 25.OIP) since Shane McClanahan (1.13) from June 9-July 8, 2022...Bradley ranks among AL leaders during that stretch in strikeouts (4th, 45), opp. average (4th, .184) and WHIP (10th, 1.03)...on the season, his 30.6 pct. strikeout rate ranks third among AL starters (min. 10GS), trailing CWS Garrett Crochet (34.8%) and DET Jack Flaherty (32.1%)...over his last five home starts since May 26, he has pitched to a 0.64 ERA (28.OIP, 2ER), second lowest in MLB behind DET Tarik Skubal (0.44).

★ The Rays rotation has turned in a 3.18 ERA (85.OIP, 30ER) since June 23, third lowest in the majors behind the Mets (2.82) and Royals (2.93)...Rays starters have allowed two runs or fewer in 12 of 16 games during that timeframe.

BLAST OFF—Last night, Yandy Diaz laced a 117.4-mph double in the 3rd inning, marking the hardest-hit ball of his career and the highest exit velocity recorded at Tropicana Field in the Statcast era (since 2015)...it signaled the Rays second-hardest-hit ball under Statcast, trailing only Nelson Cruz's 117.5-mph homer on Sept. 10, 2021 at Detroit...on the season, Diaz's 154 hard-hit balls (95+ mph) are tied for third most in the majors behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (165) and LAD Shohei Ohtani (160)...with 15 games remaining in July, his 154 hard-hit balls are already the most before the calendar flips to August by a Ray under Statcast, surpassing his own mark of 152 from last season.

DAWGS GOTTA EAT—After matching a season high with three hits last night, Brandon Lowe is slashing .327/.397/.655 (18-for-55) with 3 2B, 5 HR and 8 RBI in his last 17 games since June 16, posting the AL's fifth-best OPS (1.051) over that span (min. 50PA)...this season, Lowe, who is 10-for-24 (.417) across his last seven games, has produced his highest barrel rate since 2020 (17.5%) at 14.0 pct. while owning a career-low 31.4 pct. whiff rate.

★ Lowe has been at his best as a designated hitter...he is batting .351/.467/.730 (13-for-37) in 13 games at DH, including 5-for-9 (.556) in his last two, compared to .209/.296/.373 (23-for-110) in 33 games at second base.

RUNNIN' RAYS—Since July 1, the Rays are 9-for-11 (84.6%) on stolen base attempts, the second-most thefts in the AL behind the Athletics (13)...Josh Lowe leads the club with 3 SB this month—he has an AL-leading 6 SB in his last 13 games since June 23...on the season, Tampa Bay's 92 SB pace the AL, ahead of the Red Sox (88SB), and rank fifth in the majors...the club is looking to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break for the second consecutive season (111SB in 2023).

★ Despite going 13 games since his last stolen base, tied for the longest drought of his career (also May 22-June 7, 2023), José Caballero still leads the AL with 24 SB, outpacing BOS David Hamilton (23SB)...Caballero could join Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

★ Rays catchers have collected an AL-most 4 CS this month, throwing out four of five would-be base stealers...they entered July with an 11.9 caught stealing pct. (10-for-84), tied with the Cardinals for the lowest mark in the majors.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—After permitting a pair of homers last night, the Rays have yielded the most home runs before the All-Star break in franchise history (124), surpassing the 2000 club (122)...the Rays -40 (124-84) home run differential is second worst in the majors, ahead of only the Blue Jays -44 (128-84), but they have out-homered opponents, 30-27 (+3), over their last 22 games.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays own the majors' second-best record in both one-run games (17-9/.654) and games decided by two runs or fewer (32-15/.681), trailing the Red Sox (11-5/.688) and Phillies (26-12/.684), respectively...Tampa Bay is 13-4 at home in games decided by two runs or fewer, including wins in five of six and seven of their last nine contests...they are 14-32 (.304) overall in games decided by 3+ runs, better than only the White Sox (12-38/.240) among AL clubs.

★ From May 18-June 19, 10 of the Rays 11 wins came in come-from-behind fashion...they have not trailed in nine of their last 11 victories since that stretch.

STUCK IN NEUTRAL—The Rays have held a .500 record at the end of play 19 times, second most in the majors behind the Padres (25)...according to Elias, the Rays 19 times at .500 match 2017 for the most before the All-Star break in franchise history...they can set a new club record by improving to 47-47 with a victory tonight...the full-season record is 22 times, also set in 2017, followed by 20 in 2015 and 19 this season.

EN GARDE!—The Rays and Guardians open a seven-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...Tampa Bay will visit Progressive Field from Sept. 12-15...the clubs split a six-game season set in 2023, with four of the six meetings decided by one run, three of which were walk-offs...Tampa Bay is 5-8 in the last 13 meetings on the heels of an 11-game winning streak from May 19, 2019-July 24, 2021...the Rays are seeking their first season series win over the Guardians since winning three straight from 2018-21 (clubs did not meet in 2020), having gone 3-3 last year and 2-4 in 2022.

★ Brandon Lowe is 10-for-29 (.345) with 3 XBH and 4 RBI in his last eight games against Cleveland dating to July 30, 2022...Taylor Walls is batting .292 (7-for-24) in 10 career games against the Guardians, his highest average against any AL opponent.

CONNECTIONS

- ★ Rays Manager Kevin Cash was Cleveland's bullpen coach under Terry Francona from 2013-14... Cash played under Francona for parts of three seasons (2007-08, 2010) during the latter's stint as Boston's skipper.
- ★ Guardians Manager Stephen Vogt began his playing career with the Rays in 2012, appearing in 18 games...the 2007 Tampa Bay draftee (12th rd.) is one of seven former Rays players that have served as MLB managers, including one of four active skippers (Cash, MIN Baldelli, WSH Martinez).
- ★ Guardians Bench Coach Craig Albernaz spent 13 seasons in the Rays minor league system as a player (2006-13) and coach (2015-19)...he managed Class-A Hudson Valley to a NY-Penn League championship in 2017 on a team that featured Rays INF Taylor Walls...Albernaz graduated from St. Pete's Eckerd College in 2005.
- ★ Cleveland Director, Amateur Scouting Ethan Purser worked in the Rays amateur scouting department from 2015-16.
- ★ Rays Director, Amateur Scouting Chuck Ricci spent 15 seasons in Cleveland's organization from 1998-2012.
- ★ Shawn Armstrong (2015-17), Yandy Diaz (2017-18) and Richie Palacios (2022) all began their MLB careers with Cleveland.
- ★ Amed Rosario suited up for 388 games with the Guardians from 2021-23...he was sent to the Dodgers at last season's trade deadline.
- ★ Kevin Kelly was a Cleveland farmhand from 2019-22 before the Rockies took him in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and dealt him to the Rays.
- ★ Bally Sports Sun announcer Brian Anderson had two stints with Cleveland during his playing career (1996-97, 2003), helping the club to the World Series in 1997...he was inducted into the Greater Cleveland Sports Hall of Fame in 2015...Anderson attended Geneva High School, less than an hour from Cleveland.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will make his 12th start of the season this evening, including his eighth at home...has worked 5.0+ innings in 10 of his 11 starts...owns a 1.76 ERA (41.0IP, 8ER) in seven starts at Tropicana Field (0.64 in last 5GS)...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before his May 10 reinstatement.

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on July 6 at Texas...tossed 6.0 innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits and two walks with five strikeouts...allowed a two-out, run-scoring single to **Andrew Knizner** in the 2nd inning...another RBI-single by **Nathaniel Lowe** in the 3rd frame was preceded by a passed ball from **Alex Jackson**.
 Bradley has issued multiple walks in a career-high five straight starts...the last Tampa Bay hurler to do so in six straight starts within a single season was **Charlie Morton** (6GS, March 29-April 27, 2019).

GUARDIAN OF THE TROP—Bradley's lone career start opposite Cleveland came last season at Progressive Field on Sept. 3...he did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.0 innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and a career-high five walks while fanning seven...prior to Bradley, the last pitcher to have 5+ BB and 7+ SO against the Guardians was **Carlos Rodón** on April 20, 2021 (W, 5.0IP, 3H, 2R, 1ER, 5BB, 8SO).

Bradley owns a 3.05 ERA (20.2IP, 7ER) in four career starts against AL Central opponents, including a 1.64 ERA (11.0IP, 2ER) in two outings this season.

STRINGS OF SUCCESS—In six starts since June 8, Bradley owns a 1.29 ERA (35.0IP, 5ER), the lowest mark in the majors during that stretch...during this period, he has limited the opposition to a .184 (23-for-125) average, struck out 45 batters and posted a 1.03 WHIP.

He is the first Rays starter to work 5.0+ IP and allow 2 ER or fewer in six straight starts since **Tyler Glasnow** (6GS: July 7-Aug. 14, 2023)...it is tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors behind **AZ Merrill Kelly** (7GS)...the last Rays pitcher to accomplish the feat in seven straight starts was **Shane Bieber** (9GS: Oct. 1, 2022-May 8, 2023).

THE RIGHT ANSWERS—Over his last five starts, Bradley has limited right-handed hitters to a .151/.211/.208 (8-for-53) line, allowing 1 XBH (HR by MIN **Royce Lewis**)...min. 100 AB, his .187 opp. average against righties on the season is third lowest in the AL, trailing only NYY **Luis Gil** (.149) and KC **Brady Singer** (.171).

Bradley has limited righties to a .182 (8-for-44) average on his four-seam fastball compared to a .321 (18-for-56) mark vs. lefties.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—Bradley's 205 SO are fourth most in a pitcher's first 32 starts after joining the Rays, trailing **Charlie Morton** (231, 2019), **Tyler Glasnow** (213, 2018-20) and **Drew Smyly** (210, 2014-16)...Morton (240) also holds the mark through 33 starts, followed by Glasnow (223) and Smyly (215)...Bradley's 205 SO are the most by a Ray in his first 32 career starts, outpacing **Shane Bieber** (199, 2021-22).

His 30.6 pct. strikeout rate is third highest among AL starters (min. 10GS)...he trails CWS **Garrett Crochet** (34.8%) and DET **Jack Flaherty** (32.1%).

Bradley is one of six AL pitchers with multiple 11+ SO games, joining Crochet (4G), CLE **Tanner Bibee**, BAL **Corbin Burnes**, KC **Cole Ragans** and Skubal (all 2GS).

DOME SWEET DOME—Bradley has turned in an 0.64 ERA (28.1IP, 2ER) across his last five home starts, producing a 0.86 WHIP and .126/.224/.189 (12-for-95) opp. slash line while yielding 2 XBH (2HR)...5 of the 8 ER he has allowed at home came on May 20 vs. Boston—in his other six starts at Tropicana Field, Bradley has pitched to a 0.79 ERA (34.0IP, 3ER).

His 1.76 home ERA (41.0IP, 8ER) is fifth lowest in the majors (min. 40.0IP) behind ATL **Reynaldo López** (1.24), CWS **Erick Fedde** (1.47), PHI **Cristopher Sánchez** (1.50) and DET **Tarik Skubal** (1.74).
