NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals continue this three-game weekend series against the Atlanta Braves on Saturday afternoon...The Nationals dropped Friday night's tilt, 5-4, in extra innings.

- This series features two of the top offenses in Major League Baseball...Washington leads MLB with 284 runs and 5.46 runs per game, ahead of Atlanta with 281 runs and 5.40 runs per game...The Braves (1st, .442) and Nationals (4th, .414) each rank in the top five in MLB in slugging percentage and OPS where Atlanta is first (.770) and Washington is fourth (.738).
- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 6-5 during this stretch so far.

A IS FOR ABRAMS AND...ALL-STAR?

With All-Star voting set to open in a few weeks, **CJ Abrams** has placed himself among the best players in Major League Baseball, as well as one of the top shortstops in the National League...See chart to the right for Abrams' rankings among National League shortstops.

- He leads Major League Baseball with 45 RBI...He ranks among National League hitters in OPS (2nd, .947), on-base percentage (4th, .391), wRC+ (4th, 163), slugging percentage (5th, .556), extra-base hits (T5th, 24), wOBA (6th, .408), hits (T6th, 56), and batting average (10th, .299).
- He's reached safely in 11 straight games, posting a .412 on-base percentage during the streak (13 H, 5 BB, HBP).

HOMER HAPPY

Washington's 26 home runs since May 6 are the most in Major League baseball ahead of the Chicago White Sox (23) and Philadelphia Phillies (23)...The Nationals have homered at least once in 12 of the 16 games since May 6.

- Washington leads Major League Baseball with a .490 slugging percentage and 73 extra-base hits over this stretch...The 73 extra-base hits are 23 more than the next closest club (San Francisco, 50).

BULL PENNING

Over the last three games (19.2 IP), Washington's bullpen has struck out 20 batters, issued five walks and has pitched to a 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP)...Notable performances include:

- Clayton Beeter** has tossed two hitless outings (2.0 IP) with four strikeouts and one walk since returning from the Injured List on May 21.
- Andrew Alvarez** recorded his first career save on May 20 vs. New York (4.0 IP; 2 H, 2 ER, HR, BB 5 SO).
- Brad Lord** has not issued a walk in his last four outings while striking out 10 batters over this stretch...On the season, he's recorded 4.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio (26 SO/6 BB).
- Richard Lovelady** is 1-1 with three saves, three holds and a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) and 13 strikeouts in his last 13 outings...He's posted a 1.88 ERA in 14 games with the Nationals.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals are 14-11 (.583) since April 25 and have won five of their eight series over this stretch, with one series split against the New York Mets (May 18-21).

- In the 14 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.86 ERA and a .214 opponents' average with 130 strikeouts and 37 walks in 129.0 innings pitched.
- Washington's 25 wins are the most through 52 games for any Nationals club since the 2018 Nationals were 29-23 (.558) through their first 52 games.
- The Nationals have a 15-11 (.600) record on the road this season...Washington has taken at least a share of five of the last six series away from home.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 5.46 runs per game and with 284 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 42 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 105 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 30 times this season, tied for the most in MLB with the Chicago Cubs.

BACKSTOP BAT

Keibert Ruiz has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, going 13-for-30 (.433) with six doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, one walk, one stolen base and eight runs scored...He is in the midst of a six-game hitting streak along the way.

- On the season, Ruiz ranks tied for second among all Major League catchers with 11 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in isolated power (4th, .240) and slugging percentage (5th, .500).

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.2 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.8).

- Wood is one of four players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (2), **Junior Caminero** (2), **O'Neil Cruz** (2) and **Ketel Marte** (2).
- His 32 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch) are the most in MLB ahead of **Aaron Judge** (28) and **Kyle Schwarber** (28) and his 62 batted balls over 100 MPH are second in MLB behind **Michael Harris II** (64).

ACE OF BASES

The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams in baseball according to the advanced metrics:

- Per Baseball Savant, the Nationals are tied for the Major League lead with five baserunning runs (*A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.*)
- According to FanGraphs, Washington ranks second in Major League Baseball in their baserunning metric, baserunning runs above average, at 5.1.6. Baserunning runs above average is *all encompassing baserunning statistic that turns stolen bases, caught stealings, and other base running plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average.*
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with four baserunning runs and is second with 3.7 baserunning runs above average...His 22 stolen bases lead MLB ahead of **Jose Ramirez** (20).

CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- Ranks first in Major League Baseball with 76 starts since the start of the 2024 season... His 414.1 innings pitched since 2024 are ninth most.
- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the "Best Control" in Washington's system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin tossed 4.0 innings, striking out six and allowing two earned runs on six hits and one walk against the New York Mets on May 18 in his 100th career start.

VS. ATLANTA

Irvin is set to make his ninth career start against the Braves, tied for the most of any opponent with the Mets...He holds a 2-3 record against Atlanta with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER/43.0 IP).

CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting .135 (5-for-37) against Irvin's curveball...The .162 opponents' slugging percentage ranks fourth best among all qualified pitchers for the curveball.

- He has given up one extra-base hit on his curveball this season.

2025

Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.

- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
- Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Worked 7.0 innings or more in four starts this season...He went 3-0 in those games.
- Went 6-5 in games he completed 6.0 innings...Pitched to a 4.32 ERA in those 16 games.
- The Nationals 15 wins in his starts were the most for any Nationals starter.
- **2025 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (32.2%) Curve (29.6%) Sinker (21.9%) Change (7.7%) Slider (4.4%) Cutter (4.1%)

2024

In first full Major League season, his 33 starts were tied for the most in MLB...Led Washington and ranked fifth in the National League with 187.2 innings pitched.

- Also led the Nationals and ranked 10th in the National League with a 1.20 WHIP...Tied MacKenzie Gore for the team lead with 10 wins.
- Led Major League pitchers with six defensive runs saved, according to FanGraphs.com and Sports Info Solutions.
- **2024 Pitch Mix:** Four-Seam (37.9%) Curveball (31.3%) Sinker (20.5%) Cutter (6.5%) Changeup (3.5%) Slider (0.3%)
