THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won, 12-5, vs. White Sox.

- The D-backs plated multiple runs over 3 frames, including 3 in the first, 6 in the fourth and 2 in the sixth
- Christian Walker collected his 16th homer in the first inning to mark his fourth in his last 5 games.
- Jordan Montgomery notched his fifth win (0 ER in 5.0 IP) with only 4 hits allowed and 7 strikeouts.

MAKE OUR SNAKES ALL-STARS: Ketel Marte, in second place among NL second basemen (608,807 votes), leads D-backs vote getters in first balloting update for 2024 MLB All-Star Game.

- Christian Walker currently sits at sixth among first basemen (112,385 votes) while Joc Pederson sits at sixth among designated hitters ( 81,340 votes).
- Phase 1 balloting ends on Thursday, June 27 at 9:00 a.m. AZ with finalists announced later that day at 3:00 p.m. AZ on MLB Network.

SERIES-LY: The D-backs' have won or split their last 5 series dating back to May 30.

VS. NATIONALS: The D-backs went 5-1 vs. Nationals last season, including a 3-game sweep @ Nationals last June 6-7 \& 22 (June 22 was the makeup of the June 8 game postponed due to "clearly hazardous air quality conditions").

- Have won 5 straight road games @ Nationals and are 12-9 on the road since 2017.
- Are 9-2 vs. Nationals since April 20, 2022.

NL'S BEST: Ketel Marte's 4.0 bWAR leads the NL and is fifth in the Majors, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (5.0), Gunnar Henderson/BAL (5.0), Juan Soto/NYY (4.3) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4.3).

- Marte leads all second basemen with a 4.0 bWAR, an . 852 OPS, 31 extra-base hits, 11 defensive runs saved, is second with 1.3 dWAR, 15 doubles, 14 homers, 39 RBI and third with 109 times on base, 78 hits.

CORBIN'S CAREER BEST STREAK: Corbin Carroll is currently riding a career-high 17-game on-base streak (since May 29), the second-longest active on-base streak in the NL, behind J.D. Martinez/NYM (20).

- Is batting . 299 (20-for-67)/. 800 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI, 10 walks ( 9 strikeouts), 1 HBP and 3 stolen bases...previous high was 15 straight from April 3-19.

JUNE BOOM: The D-backs are 10-5 (.667) in June, tied for the fourth-best winning pct. in the Majors (also: Yankees), behind the Mariners (.733, 11-4), Mets (.714, 10-4) and Orioles (.688, 11-5).

OFFENSE HEATING UP: The D-backs offense, since June 1, is second in the Majors with 210 times on base ( $\mathrm{H}, \mathrm{BB}$, HBP), 87 RBI, tied for second with 54 extra-base hits, 148 hits and third with a .287 AVG, .841 OPS.

AT THE DISH: Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games, batting .351 (20-for-57)/1.079 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI, 11 walks ( 10 strikeouts) and 2 hit by pitches.
