TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to make it two in a row with a win in tonight's series opener vs. Colorado...SF snapped its eight-game losing streak to start the season vs. AZ with its win on Wednesday.

- ▶ The Giants went 1-2 in Colorado May 29-31, yet outscored the Rockies 28-22 in the series thanks to a 19-6 win on May 31.
- ▶ SF has won five of its last nine games, and three of its last five series coming into today.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: RHP Logan Webb was named National League Pitcher of the Month today for June...Webb led the Majors in June with a 0.71 ERA (3er, 38.0ip) and a .370 opposing OPS, while tying for the MLB lead with a 0.61 WHIP.

- ▶ Webb's 0.71 ERA was the lowest in a calendar month (min. five games started and 35.0 innings pitched) by an SF starter since Noah Lowry logged a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...Webb's 0.71 ERA in June is the sixth-lowest ERA in a single month by a Giants starter since 1912.
- ▶ The Northern California native is the first Giants pitcher to win Pitcher of the Month since LHP Robbie Ray in May of 2025...he is the first Giants right-handed pitcher to win the award since Kevin Gausman in May of 2021.
- ▶ A Giants pitcher has now won a Pitcher of the Month award in each of the last three seasons (Webb in 2026, Ray in 2025 and Blake Snell in June of 2024).

WEBB VS. THE ROX: RHP Logan Webb will make his first start of July and second start vs. the Rockies this season (also May 29 at Coors Field)...in that start, which was his first since being activated off the 15-day IL (right knee bursitis), Webb allowed one run on three hits and three walks while striking out five over 4.1 innings.

- ▶ Webb is 11-3 with a 2.94 ERA (38er, 116.1ip), 109 strikeouts and a 1.16 WHIP in 20 career games (19 starts) vs. the Rockies...Webb's 2.94 ERA is the best against the Rockies among active pitchers (min. 12 starts vs. COL).
- ▶ Among pitchers with at least 16 career starts vs. the Rockies all-time, Webb's 2.94 ERA is tied with former Giants pitcher Johnny Cueto for second-best behind only another former Giants pitcher, Randy Johnson, and his 2.47 ERA.
- ▶ Since returning from the IL, Webb has limited opponents to a .184 batting average (7x38) and a .416 OPS vs. his changeup...opponents are batting .115 (3x26) with a .231 OPS vs. his sweeper in that span.

ARE THE MOUNTAINS BLUE YET?: The Giants are 60-20 (.750) vs. the Rockies since the start of the 2021 season...SF's 60-20 record vs. Colorado is the best in the Majors for any team against a divisional opponent in that time per Stats, LLC.

- ▶ OF Drew Gilbert is one of two Giants in franchise history to have three or more homers and a triple in their first nine career games vs. the Rockies (also Barry Bonds).
- ▶ IF Willy Adames is one of 32 Giants to have 20+ RBI vs. COL while playing for SF...of those 32, Adames is the only one to reach the 20 RBI mark in his first 16 games for SF vs. COL.
- ▶ IF Rafael Devers is the first Giants batter to have nine extra-base hits over their first nine games with the Giants vs. the Rockies.

BERICOTO BOMBS: OF Victor Bericoto put SF up 3-0 with a two-run homer in the 5th inning on Wednesday that measured 422 feet...his three homers of 420+ feet lead the team.

- ▶ Bericoto is one of five Giants since 1991 to have four or more homers in their first 19 career MLB games, joining Grant McCray (five homers in 2024), Blake Sabol (four homers in 2023), Aramis Garcia (four homers in 2018) and Jarrett Parker (six homers in 2015).
- ▶ Five different Giants have an RBI in their debut 2026 season (Bericoto, C Drew Cavanaugh, OF Jonah Cox, C/IF/OF Jesús Rodríguez and C Daniel Susac), which is second-most in MLB behind Chicago-AL's seven such players.

T-MAC: In his start vs. AZ on Wednesday, RHP Trevor McDonald became one of four Giants rookies in team history to throw 6.0+ shutout innings in a start vs. the Diamondbacks, joining Dereck Rodríguez (6.1 innings on June 30, 2018), Madison Bumgarner (7.1 innings on September 6, 2010) and Tim Lincecum (July 1, 2007).

- ▶ The Giants as a whole have 19 starts of 6.0+ innings and one or fewer runs allowed...the 19 such games are T-8th most in MLB, and T-3rd most in the NL.

GOLD GLOVE: 2025 | ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

JUNE BLOOM: Was named NL Pitcher of the Month in June after leading all MLB pitchers with a 0.71 ERA (3er, 38.0ip) in five starts...went 3-1 in the month with a .148 opposing average, .370 OPS, 0.61 WHIP and a complete game on his way to earn his first career monthly honors...Webb had the lowest ERA of any Giant in a month (min. 20ip) since **Noah Lowry**, who had a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...lastly, he became the first Giant to win a monthly award since teammate **LHP Robbie Ray** (May, 2025).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fifth win of the season last Saturday in SF's 5-0 win over the Braves...tossed 7.0-scoreless innings with just one hit, two walks and six strikeouts...it marked his fifth straight start of 7.0+ innings pitched, the longest such streak by a Giant since **Ty Blach**, who had two different five-game streaks in 2017.

VS. COLORADO: Will face the Rockies for the 21st time in his career and second this year...Webb made his return from the IL here at Coors Field on May 29, tossing 4.1 innings with one run on three hits and five strikeouts...overall, the right-hander is 11-3 with a 2.94 ERA (38er, 116.1ip) and 109 strikeouts...Webb's 11 wins, 116.1 innings and 109 strikeouts are his most vs. any single opponent, with the 11 wins vs. Colorado being the second-most of any active pitcher behind Patrick Corbin (13)...in his last eight starts vs. Colorado dating to July 9, 2023, Webb is 5-1 with a 1.60 ERA (9er, 50.2ip), .225 BAA and 1.05 WHIP.

BACK AND BETTER: Webb has been dominant since returning from the 15-day IL on May 29, sporting a 0.85 ERA (4er, 42.1ip) with 34 strikeouts, a .153 BAA and 0.69 WHIP in six starts...the stretch helped lower his ERA from a 5.06 ERA in eight starts before the IL stint to his current 3.09 mark...Webb landed on the IL on May 9 and missed 20 games with right knee bursitis in what was his first trip to the injured list since October 2022 (low back strain).

THE EIGHT BALL: Tossed 8.0 innings in three straight starts from June 8-21...Webb became the first Giants pitcher to throw 8.0+ innings in three consecutive starts since **Madison Bumgarner** on June 6-17, 2015...he was also the first pitcher overall to accomplish the feat since Nathan Eovaldi on April 29-May 11, 2023.

STAY GROUNDED: Has a 53.1% ground ball rate this season, third-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.3%) and STL's Andre Pallante (54.7%).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Has only given up one run (solo HR) in the 1st inning this year (0.64 ERA), with batters slashing .128/.196/.255 (.451 OPS) off him with six hits, three walks and 18 strikeouts... additionally, leadoff hitters are slashing .136/.156/.250 off Webb... the .136 average is second-lowest among qualified pitchers this season, trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.133).

MISSION COMPLETE: Threw his fourth career complete game on June 21 at Miami, his first since July 31, 2024 vs. the A's...suffered the loss despite tossing 8.0 innings with two runs on five hits as the offense was unable to pick him up in a 2-1 loss to the Marlins...walked one and struck out five in the start.

WORKHORSE: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 910.1 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framber Valdez, who has logged 868.1 innings...Webb's 95 quality starts and 146 total games started since 2022 are most in MLB over that span.

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 5-9 in Webb's 14 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago (they were 16-17 in his 33 starts in '24)...since 2022, SF as a team is 72-74 in Webb's 146 starts, yet his 3.20 ERA in that time is sixth-best in MLB among starters (min. 100 GS).

- ▶ Earned his third straight win as he fired 8.0 innings and allowed just one unearned run in SF's 3-2 victory vs. the Braves...allowed just one unearned run in 14.1 innings, covering two outings against the Braves this season.
- ▶ Over his last five outings, Ray has posted a 4-0 record with a 1.36 ERA (5er, 33.0ip), 23 strikeouts and a .149 opponents average against...he's been even better over his last three appearances, as he's held opponents to two unearned run over 22.1 innings of work.
