NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON
The Washington Nationals continue this 10-day, nine-game homestand with a three-game series against the Houston Astros starting on Monday night.

- Washington is 35-29 (.547) since April 25 and are 11-4-1 in their last 16 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have 46 wins, the most by a Nationals club prior to the All-Star break since the 2019 Nationals recorded 47 wins before the break.

ROSTER MOVES

The Nationals announced the following roster moves:

- Recalled right-handed pitcher **Cole Henry** from Triple-A Rochester on Monday.
- Optioned right-handed pitcher **Eddy Yean** to Triple-A Rochester on Sunday.

ALL STARS!

Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams** and outfielder **James Wood** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, while Wood was selected through player voting...Both players will make their second career All-Star appearance...See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

LUIS! LUIS!

Luis Garcia Jr. ranks in the National League in RBI (2nd, 64), slugging (.561) and home runs (8th, 19).

- He is 14-for-32 (.438) with three doubles, six homers, 15 RBI, two walks, just two strikeouts and eight runs scored in his last eight games.
- He clubbed his career-high 19th home run on Sunday against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- His 10 home runs in his last 15 games are the most in the National League (2nd in MLB) since June 19.
- Since May 24, **Garcia Jr.** leads MLB with 42 RBI and a .779 slugging percentage...His 16 home runs are tied for the most, while his 1.136 OPS is good for third.

HOMER HAPPY

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 88 home runs since May 6, ahead of the Phillies (81) and the White Sox (80)...Washington leads in OPS (.789) and is second in slugging (.463) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 125 home runs this season, tied for the second-most in MLB behind the New York Yankees (128) and tied for the third-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 91 games behind the 2017 Nationals (135 HR), 2019 Nationals (126 HR) and with the 2016 Nationals (125 HR).

JIMMY LEADOFF

James Wood clubbed his seventh leadoff home run of the season on Saturday, the most in Major League Baseball ahead of **Shohei Ohtani** (6).

- Wood is 10-for-26 (.385) with two doubles, one triple, three homers, seven RBI, eight walks, just five strikeouts and eight runs over his last seven games...He's reached safely in 14 of his last 22 plate appearances (8 H, 6 BB).

PITCHING IN

Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.61 ERA (20 ER/69.0 IP) over the last 14 games...They've combined for 72 strikeouts, just 11 walks and only seven home runs allowed.

- **Foster Griffin** - who ranks ninth in the NL with a 2.87 season ERA - has allowed just two earned runs in 19.1 innings (0.93 ERA) with 20 strikeouts and three walks in two starts during this stretch.
- **Cade Cavalli** has 23 strikeouts and just three walks in his last three starts.
- **Andrew Alvarez** is 1-1 with 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts with four walks during this stretch.
- **Zack Littell** has pitched to a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP) with 11 strikeouts and three walks in his last three starts.
- **Miles Mikolas** has not issued a walk over his last two starts (10.1 IP).

ROLLIN' RUIZ

Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers (min. 125 PA) with a .333 batting average, a .924 OPS and is third with a .556 slugging percentage in 33 games since May 7.

- He's hitting .333 with 11 doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 22 runs since that date.

CREWSIN'

Dylan Crews is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with three doubles, two homers, four RBI, six walks, one hit by pitch, three stolen bases and 12 runs scored over his last 15 games...He's posted a .385 on-base percentage and a .466 slugging percentage over this stretch.

- Crews has 10 infield hits this season, tied for second on the club despite playing in just 41 games so far and tied for sixth-most in MLB since he was recalled on May 19.

NAS (H)IM

Nasim Nuñez is 20-for-56 (.357) with a double, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, nine walks, seven stolen bases and 11 runs scored over his last 19 games.

- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 32 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

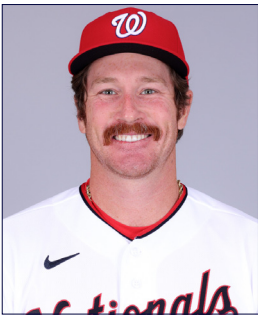

CAREER

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is ninth in Major League Baseball with 137 starts and is tied for sixth with 816.0 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST START

Mikolas tossed a season high 7.0 innings and allowed six earned runs on nine hits with three strikeouts...He took his seventh loss of the season in the 6-3 loss against the Boston Red Sox on June 29.

vs. HOUSTON

Mikolas is set to make his fifth career start against Houston..He is 1-1 with a 7.65 ERA (17 ER/20.0 IP) and 16 strikeouts against the Astros.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Mikolas leads Major League Baseball with just 0.63 walks per 9.0 innings since May 22...He's walked just three batters in 42.2 innings over this stretch...His 6.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio (19 SO/3 BB) over this stretch is tied for fifth in MLB.

- He has not issued a walk in 15.1 straight innings since his start on June 19 at Tampa Bay.

Went 8-11 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 starts...Marked his fourth consecutive season with 31 or more starts.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
- Posted a 2.77 ERA in five starts from Aug. 28-Sept. 20 with a record of 1-1...Allowed two or less earned runs in all the five games and struck out 15 batters across 26.0 innings.
- Recorded a 3.42 ERA in 15 home starts and a 6.39 ERA in 16 road starts.
