PITTSBURGH PIRATES (38-60) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (61-37)

July 25, 2021 at Oracle Park, San Francisco, CA -- GAME #97/ROAD #51

RHP JT BRUBAKER (4-9, 4.68 ERA) vs. LHP ALEX WOOD (8-3, 3.77 ERA)

THE PIRATES... collected a season-high 16 hits in their 10-2 win in San Francisco last night...Have won back-to-back games after losing four in a row...Have gone 9-7 in their last 16 games after losing six in a row...Have scored a season-high 11 runs twice; 7/5 vs. Atlanta and 6/18 vs. Cleveland...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions.

PIRATES AT THE PLATE: The Bucs are hitting .312 (104-for-333) in their last nine games while collecting 10 or more hits eight times...Their .301 batting average since the 4th of July is the highest in all of MLB...The Pirates also rank first among all Major League teams with a .284 batting average and .356 on-base percentage during the month of July.

THE BOOK ON BRU: JT Brubaker leads the staff in strikeouts (93) and has gone 1-1 with a 2.87 ERA (15.2ip/5er) in three career starts against teams from the National League West division..He enters today's start having lost each of his last five decisions since picking up his last victory on May 29 vs. Colorado...Brubaker went 4-4 with a 3.74 ERA (55.1ip/23er) in his first 10 starts thru May 29 and has gone 0-5 with a 6.08 ERA (37.0ip/25er) in his last seven.

STRIKING NUMBERS: One day after matching their season high with 14 strikeouts Friday night, the Bucco pitching staff punched out 12 batters last night...The pitching staff has now struck out at least 10 batters in four straight games for the second time this season (also May 13-16).

BUCS BY THE BAY: Dating back to the 2011 season, the Pirates have now gone 7-2-1 in their last 10 series played at Oracle Park...The Bucs have gone 14-5 here since 2015 and 19-8 in their last 27 games, dating back to April 15, 2012...Over the last 10 seasons, Pittsburgh's 19-10 (.655) record at Oracle Park is the best among all visiting teams.

GOING THAT EXTRA MILE: The Pirates have collected at least one extra-base hit in a season-high 20 consecutive games...**Bryan Reynolds** enters today's action with 41 extra-base hits, tied for the third-most among National League outfielders behind Nick Castellanos (47) and Ronald Acuna, Jr. (44).

CHASEN DOWN GAMES: Since he made his season debut with Pirates on 5/12, **Chasen Shreve** has made a team-leading 29 appearances - only six pitchers in the N.L. have made more in that time...Shreve has been scored upon in just four of his 29 appearances and has posted a 1.56 ERA (17.1ip/3er) in his last 19...Chasen has held left-handed hitters to a .167 batting average this season, limiting them to two hits in their last 17 at bats.

HEADING HOME: This six-game, seven-day road trip to Arizona (0-3) and San Francisco (2-0) comes to an end with today's tilt...The Pirates are off tomorrow before beginning a six-game homestand against the Brewers and Phillies Tuesday night.

PLAYING THE FIELD: Dating back to the action on May 9, the Pirates have made the fewest amount of errors in Major League Baseball...In that time, the Bucco defense has committed 24 errors in 65 games and 2296 total chances (.990 fielding pct).

STRATTON HIS STUFF: Originally selected by San Francisco in the first round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft (20th pick overall), **Chris Stratton** led all National League relief pitchers in innings pitched (30.0) last season...He picked up the win Friday night and enters today's action ranked second among all Major League relievers with 52.1ip...Dating back to May 1, Stratton has gone 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (39.0ip/6er) and 38 strikeouts in his 30 appearances.

THE HIT MAN: All-Star second baseman **Adam Frazier** leads all Major League players with 125 hits and his .327 batting average ranks second in the National League behind Nick Castellanos (.329)...Frazier has gone 22-for-61 (.361) in his last 15 games is hitting .345 (90-for-261) in his last 67 games, dating back to May 8.

STEADY AT SHORT: **Kevin Newman** leads all Major League shortstops with a .997 fielding percentage, having made just one error in 288 total chances...He began this season with 76 consecutive errorless games, a National League record to start a season and a club record for a shortstop at any point in a season.

ROAD WARRIORS: Bucco All-Stars **Bryan Reynolds** (.337) and **Adam Frazier** (.325) rank first and second respectively in road batting average among N.L. hitters (min: 170 AB)...Frazier is hitting .356 (21-for-59) in his last 16 games played on the road and Reynolds has hit safely in 26 of his last 28 road games, going 41-for-113 (.363) with six homers and 22 RBI.

THE PITTSBURGH STEALER: **Gregory Polanco** has been successful in all 11 of his stolen base attempts this season...He leads the National League with the most attempts without being caught...The Pirates single season "record" for most stolen base attempts without being caught is held by **Miguel Dilone** (12 in 1977).

CENTER OF ATTENTION: All-Star outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** connected off Johnny Cueto Friday night for his team-leading 18th home run - 17 of which have come while playing center field...Reynolds leads all National league center fielders with 17 home runs and has hit the second-most in the Majors behind Texas' Adolis Garcia (18)...Since becoming the everyday center fielder on April 22, Reynolds' 89 hits from that position are tops in the N.L. and second in MLB behind Mullins (94).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 25, 1956: Roberto Clemente hit the only walkoff, inside-the-park grand slam in MLB history to give the Pirates a 9-8 win over the Cubs at Forbes Field. Hank Foiles led off the 9th with a walk, which was followed by Bill Virdon's fourth hit of the game and a walk to Dick Cole to load the bases. Jim Brosnan came in from the bullpen to face Clemente and surrendered the game-winning hit.

TYLER ANDERSON: The 31-year-old lefthander will be making his 19th start of the season when he takes tomorrow night...His last start was a no-decision in Arizona Tuesday night (6.0ip/7h/3r/3er/1bb/6so); he left the game with a 5-3 lead after six innings...Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his team-leading 18 starts...Lost five straight decisions prior to winning his last two...Was signed as a free agent on 2/17...Spent 2020 Has won his last two decisions and has allowed five earend runs in his last three starts (18.0ip)...season with San Francisco and went 4-3 with a 4.37 ERA (59.2ip/29er) in 13 games (11 starts).	
vs. MILWAUKEE: 2-2 with a 5.82 ERA (21.2ip/14er) in four career starts...Is 1-0 in one start this year; allowed three hits in 7.0 innings while earning the win in a 2-0 shutout on 7/4 at PNC Park...Prior to this season he hadn’t faced the Brewers since losing an 8-4 decision on 8/4/18 (4.0ip/7er) with the Rockies...His first win against the Brewers came on 4/4/17 (5.2ip/5er) at Miller Park.
