HAPPY OPENING DAY! Today marks Opening Day for the 2021 Minor League Baseball season...All four of the Orioles affiliates are scheduled to play today for the first time since 2019...The Orioles farm system is ranked as the No. 7 farm system by *Baseball America* and boasts five Top 100 prospects: **C Adley Rutschman** (No. 2), **RHP Grayson Rodriguez** (No. 18), **LHP DL Hall** (No. 52), **OF Heston Kjerstad** (No. 55), and **INF Gunnar Henderson** (No. 97).

- 🦅 The Norfolk Tides (Triple-A East) will open the season in Florida against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp at 7:05 p.m. ET...Marks their first game since Sept. 2, 2019 (610 days in between)...The Tides went 60-79 in 2019 and featured International League MVP **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle**.
- 🦅 The Bowie Baysox (Double-A Northeast) will open the season in Pennsylvania against the Altoona Curve at 6:00 p.m. ET...Marks their first game since Game 4 of the Eastern League Championship Series against the Trenton Thunder on Sept. 13, 2019 (599 days in between)...The Baysox went 76-64 in 2019, finishing 69-41 after starting the season 7-23.
- 🦅 The Aberdeen IronBirds (High-A East) will open the season in Delaware against the Wilmington Blue Rocks at 7:05 p.m. ET...Marks their first game as the O's High-A affiliate, and first regular season action since Sept. 2, 2019 (610 days in between)...The IronBirds went 42-33 in 2019, becoming the winningest team in franchise history.
- 🦅 The Delmarva Shorebirds (Low-A East) will open the season at home against the Salem Red Sox at 7:05 p.m. ET...Marks their first game since Game 2 of the Northern Conference Championship Series against the Hickory Crawdads on Sept. 6, 2019 (606 days in between)...The Shorebirds went 90-48 in 2019 and were named the MiLB Team of the Year by *MiLB.com*.

HIT TO KNOW CEDRIC: After a three-hit performance last night, **OF Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with 38 hits...He's hit safely in 22 of his 28 starts...He's batted leadoff in all of his starts, batting .370 (10-for-27) in the first inning of these games; his 10 hits are tied for the second-most in the majors (**Harper**, PHI - 10, **Trout**, LAA - 10, and **Buxton**, MIN - 11).

- 🦅 His 17 hits (17-for-43 - .395) against left-handed pitching are tied for the most in the majors (**Lowrie**, OAK).
- 🦅 He's batting .456 (26-for-57) in the Orioles 14 wins, hitting safely in 13 of the 14, and .211 (12-for-57) in the Orioles 15 losses.
- 🦅 Mullins is swinging at 20.6% of first pitches seen, the lowest on the O's; last season Mullins swung at 33.3% of first pitches.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles have hit at least one home run in each of their last five games (7 HR total)...Have gone 4-1 during this stretch...Their five-straight games with a home run is tied for the second-longest active streak in the AL.

- 🦅 Five different O's batters have homered in the last five games: **INF/OF Trey Mancini**, **OF Cedric Mullins**, **OF Austin Hays**, **OF DJ Stewart**, and **INF Freddy Galvis**...Mullins and Hays have each homered twice.
- 🦅 The Orioles have hit multiple home runs in four of their last nine games, going 4-0 in these contests...Are 7-3 on the year when they hit multiple home runs, compared to 4-7 when they hit no home runs.

A TRIP TO THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST: The Orioles defeated the Mariners by a score of 5-3 last night in the opener of the three-game series...The Mariners won three of four games in a four-game set back on April 13-15 at Oriole Park...This marks the O's first visit to Seattle since June 20-23, 2019.

- 🦅 **LHP Paul Fry** was acquired by the O's from the Mariners on April 14, 2017 in exchange for an International Signing Bonus Slot; **RHP Shawn Armstrong** was claimed off waivers by the O's from the Mariners on April 28, 2019.

LIFE ON THE ROAD: The O's began their sixth road series of the season last night...They have gone 5-1 in series openers on the road...The O's have gone 10-5 on the road overall, the most road wins in the majors...Their .667 winning percentage is tied for the fourth-best in MLB.

- 🦅 The O's have posted a team ERA of 3.16 (47 ER/133.2 IP) in their 15 road games, the lowest ERA in the AL and fourth-lowest in the majors.
- 🦅 The O's have averaged 4.2 runs per game on the road and 3.5 at home; they have a +13 run differential on the road and a -22 run differential at home.
- 🦅 **OF Cedric Mullins** leads the O's with 20 road hits and is batting .333 (20-for-60) on the road; his 20 road hits are tied for the most in the majors.

PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 3.12 ERA (39 ER/112.1 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL and seventh-lowest in the majors...At home, the bullpen has posted a 3.39 ERA (22 ER/58.1 IP) and on the road a 2.83 ERA (17 ER/54.0 IP).

- 🦅 The O's bullpen has posted a combined 1.6 wins above average, according to *Baseball-Reference*, tied for the second-highest in the majors (CLE - 1.6 and TOR - 2.8).
- 🦅 **RHP César Valdez** is tied for first in the AL in saves with seven (7-for-9).
- 🦅 **RHP Adam Plutko** has worked 16.1 innings in relief, posting a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP)...His innings out of the bullpen are tied for the fifth-most in the AL.

NOTES FOR THE NEXT HOMESTAND: The O's return home this weekend and will be celebrating different events at Oriole Park...The Orioles will recognize nurses during National Nurses Appreciation week for their hard work and dedication to keep our community safe...The team has partnered with MedStar to welcome nurses to the ballpark and MedStar will have first pitches on May 7 & 8...The Orioles will also celebrate Negro Leagues Day in Maryland on Saturday, May 8, by paying tribute to Negro Leagues teams throughout the game...All fans in attendance will receive a Baltimore Elite Giants replica cap; the Elite Giants were Baltimore's Negro Leagues team from 1920-1950.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 4/29 vs. New York-AL, in which he threw 4.0-plus innings, allowing two runs on four hits and two walks while striking out three...Marked his first start this season, and first since 9/4/20 vs. NYY, in which he did not allow a home run, snapping a career-high eight-game streak in which he allowed a homer...The 4.0 innings matched a season-low (done three times, last: 4/23 vs. OAK).

QUICK HITS: Snapped a four-game losing streak (since 9/19/20) on 4/16 at Texas with his first win of the 2021 season...Claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9/20 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16/20 vs. Washington...Made just one appearance with the Royals on 7/26/20 at Cleveland...Started as a reliever with Baltimore before moving to the rotation on 8/30/20...Originally selected in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Milwaukee Brewers.

CAREER VS. SEA: Will be making his third-career appearance (second start) vs. SEA, and first since 2019, in which he does not have a decision with a 2.84 ERA (2 ER/6.1 IP) and .208 (3-for-21) opponents' average...Will be his first start (second appearance) at T-Mobile Park...His only outing at T-Mobile Park came in 2019, in which he threw 0.1 innings, with a strikeout.

CAREER VS. AL WEST: Is 1-1 in two starts vs. the AL West with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP) and a .206 (7-for-34) opponents' average this season...Is 1-4 in seven career starts (nine appearances) against American League West foes, with a 7.53 ERA (29 ER/34.2 IP)...Earned his first career win vs. the AL West on 4/16 at Texas, in which he threw a season-high 5.0 innings, while striking out eight.

PITCH, PLEASE: Has thrown three pitches registering 97.1 MPH or greater in his past three starts, two of which resulted in a strikeout...Threw a 97.2 MPH sinker to strike out Nick Solak on 4/16, the hardest pitch of his career...Marked the first time he's registered a pitch of 97.0 MPH or harder since 8/8/19...The three pitches are the hardest by a Baltimore starter this season.

START ME UP: Has made 38 career starts, going 9-18 and pitching to a 6.50 ERA (131 ER/181.1 IP) with 63 walks and 145 strikeouts...López owns a 6.64 ERA (62 ER/84.0 IP) in 18 career starts at home, compared to a 6.58 ERA (69 ER/94.1 IP) in 19 road starts...As a starter, opponents have hit .290 (209-for-721) against him...Started a career-high 18 games for Kansas City in 2019.

WHAT A RELIEF: López is 1-2 in 36 career games as a reliever, owning a 5.24 ERA (40 ER/68.2 IP) with 28 walks and 61 strikeouts...Has held batters to a .277 opponents' average (74-for-267)...Earned his only career save in two opportunities on 8/25/19 at Cleveland, ending the 10th frame with an inning of scoreless relief with two strikeouts...Holds a 6.53 ERA (29 ER/40.0 IP) in 20 relief appearances at home, compared to a 3.45 ERA (11 ER/28.2 IP) in 16 games on the road.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 2-2 with a 6.34 ERA (27 ER/38.1 IP), 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in nine games (six starts) for the Orioles...Pitched to a 6.14 ERA (20 ER/29.1 IP) with nine walks and 20 strikeouts in the starts alone...Did not earn a decision in any of his relief appearances...Earned his first win as an Oriole on 9/4 vs. New York-AL (G2), and his first victory since 9/12/19 vs. Chicago-AL...In his start on 9/14 vs. Atlanta, López became the first Orioles pitcher to toss at least 7.0 innings in a game last season...Led Baltimore hurlers with 30 runs allowed (27 earned), and ranked third in innings pitched (38.1) and hits allowed (43).

Means will be making his 44th career start (49th appearance) and seventh this season tomorrow vs. SEA...Earned his second-straight win on 4/30 at OAK, in which he threw 7.0 innings, allowing two runs, on three hits, two home runs, and one walk, while striking out a season-high tying nine batters...Is making his third career start vs. the Mariners, and second this season...Did not factor in the decision on 4/13 (G1), in which he threw 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, and two walks while striking out five; is 1-0 in his career vs. SEA with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP)...Is 2-0 in four road starts this season with a 1.05 ERA (3 ER/25.2 IP) and a .156 (14-for-90) opponents' average.
