ROSTER MOVES—The Rays have reinstated C Francisco Mejía (left intercostal discomfort) from the 10-day IL and designated C Kevan Smith for assignment...last night the Rays traded INF/OF Yoshi Tsutsugo, who was DFA'd on Tuesday, to the Dodgers for a player to be named or cash.

RAY MATTER—The Rays have won three straight games on the heels of a 1-4 stretch, returning to a season-high-tying 3 games over .500 for the first time since they were 18-15 through games of May 6...the Rays have overcome multi-run deficits in back-to-back games, and their 3-run comeback yesterday tied a season high (5th time, last May 9 at OAK)...the Rays have 11 come-from-behind wins this season, 3rd in the majors behind the Red Sox (16) and Indians (13)...the Rays are 3.0 GB of the first-place Red Sox (25-16) in the division but are in fourth place in the AL East.

- + The Rays are 3-2 in their last 5 games, 4-4 in their last 8 games and 12-11 in their last 23 games...their next loss will be the 20th of the season, which will tie their total from the 60-game 2020 season.
- + Today the Rays conclude a 6-game homestand against the Yankees (1-2) and the Mets (2-0)...the Rays are 10-12 at home and 2-4-1 in home series this season after going 20-9 and 6-0-4 last season.
- + The Rays have blown a lead in eight of their losses, tying their total from the shortened 2020 season (none since April 29 vs. OAK).
- + The Rays have used 40 different batting orders in 41 games.

SEEKING SWEEP—Today the Rays are attempting to sweep the Mets for the first time in franchise history...the Mets are one of eight teams, all in the NL, that the Rays have never swept in a series of 3+ games (ATL, CIN, LAD, MIL, PIT, SF, STL)...the Rays have swept two series this season: May 3-6 at LAA (4-0) and April 16-18 at NYY (3-0), and are attempting their first sweep at Tropicana Field since Sep 25-27, 2020 vs. PHI (3-0)...last season the Rays swept six series overall and four series of 3 games (or more)...three of the four sweeps of 3 games (or more) came on the road.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—Over the last 3 games, the Rays have 24 runs on 32 hits and 14 BB...yesterday the Rays scored 12 runs, their 2nd-most of the season behind April 20 at KC (14) and their most at home since July 27, 2020 vs. ATL (14)...the 15 hits were their most since April 20 at KC (17) and most at home since May 30, 2019 vs. MIN (16)...the Rays had a season-high 8 hits with RISP, their most since Aug 13, 2020 at BOS (8) and most at home since June 14, 2019 vs. LAA (8)...the 8 hits with RISP were more than their total during the 10-game homestand from April 23-May 2, when they went 7-for-71.

- + Yesterday the Rays improved to 3-10 when held to 0 HR...was the fifth time in club history the Rays scored 12 runs (or more) without hitting a homer, following May 18, 2009 vs. OAK (13), July 7, 2004 at BAL (13), Sep 19, 2001 at BOS (12) and May 3, 1999 vs. DET (14).
- + The 5-run 4th inning marked their highest-scoring frame since the 8th on May 6 at LAA (7) and their largest at home since the 3rd on July 28, 2020 vs. ATL (5)...this was passed with a 6-run 8th, their most at home since the 4th inning on July 27, 2020 vs. ATL (8).
- + This season the Rays rank 5th in the AL in runs (178), 10th in avg. (.224), 11th in on-base pct. (.305) and 11th in homers (41)...their .224 avg. would be the lowest in franchise history (.238 in 2020).
- + The Rays have struck out a major-league-most 434 times, ahead of the Phillies (409)...the Rays are on pace for 1,714 SO, which would be a major league record ahead of the 2019 Tigers (1,595)...the Rays have a majors-most 29 games of reaching double-digit strikeouts.
- + The Rays have scored 1 run (or fewer) nine times this season, tied for most in the majors, compared to six times during the abbreviated 2020 season (tied for 3rd-fewest in the majors)...the Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 26 games, tied for 4th in the majors.
- + Prior the yesterday's game the Rays reinstated 1B Ji-Man Choi (arthroscopic surgery, right knee) from the 10-day IL...the Rays and Indians are the only two teams with 0 HR from the 1B position.

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—This season the Rays are batting .213 (75-for-352) with RISP, last in the AL and 28th in the majors ahead of the Pirates (.206) and Brewers (.195)...prior to this season, the lowest avg. with RISP in major league history was .210 by the 1981 Mets, and the lowest in AL history was .217 by the 1988 Orioles...with RISP and 2 outs, the Rays are batting .182 (30-for-165), 27th in the majors...prior to this season, the low-

est avg. with RISP/2 outs in major league history was .173 (2011 Giants).

- + This season the Rays are batting .179 (32-for-179) with RISP at Tropicana Field, compared to .249 (43-for-173) with RISP on the road.
- + The Rays have struck out 125 times with RISP, most in the majors ahead of the Dodgers (119)—the closest AL team is the Red Sox (100)...Brett Phillips is tied for 3rd in the majors with 16 SO with RISP, and Willy Adames and Brandon Lowe are tied for 5th (15).

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays rank 10th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.61 ERA (369-IP, 148-ER)...the Rays have pitched to a 2.67 ERA (124.2-IP, 37-ER) in their last 14 games and a 2.78 ERA (187.2-IP, 58-ER) in their last 21 games...in 5 games on this homestand, Rays pitching has allowed 12 runs (11 ER) in 45 IP and held opponents to 3-for-25 with RISP.

- + The Rays have yielded 3 runs (or fewer) 24 times, most in the AL and 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (26)...this includes 10 of the last 12 games and 17 of the last 21...the Rays have 7 losses when allowing 3 runs (or fewer), tied for 2nd in the majors (Tigers, 8).
- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.17 ERA (306.1-IP, 108-ER) in 34 games, which ranks 4th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.48 ERA (94.2-IP, 26-ER) in the last 22 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.68...since April 10, the bullpen is 5th in the majors with a 3.04 ERA (151-IP, 51-ER) in 34 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 62 runs in the 7th inning or later, but only 17 in the last 22 games compared to 45 through the first 19 games.

CLOSE SHAVES—Since April 15, the Rays are 17-12 and 10 of the 12 losses have been by 2 runs (or fewer)...the only exceptions over this stretch are a 9-2 loss on April 30 vs. HOU and a 6-3 loss on May 8 at OAK...in comparison, six of the club's first 7 losses this season were by 4 runs (or more).

- + The Rays are 11-11 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a majors-best 23-10 last season...similarly, the Rays are 6-7 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 last season.

START ME UP—Rays starters have a 3.54 ERA (193-IP, 76-ER) this season, 8th in the majors and 3rd in the AL behind the White Sox (3.09) and Yankees (3.46)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.30 ERA (155.1-IP, 57-ER) behind the White Sox (3.07)...over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 2 runs (or fewer) in 22 of 34 starts (64.7 pct.), including 14 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 2 runs (or fewer) in 16 of 27 starts since April 10, with 10 scoreless starts.

- + Rays pitchers have 12 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), which they achieved only 11 times in 60 games in 2020.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 15 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

RAYS vs. METS—The Rays have won four straight series over the Mets since Aug 7-9, 2015 (2-1)...the Rays are 15-14 (.517) all-time against them (7-7 at home, 8-7 on the road)...the Rays went 2-1 last season, clinching the third AL East title in franchise history with a win on Sep 23 at Citi Field.

- + The Rays are 4-1 in interleague play this season (2-0 at home).

UP NEXT: ORIOLES—On Tuesday the Rays open a 3-game series at Camden Yards, the first of 19 meetings between the two clubs this season...the schedule includes 13 games from July 19-Aug 29 and 10 games from Aug 6-29...the Rays went 6-4 against the Orioles last season (2-0 at home, 4-4 on the road), clinching the season series against them for a fourth consecutive year...the Rays lost the last game of the season series to snap a 6-game winning streak over the Orioles...seven of the 10 games in the season series were decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and the Rays went 5-2 in them...the Rays swept a doubleheader on Sep 17 at BAL to clinch a post-season berth for a second straight season and sixth time in club history.

STAY THIRSTY, MY FRIENDS—The Rays have played 715 games since their last complete game, by Matt Andriese on May 14, 2016 vs. OAK, a 2-hit shutout...this is the longest drought without a complete game in major league history, according to the Elias Sports Bureau...since then:

- + the longest outing for a Rays starting pitcher is 8.2 IP, by Ryan Yarbrough on Aug 11, 2019 at SEA (replaced, up 1-0, after 99 pitches);
- + a Rays starter has pitched into the 9th inning only twice;
- + the Rays have used 40 different starting pitchers;
- + the Rays have had 11 CG thrown against them;
- + the Indians have recorded a majors-most 23 CG,
- + 134 pitchers have a CG and 59 pitchers have at least 2 CG

LAST APP—On Tues vs. NYY, entered the game in the 5th inning in relief of **Luis Patiño** and retired his first 8 BF before yielding a 2-out, solo homer to **Gary Sánchez** in the 7th...allowed consecutive hits to lead off the 8th, but induced back-to-back grounders that resulted in **Giancarlo Stanton** being thrown out attempting to score and a groundball double play...his line: ND, 4 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 1 HBP, 63 pitches, 37 strikes.

- + Recorded 2 assists and has eight this season, tied for 5th among AL pitchers...has not made an error in his career (22 total chances).
- + Threw first-pitch strikes to 11 of his 16 BF and has thrown first-pitch strikes to 63.6 pct. of batters faced this season.

SOLID START—Is 7-3 with a 2.76 ERA (62-IP, 19-ER) in his first 13 career apps (8 starts), one shy of **Rolando Arrojo** for the most wins in franchise history through 13 career apps...min. 5 starts, has the lowest ERA in a 13-game span to begin his career in club history, ahead of **Blake Snell** (3.17).

- + Has held opponents to 1 run (or fewer) in eight of 13 career apps, and 3 runs (or fewer) in 12 of 13 apps including all six this season.

SINK OR SWIM—Has used his sinker on 46.4 pct. (208 of 448) of his pitches this season and is limiting opponents a .192 avg. (10-for-52) on at-bats ending with the pitch, according to StatCast, the 8th-best rate in the majors (min. 40 PA)...is allowing an avg. exit velocity of 85.7 mph on the pitch, 6th-lowest in the AL (min. 20 batted balls)...since last season, his .297 opp SLG on the sinker is the 9th-lowest in the majors (min. 75 PA).

vs. METS—Will be making his second career app against the Mets after recording the win on Sep 21, 2020 at Citi Field when he allowed 1 run in 3 IP of relief...was the third pitcher used by the Rays, following **Pete Fairbanks** and **Ryan Thompson**...his only run allowed came after yielding four straight baserunners with 2 outs in the 5th inning, including a RBI single by **Jeff McNeil**...got an inning-ending flyout to limit the damage.

- + Is 4-0 with a 1.96 ERA (23-IP, 5-ER) in five career IL apps (3 starts).

2020 RECAP—Went 5-0 with a 2.78 ERA (32.1-IP, 10-ER) in 7 apps (5 starts) for the Rays last season, his first career action...his 5-game winning streak was the longest for a Ray beginning his major league career, breaking a tie with **Adam Kolarek** (2017-19), **Jake Faria** (2017), **Jeremy Hellickson**

(2010), **Tim Corcoran** (2006) and **James Shields** (2006)...became the second Rays rookie to finish a season with 5 wins (or more) and no losses, joining **Jalen Beeks** (5-0) in 2018...became the third Rays pitcher to start and win each of his first three major league apps, joining Faria and Hellickson.

- + Selected from the alternate training site on Aug 23 and remained on the active roster for the rest of the season...from Aug 23 through season's end, his 5 wins tied **Tyler Glasnow** and SEA **Marco Gonzales** for the major league lead...from the date of his debut through the end of the season, ranked among major league rookie leaders in wins (1st), innings (tied for 5th), ERA (2nd) and opp avg. (.230, 4th).
- + Went 4-0 with a 3.16 ERA (25.2-IP, 9-ER) in 5 starts and 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA (6.2-IP, 1-ER) in two relief apps...two of his five starts last season were scoreless and one of his two relief apps was scoreless.
- + Min. 20 IP, his groundball rate of 64.6 pct. led the AL and ranked 3rd in the majors...yielded 7 BB in 32.1 IP for a 1.96 BB/9 IP ratio.
- + Ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 24 prospect in the Rays system following the season...the publication also tabbed him as having the Best Changeup in the organization.

IN CONTROL—Had a 3.57 SO/BB ratio (25-SO, 7-BB) last season, 5th-best among major league rookies (min. 30 IP)...threw 14.5 pitches per inning and 3.62 pitches/BF, both the 2nd-best marks among rookie pitchers (min. 30 IP)...went to 3-ball counts to only 16.2 pct. (21 of 130) of batters faced.

POSTSEASON—Pitched to a 6.35 ERA (5.2-IP, 4-ER) in 2 apps in the post-season...made his postseason debut in Game 5 of the ALCS at HOU, entering with 1 out in the 2nd inning behind opener **John Curtiss** and allowing 2 runs in 3 IP...yielded 2 runs in 2.2 IP of relief in Game 1 of the World Series at LAD...was not on the roster for the Wild Card Series or ALDS.

AMATEUR CAREER—Selected in the fifth round of the 2017 June Draft out of Webster University, becoming the first drafted player in program history...became the first player in school and league (SLIAC) history to play in the majors...went 8-1 with a 0.68 ERA (92.2-IP, 7-ER) in 13 starts as a junior, leading Division III pitchers in ERA and WHIP (0.71)...missed most of his sophomore season with a sprained UCL in his left elbow.
