THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JULY 4
1995 - 2B Craig Biggio sets the franchise record by scoring five runs in the Astros 16-8 win over the Rockies at Coors Field... Biggio goes 3x4 with two walks, two HR and three RBI in the shootout...**1B Jeff Bagwell** also homers for Houston and has five RBI...since that date, an Astro has scored five runs on six additional occasions, accomplished by Biggio twice more (1995, 1996), **Chris Burke** (2006), **Cody Ransom** (2007) and **George Springer** twice (2014, 2019).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will play host to the top team in the AL, the Rays, for a July 4th matchup tonight at Daikin Park...Astros ace **RHP Hunter Brown** (1-0) will get the start for Houston as he looks to snap the Astros two-game losing streak and the Rays nine-game winning streak...the Rays will counter with **RHP Drew Rasmussen** (10-5).

BROTHER BROWN: **RHP Hunter Brown** will make his sixth start of the season tonight and his fourth since returning from a lengthy stint on the IL with a right shoulder strain...despite showing some rust, Brown has still been effective, posting a 2.45 ERA (4ER/14.2IP) in his three starts since his return...overall in 2026, Brown has a 1.78 ERA (5ER/25.1IP) while allowing just 17 hits in 25.1 IP (.187 opp. avg.) with 32 strikeouts...Brown has had huge success against the Rays in his career, going 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (7ER/28IP) in six games (four starts).

JULY 4TH FESTIVITIES: In honor of today's holiday, the Astros will hold a **Fourth of July Street Fest** presented by Macy's, which will take place in the Apache Tree Farm outside Center Field Gate from 3-6 p.m...inside the stadium, 10,000 fans will receive a **Patriotic Orbit Beach Towel**, presented by Coca-Cola...country music superstar and Conroe native, **Parker McCollum** will have the Play Ball Call, and postgame, there will be a **Fourth of July Postgame Fireworks Show**, presented by Macy's.

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 23-16 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: Prior to the Astros losing two of three to the Twins earlier this week, the club had won five consecutive series dating back to June 12...the last time the Astros won five straight series was from June 20-July 6 of last season.

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-5 in one-run games and 19-11 in two-run games...each of the Astros last seven wins and 12 of their last 13 victories have come by two-or-fewer runs.

FIREWORKS ON THE 4TH: The Astros have won on the Fourth of July for eight consecutive seasons (since 2016), which is the longest active streak in the Majors...three of those wins have come at Daikin Park (last, a 4-1 win over COL in 2023)...in 2025, the Astros beat the Dodgers, 18-1, on the Fourth of July at Dodger Stadium...it marked the Dodgers' largest-ever margin of defeat at Dodger Stadium...it also marked the 13th time in franchise history the Astros scored at least 18 runs in a game.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: After tying the game up in the 6th, the Astros dropped a close game to the Rays last night by a score of 3-1...the Astros scored their only run on a solo homer in the 6th by **DH Yordan Alvarez** (1x4)...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (1ER/6IP) bounced back to have a strong start, but did not factor into the decision.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have reinstated **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (right hamstring strain) from the 10-day IL and recalled **OF Zach Dezenzo** from Triple A Sugar Land...in corresponding moves, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Joey Loperfido** have been optioned to Triple A Sugar Land.

YESTERDAY'S TRADE: Announced yesterday, the Astros traded minor leaguer **LHP Tom Cosgrove** to the Nationals in exchange for cash considerations...Cosgrove was pitching at the Triple A level.

ALL-STAR UPDATE: Full All-Star rosters (starters and reserves) will be announced tonight beginning at 6:30 p.m. CT on FOX...**DH Yordan Alvarez** was a finalists on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot and is a strong candidate to be the AL starter at the DH position...Alvarez has been an All-Star three times in his career.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has had a torrid first half to his season, currently leading all of baseball in OPS (1.056), OBP (.431), SLG (.625) and total bases (198)...additionally, he ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (43), first in homers (27), tied for first in hits (101), second in batting average (.319), second in RBI (61), second in runs (60) and fourth in walks (59).

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 2-0 with eight saves (in eight chances) and a 0.69 ERA (1ER/13IP) in 13 appearances this season...he has 21 strikeouts in his 13.0 innings with a .049 (2x41) opponent average and a 0.54 WHIP...Hader has not allowed a hit in six consecutive appearances (6IP since June 21).

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** delivered a game-tying solo homer in the 6th inning last night, giving him 27 home runs on the year...he reached 27 homers in the Astros 90th game of the season, marking the fifth instance in club history for a player to reach 27 homers in that span and the first to do so since **OF George Springer** in 2017.

MY BOY BLU: **RHP AJ Blubaugh** worked another 2.2 scoreless innings on Wednesday vs. MIN, giving him 56.1 innings pitched on the season, which leads all Major League relievers...Blubaugh has been on a strong run since April 11, going 3-0 with a 2.06 ERA (11ER/48IP) in his last 29 appearances.

OUT ON ASSIGNMENT: The Astros have several players on minor league rehab assignments:

- **RHP Ronel Blanco** (rt. elbow surgery) started on Wednesday for Double A Corpus Christi at NW Arkansas, tossing 4.1 innings, allowing three runs with four strikeouts...he tossed 60 pitches (45 strikes) in what was his third minor league rehab start...he is expected to make his next rehab start on Tuesday.
- **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (rt. shoulder inflammation) started on Wednesday for Triple A Sugar Land at OKC, tossing 4.0 innings of one-run ball on 60 pitches (41 strikes)...he is also expected to make his next rehab start on Tuesday.
- **RHP Hayden Wesneski** (rt. elbow surgery) began a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday for the FCL Astros, tossing 3.0 innings (0ER) on 25 pitches... he is expected to make his next start on Sunday.
- **IF Braden Shewmake** (rt. adductor strain) had his rehab assignment transferred to Triple A on Wednesday and has started two games for the Space Cowboys, one at shortstop and one at second base.

LAST START, JUNE 28 at DET: In his 3rd start since being activated from the IL, he allowed 3 runs (2 ER) on 5 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...marked his 2nd quality start of the season along with his 1st quality start since being activated from the IL on June 16.

THE DIESEL: The Astros 2026 Opening Day starter, Brown has been limited to just 5 Major League starts on the season due to a 2-plus month-long IL stint due to a right shoulder strain...when on the field, he has performed at an All-Star level in his limited duty, going 1-0 with a 1.78 ERA (5ER/25.1IP) with 32 strikeouts and a .187 (17x91) opponent average.

ON THE MEND: After his 2nd start of the season, was placed on the 15-day IL on April 2 with a right shoulder strain...on the way back, he made 4 rehab appearances between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

AGAINST THE RAYS: In 6 career appearances, including 4 starts against Rays, he's recorded a 2.25 ERA (7ER/28IP) with 26 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .177 opponent batting average...made his last against the Rays on June 1, 2025 at Daikin Park, in that outing, he allowed 1 hit and 4 walks with 5 strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings.

FOLLOWING JV'S FOOTSTEPS: Born and raised in Detroit, Brown went to grade school, high school and college in his hometown...he grew up a Tigers fan and a fan of **Justin Verlander**, who he modeled his pitching delivery after...Brown met Verlander as a fifth-grader at St. Isaac Jogues Catholic School in Saint Clair Shores, MI, a suburb of Detroit...Verlander, fellow Tiger **Carlos Guillén** and others visited the school as part of a radio promotion, won by one of Brown's classmates...the two later were teammates for three years (2022-24) and became close friends.

ALL-STAR SEASON: A 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...in 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration.

MIXING IT UP: Has changed his repertoire over the course of his career, which resulted in a huge turnaround over the last 2 seasons...many coaches and teammates have worked with Brown, none more so than former teammate **Alex Bregman**, who suggested Brown incorporate a running sinker into his arsenal to keep right-handed hitters from leaning out over the plate... while the sinker does not grade out analytically as well as his other offerings, it compliments his offerings perfectly...prior to the change, Brown owned a 5.10 ERA in 41 games.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/1 vs. MIN): Worked the final 2.0 innings Wednesday night vs. MIN and struck out 3 batters while allowing 1 run on 1 hit (solo HR by IF Luke Keaschall)...tossed a season-high 34 pitches (24 strikes) and matched his season high of 2.0 innings for the 2nd time (also, May 3 at BOS)...were his most pitches since tossing 44 pitches on Sept. 27, 2023 at SEA.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Made his 349th career appearance on Wednesday vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros franchise history...now trails RHP Brad Lidge (377) for No. 4 on the list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (485) and 10th in innings pitched (358.2).

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.75 ERA (6ER/19.2IP) in his last 21 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak).

VS. TB: In 9 career games vs. TB, he's posted a 0.96 ERA (1ER/9.1IP) with 15 strikeouts, 0.96 WHIP and a .121 (4x33) opponent batting average.

CAREER: In 349 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.91 ERA (116ER/358.2IP) with 485 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.17 K/9 and a 0.80 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
