SERIES BUSINESS

The Washington Nationals beat the Milwaukee Brewers, 3-1, on Saturday night to claim the series victory...It marks their second road series win of the season, their first series win over Milwaukee since Aug 2-4, 2024 in D.C. and first road series win over the Brewers since July 12-14, 2024.

- A win on Sunday would give Washington its first series sweep of the season, first series sweep over Milwaukee since April 15-17, 2011 in D.C. and first series sweep in Milwaukee since June 2-4, 2006.
- Friday night's game began a stretch of 17 games for the Nationals without a day off...Washington's next off day is April 27 in New York.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood is 12-for-23 (.522) with three doubles, three homers, 10 RBI, five walks, just four strikeouts, one stolen base and eight runs scored over his last six games.

- Wood is the only player in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball (has 2) of at least 116.0 MPH... He's also the only player with more than two batted balls (has 3) of at least 115.0 MPH.
- His 20 batted balls over 100 MPH are second-most in Major League Baseball behind **Fernando Tatis Jr.** (21)
- Since the start of last season, his 13 home runs against left-handed pitching ranks third among left-handed batters, trailing **Kyle Schwarber** (23) and **Shohei Ohtani** (17).
- 10 of his 16 hits this year have gone for extra bases (6 2B, 4 HR).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals have scored 81 runs, the second-most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 14 games, behind the 2019 Nationals who scored 83 runs through their first 14 contests.

- Washington has scored 15 runs in the first inning, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Philadelphia.
- The Nationals have scored at least five runs 10 times this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Houston.

START ME UP

Washington's rotation is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (8 ER/28.0 IP) and a .206 opponents' average (21-for-102, 2 2B, 2 HR) over the last six games dating to April 5...The 2.57 ERA and .206 opponents' average rank fourth in the National League over this stretch.

- **Foster Griffin** allowed one hit in 5.1 innings pitched on April 11 at Milwaukee...He did not allow the lone hit until the sixth inning...His 1.76 ERA ranks 10th in the National League.
- From April 5-7, **Foster Griffin** (5.0 IP, 5 H, ER, 3 BB, 6 SO), **Zack Littell** (5.0 IP, 4 H, ER, 3 BB, 6 SO) and **Cade Cavalli** (4.2 IP, 4 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO) each allowed just one earned run in their starts.

BULL PENNINGS

Washington's bullpen has pitched to a 1.17 ERA (1 ER/7.2 IP) with a .115 opponents' average (3-for-26, HR) and eight strikeouts over the last two games...Of three walks allowed two were intentional.

- **Clayton Beeter** has allowed just three hits in 26 at-bats against him through seven outings...Opposing left-handed batters are 0-for-14 against Beeter.
- **Cionel Pérez** has allowed one earned run on three hits with one win and one hold in his last 4.0 games (4.0 IP).
- Opposing batters are hitting .195 (5-for-27) against **PJ Poulin**...Left-handed batters are 1-for-11 (.091).

A FOR ABRAMS

CJ Abrams has reached base safely in 12 of 13 games this season and hit safely in 10 of his last 11...He is 14-for-42 (.333) with a double, four homers, 13 RBI, six walks, four stolen bases and nine runs during the 11-game stretch.

- Abrams has improved his walk rate this season...He has a 10.5% BB (6 BB in 57 PA) in 2026, compared to a 5.8% BB (37 BB in 635 PA) in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Lile's 16 hits are tied for 10th in the National League...He has hit safely in 11 of the first 14 games and has reached safely in 12 of the 14.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .313 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced the National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

BLAKE BUTERA

Blake Butera was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

 Veteran starter is one of just 12 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.75 since the beginning of 2024.
 • Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-23 with a 3.65 ERA in 76 starts since June 29, 2023.
 • In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
 • His 4.1% walk rate since the start of 2023 is the third-best mark in MLB.

LAST START

Littell made his first start of the season against the Cardinals on April 6 at Nationals Park...He allowed just one earned run on four hits with seven strikeouts and three walks in 5.0 innings of work.

vs. MILWAUKEE

Littell is set to make his fourth career start against the Brewers...He owns a 1.75 ERA (5 ER/25.2 IP) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks in 12 career games (three starts).

- First career save at Milwaukee on Aug. 8, 2021 (2.0 IP, BB, SO).

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- Made his Reds debut on Aug. 5 at Chicago (NL)...Became the fifth pitcher in Reds history with at least 7.0 innings, one run or fewer allowed and at least eight strikeouts in his team debut (also: Brady Singer, 3/31/25 vs TEX; Johnny Cueto, 4/3/08 vs AZ; Mo Sanford, 8/9/91 at SD; Tom Seaver, 6/18/77 at MON).
- **2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (T1st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (T1st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
- **2024 Pitch Mix:** Slider (34.8%) Split Finger (23.2%) Four Seamer (22.3%) Sinker (14.6%) Sweeper (5.1%)

2023

Appeared in 28 games (4 starts) between the Red Sox and the Rays...Converted to the starting rotation with the Rays on July 19.

- Ranked among MLB leaders after the All-Star break in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 0.89), walk rate (2nd, 2.4%) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 7.86).
- In 14 starts, went 3-5 with a 3.41 ERA (27 ER/71.1 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.
- Pitched in Game 2 of the AL Wild Card vs. Texas...Tossed 2.0 hitless innings and struck out three while hitting one batter

2021-22

Spent two seasons working out of San Francisco's bullpen...Went 7-3 with three saves, 3.82 ERA in 102 relief appearances for the Giants.

- Struck out 102 batters in 106.0 innings across the two seasons.
- On Aug. 8, 2022 at Milwaukee, recorded his first career save in 2.0 scoreless innings.
- Pitched in Games 2 and 4 of the 2022 NLDS vs. Los Angeles (NL)...Allowed three runs on four hits over 0.2 innings in Game 2 before working 2.0 scoreless innings in Game 4.
