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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore closes out the pre-All-Star schedule today against the Royals at Camden Yards...The Birds are coming off a 1-2 series against the Cubs and enter play today 12.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.0 games back in the Wild Card.

- The Orioles hit four home runs last night, including three off left-handed pitching... Baltimore has homered in four straight games in which they have faced a southpaw for the first time since August 18-21, 2024...The O's have not done so in five straight since a five-game run from April 27-May 2, 2023.
- **Gunnar Henderson** snapped a season-high 18-game homerless drought, hitting his first long ball since June 19 at Los Angeles-NL.
- **Adley Rutschman** has gone 30 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since July 4, the fourth-longest active streak in the majors behind MIA's Javier Sanoja (45), TOR's Ernie Clement (37), and AZ's Geraldo Perdomo (31).
- **Pete Alonso's** 64 pre-All-Star RBI are the most by an Oriole since Manny Machado's 65 RBI in 2018.
- Today, the O's look to win a fourth straight game for the first time since a five-game winning streak from September 1-6, 2025...Baltimore has now had eight winning streaks of three games this year and joins San Francisco as the only clubs in MLB that have yet to win four consecutive games.
- A victory today would secure a third series sweep for the Birds this season, joining April 6-8 at Chicago-AL and May 25-27 vs. Tampa Bay...Baltimore last swept Kansas City from June 9-11, 2023 at Camden Yards.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 87 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Athletics (83 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in a season-high 16 straight games, their longest run since a 21-game stretch from July 20-August 10, 2024.

- **Taylor Ward** has drawn a free pass in each of his last five games, tied with AZ's Corbin Carroll and MIL's Jake Bauers for the longest active streak in MLB...On Thursday, Ward drew his 71st walk, surpassing Ken Singleton (70 BB, 1975) for the most free passes drawn by an Oriole before the All-Star Break in franchise history (since 1954)...The only other Orioles to surpass 60 walks prior to the All-Star break are Randy Milligan (69 BB, 1990), Bobby Grich (67 BB, 1973), and Albert Belle (66, 1999).
- The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).
- Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 367 walks.

ROYAL FLUSH: The Orioles are 163-99 (.622) at home all-time against the Royals, their second-highest home winning percentage against any club in franchise history (since 1954), trailing the Pirates (16-3, .842).

- **Pete Alonso** has reached base safely in 16 of 17 career games opposite Kansas City, slashing .355/.459/.774 (22-for-62) with five doubles, seven home runs, 14 runs, 15 RBI, and 12 walks against 15 strikeouts.
- Alonso's 1.234 career OPS against the Royals is the highest among all active players (min. 70 PA), ahead of LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.232) and HOU's Yordan Alvarez (1.191).

OPENING STATEMENTS: The Orioles rotation has posted a 3.60 ERA in 47 games since May 20, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL and sixth best in the majors during that time.

- Prior to this stretch, the club posted a 5.20 ERA from its starters, third worst in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.69) and Nationals (5.25) through May 19.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** ranks fourth in the AL and is tied for 10th in the majors with 64 RBI...He is batting .279/.368/.533 (67-for-240) with 10 doubles, 17 homers, 42 runs, 51 RBI, 33 walks, and three hit-by-pitches in 65 games since May 1.

- On Wednesday, he became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 37 home runs in 2013.
- Alonso is the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...The last Oriole with more than 64 RBI before the break is Manny Machado, who had 65 in 2018...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 93 RBI in 2013.
- Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and has played 512 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (876 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .357/.400/.522 (56-for-157) with 10 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 21 runs, 28 RBI, 10 walks (1 IBB), six stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 56 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

- Since May 1, his .357 batting average is the highest in the majors (min. 150 AB) ahead MIA's Otto Lopez and SF's Luis Arraez (both .346).
- Alexander is batting .365 (19-for-52) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, and 25 RBI with runners in scoring position.

ALL-STAR ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024).

- Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).
- According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).
- Baseball Savant credits Rutschman with a Fielding Run Value of nine, tied with TOR's Brandon Valenzuela for the highest figure among all catchers and tied for the seventh-highest clip among all position players behind CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (17), STL's JJ Wetherholt (15), KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (13), BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (12), and LAD's Andy Pages and WSH's Jacob Young (both 10).

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 19th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on July 7 vs. Chicago-NL after throwing 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits and three walks with three strikeouts...Threw 100 pitches, 63 strikes.

⚡ Made his seventh quality start of the year, including his second in as many starts...He is 2-3 this season when making a quality start, with the O's going 2-5 in those contests.

⚡ Has received zero runs of support in three of his last four starts while getting two runs of support on June 29 vs. Chicago-AL.

ROYALTY: Baz is set to make his fourth career start against Kansas City, going 1-1 with a 4.95 ERA (11 ER/20.0 IP).

⚡ Threw a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings against the Royals on June 26, 2025, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 24 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted nine home runs over 135.1 innings (0.60 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 24 outings, the third-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic (35 G) and STL's Andre Pallante (31 G).

⚡ The only other Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 18 starts with the team is Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).

FASTBALL FOCUS: In his last start against the Cubs, he held opponents to an 0-for-8 mark with one strikeout.

⚡ Over six June starts, Baz limited the opposition to a .158 (6-for-38) clip with three doubles on his four-seam fastball after they hit .241 (7-for-29) with two doubles and one home run against the offering in five May starts.

⚡ Overall, he is holding right-handed hitters to a .152 (5-for-33) mark on his four-seamer, while lefties are batting .253 (20-for-79).

FIRST INNING STRUGGLES: Baz owns a 6.00 ERA (12 ER/18.0 IP) in the first inning while allowing nine walks and an .896 opponent OPS.

⚡ He has, however, been scoreless in each of his last two first innings after allowing two runs on June 23 at Los Angeles-AL and three runs on June 18 at Seattle.

⚡ From innings 2-4, he has posted a 3.00 ERA (18 ER/54.0 IP) with 15 walks and a .639 opponent OPS.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 33 doubles, ahead of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (29)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 18 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

⚡ His 33 doubles are tied with Steve Barber (1963) and Omar Daal (2003) for the second most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), trailing Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

TEERING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .365/.375/.635 (23-for-63) with 11 doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.010 opponent OPS on the first pitch is fifth highest in MLB (min. 60 BF), ahead of TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.266), KC's Seth Lugo (1.225), CHC's Colin Rea (1.078), and AZ's Merrill Kelly (1.022).

THE TOTEM POLE: Opposing leadoff hitters are slashing .333/.379/.556 (18-for-54) with seven doubles, one triple, one home run, and four walks off Baz.

⚡ Five hole hitters are slashing .333/.373/.542 (16-for-48) with seven doubles and one home run.

⚡ Baz has found greater success against the bottom three hitters, limiting them to a combined .215/.281/.347 (26-for-121) line with nine doubles and two long balls.
