# Detroit Tigers (48-29) at Tampa Bay Rays (42-34)

**S-A-T-U-R-D-A-Y PLIGHT:** The Detroit Tigers and Tampa Bay Rays this afternoon continue their three-game series at Steinbrenner Field after the Tigers endured a 14-8 setback in the first game of the set last night, just their fifth loss in 25 series openers this season ... the Tigers have now dropped two games in a row and today aim to avoid only their third three-game losing streak of the nearly halfway-done season, their first since May 22-24.

- The Tigers this afternoon look to snap a bit of a random losing streak as they have dropped their
  last seven games played on a Saturday ... their last successful Saturday was a doubleheader
  sweep of the Baltimore Orioles on April 26 at Comerica Park ... the Tigers have combined to
  go a quite strong, balancing out 11-4 on Fridays and Sundays during this Saturday drought and
  have won four of their last seven weekend series despite those setbacks.
- After this quick stay in Tampa, the Tigers return to Comerica Park on Tuesday for a six-game homestand vs. the ATH and the Minnesota Twins, as the Tigers will ultimately play 15 of 21 games at home to end the month of June.

**THIS IS ON THE RECORD:** Despite losses in their last two games, at 48-29, the Tigers have the best record in the majors, 1.0 game ahead of the Dodgers and 3.5 games ahead of the Astros for tops in the A.L. ... the Tigers are off to their best start through 77 games in 19 years when they began 52-25 in 2006 ... the Tigers are 30-17 in their last 47 games starting April 30.

• The Tigers have posted a 48-26 record, a .649 winning percentage, in their last 74 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 48-26 record, which is a 105-win pace over 162 games, starting March 31 is the best in all of baseball in that span and 5.5-games up on the Astros, the next closest A.L. team.

YIKES THIS IS OFFENSIVE: The Tigers have reached the first full day of Summer ranked second in the A.L. with 379 runs scored, behind only the Yankees and their 382 runs scored ... the Tigers have reached June 21 ranked in the top two in the A.L. in runs for the first time since leading the majors with 439 runs in 2007 ... last year the Tigers were ninth in the A.L. with 308 runs scored on this day.

**JUNE BOON:** Riley Greene is now up to 19 RBI in June, tied with Seattle's Cal Raleigh for the most in the A.L. this month ... Greene set a single-month personal best with 24 RBI last month in May and, with 43 RBI starting May 1, is second to only Raleigh (45 RBI) for most RBI in the A.L. starting May 1.

• Greene is looking to become the first Tiger to record 20 RBI in back-to-back calendar months in 12 years when Miguel Cabrera did so in May (33 RBI) and June (21 RBI) of 2013.

**GREENE WITH ENVY:** Thanks to three-run and solo homers last night, Riley Greene now has 15 RBI in his last seven games and 29 RBI in his past 29 games in the last month starting May 20, trailing only Seattle's Cal Raleigh (31 RBI) for the most RBI in this one-month span.

- Greene is the first Tiger to wake up on June 21 with at least 59 RBI since Miguel Cabrera had 71 RBI in 2013 ... on June 21 last season, Greene woke up with 37 RBI to date.
- Greene has 17 homers, 59 RBI and 35 extra-base hits this season, joining Aaron Judge and Cal Raleigh as the only three players in the A.L. to reach those totals.
- Greene has 18 doubles to go along with his 17 homers and 59 RBI through 77 team games, which puts him on pace for 38 doubles, 36 homers and 124 RBI in a 162-game season ... last year in his first All-Star campaign, Greene finished up with 27 doubles, 24 homers and 74 RBI.

**PRODUCE SECTION:** Riley Greene (17 homers, 59 RBI) and Spencer Torkelson (16 homers, 48 RBI) are the most dynamic duo on offense in the A.L., as they are the only set of teammates in the A.L. (and one of two in the majors) to have each reached 16 homers and 48 RBI.

**GLEYBER PARTY**: Gleyber Torres, who leads all A.L. second basemen in All-Star voting, has posted an .812 OPS this year, the best OPS by any second baseman in the A.L. ... Torres also leads all major league second basemen with a .385 on-base percentage, leads A.L. second basemen with a .283 batting average and is second in the A.L. with 38 RBI ... www.tigers.com/vote.

**WHAT A RELIEF!**: Will Vest (12 saves, 2.50 ERA) and Tommy Kahnle (eight saves, 1.41 ERA) are one of only three sets of teammates to each have eight saves this year, joining San Francisco's Camilo Doval and Ryan Walker as well as New York's Luke Weaver and Devin Williams.

• Kahnle also has nine holds, making him the only pitcher in all of baseball with at least eight saves and eight holds this year ... additionally, Kahnle's 1.41 ERA is tied for the lowest of any A.L. pitcher with at least 30.0 relief innings this season and tied for third lowest in the majors.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the majors on the strength of a +81 overall run differential this year, trailing only the Yankees (+99) for the best mark in the A.L. ... in the A.L. Central, the Tigers have a +109 edge on the second-place Guardians (-28), are +97 on the second-place Royals (-16) and are +81 on the fourth-place Twins (+0).

**AND FINALLY:** The Tigers have scored 156 runs with two outs this season, tops in the majors ... overall, 41.1 percent of Detroit's runs have come with two outs.

- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 10, 2023, vs. Chicago (AL), tossing 5.0 innings and giving up two runs on four hits with no
  walks and five strikeouts to earn a win.
- Became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw at least 5.0 innings with no walks and at least five strikeouts in his debut.
