BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals begin their season-ending six-game road trip tonight with the opener of a three-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates at PNC Park ... The Cardinals wrap up their 2026 season with a three-game series against the Brewers this weekend at American Family Field ... The Cardinals spent a rainy off day in the Steel City yesterday after going 4-5 on their final homestand against the White Sox (2-1), Giants (1-2), and Nationals (1-2).

AHOY MATEY: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the National League Central, 3.0 games behind the Pirates ... The Cardinals return to Pittsburgh on a four-game winning streak at PNC Park (April 27, 2026-present), longest active by any visiting team and the longest by St. Louis since winning 10 in a row from Sept. 18, 2020-Aug. 12, 2021.

ROAD RAGE: The Cardinals are averaging 5.25 runs per game on the road this season, 3rd-best in MLB behind the Cubs (5.35) and Dodgers (5.32), and highest since the 2004 NL Champion Cardinals averaged 5.44 runs.

AN ERA OF EXCELLENCE: After going 78-84 in 2025, St. Louis needs a 5-1 finish to avoid consecutive losing campaigns in full seasons for the first time since **1958** (72-82) and **1959** (71-83) ... The **67 years** represents the 2nd-longest timespan all-time by any franchise of the four major North American sports leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, & NHL). - *excludes those shortened by war, work stoppages, or COVID*

- The **NHL's Montréal Canadiens** hold the record of **80 years** between consecutive full losing seasons occurring from 1938-39 to 1941-42 (4 seasons), and then again during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.
- The **Los Angeles Dodgers** have the 2nd-longest active streak, last experiencing losing seasons **39 years** ago from 1986-87.

PANAMA JACKS: The Cardinals rallied from a 3-2 deficit on Sunday against the Nationals with **Iván Herrera's** game-tying solo home run and **Leo Bernal's** game-winning two-run homer ... Herrera and Bernal became the first Cardinals duo from Panama to go yard in the same game, while marking the first time by any two Panamanian teammates since Pittsburgh's **Omar Moreno** and **Rennie Stennett** on May 21, 1978 at Montreal.

BUC SHOTS: Pittsburgh native rookie INF **JJ Wetherholt** (9G) has taken aim at his hometown with six extra-base hits in his inaugural season, 2nd in MLB against the Bucs behind **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (7) ... It's the most XBH by a Cards rookie vs. the Pirates since **Brendan Donovan** (7 in 15g) in 2022 and two behind **Albert Pujols** 8 in 17g in 2001 ... Wetherholt's 3 homers vs. Pittsburgh this season are the most by a Cardinals rookie in a season since Pujols (5 in 2001) & **Jim Lindeman** (5, in 1987).

THE HEAT IS ON: Happy 65th birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman**!

MINOR LEAGUE POSTSEASON CHARGES: Leading the best-of-3 Texas League Championship Series, 1-0, the Springfield Cardinals (AA) continue their quest to repeat as Texas League champions for the first time in franchise history when they host the Amarillo Sod Poodles (AA-Diamondbacks) in Game 2 tonight at Route 66 Stadium ... RHP **Yhoiker Fajardo** starts for Springfield at 6:35 p.m CT ... Game 3 (if necessary) is scheduled for Wednesday in Springfield.

- The Memphis Redbirds (AAA) host the Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Nationals) for all three games of a best-of-3 International League Championship series at AutoZone Park ... SHP **Jurrangelo Cijntje** starts Game 1 tonight at 6:45 p.m. CT ... The winner advances to face the Pacific Coast League champion in the Triple-A National Championship Game in Las Vegas on Sat., Sept. 26.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md. and is an avid fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Victor Scott II grew up a fan of **Andrew McCutchen** and **Starling Marte**...Scott's father was Pirates fan from Pittsburgh, although Victor II grew up a Braves fan as an Atlanta native...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft... pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made MLB debuts vs. Pittsburgh.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

Nathan Church (2018) & **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 28th start of the season and his 89th career start (197th career appearance) ... Has recorded three consecutive 20+ start seasons (2024-26) with a career-high 31 starts in 2025.
- Missed 15 games from Aug. 18-Sept. 3 due to right elbow inflammation.
- Snapped a 48.0-inning homerless streak Tues. vs. SF on a **Bryce Eldridge** HR in the 1st inning; was tied for the 4th-longest active streak in MLB and longest by a Cardinal since **Jack Flaherty** (56.1 IP from May 9-July 16, 2023). - *Elias*
- Pallante's 12 wins in his first 22 starts were the most since 2015: **Carlos Martinez** (12-3) and **Michael Wacha** (13-4).
- Andre is the first Cardinal since **Joaquin Andujar** (1983-84) to bounce back from a 15+ loss season and win 10 or more games the very next season; Andujar lost 16 games in 1983 but then produced a 20-win season in 1984 and a 21-win season in 1985.
- Owns a 9.92 Run Support Average on the road (2nd highest in MLB; 1st: WSH's **Cade Cavalli**, 10.23) but 3.15 at home (8th lowest in MLB) ... Received 3 runs or fewer in 13 of his 15 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 8 of his 12 Road starts.
- Is 7-0 in 12 road starts (St. Louis is 8-4), the 1st Cardinals pitcher to have at least 7 wins and no losses in any span of 12 road games during a single season since Miles Mikolas from 5/16/18-9/29/18 ... His 7 road wins are T-6th in the NL, while Pallante and Jesus Lizardo (9-0) are the only two undefeated MLB pitchers with 5+ road victories.**
- Has pitched 5.0+ innings in all 12 road starts, the longest such streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Sonny Gray** (14 from 2024-25).
- Making his 197th career appearance to pass **Randy Choate** (2013-15) for 59th all-time among Cardinals and one shy of **Chris Carpenter** (2004-12) for 58th ... Andre has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach both 190+ career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 85+ starts.
- Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (88), wins (36), and innings pitched (611.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cardinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, Sept. 15 at Busch Stadium): L, 10-3; 5.0 IP, 8 H, 8 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR - 99 pitches.

- Faced the same opponent in consecutive starts for the 1st time in his career (Also: 9/9 at SF).
- Tied a career-high in runs allowed (8) and matched a season-high in earned runs allowed (6).
- Made his team-leading 26th start of the season that lasted 5.0 innings or longer (T-7th in NL).

2026 NOTES:

MY BEST FRIEND: Has induced career-high 19 groundball double plays this season (3rd in NL), most since 2024 by **Kyle Gibson** (21).

STAYING GROUNDED: Induced a career-high 16 ground balls in his last start Tues. vs. SF, the most by any Cardinals pitcher since **Dakota Hudson** had 17 on 9/22/23 at SD and most by a Cardinals pitcher at home since Pallante had a career-high 17 on 6/29/22 vs. MIA. Tied for the 2nd most in a single game by any pitcher this season (1st: **Jose Soriano**, 18 on 9/8 at ATH w/TOR).

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .213 BA (35-164) with his slider, and 46 of his 104 strikeouts this season have come via the slider. Boasts a 12 Run Value on his slider, 6th-best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 26 of his 27 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 17 of those games.

RIGHT ON: His .244 Opp. BA vs. RHB (61-250) would be the lowest of his career by a -.023 margin, behind his .267 mark (65-243) in 2024.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .794 OPS, 20 runs and 5 HR in 1st inning; has allowed multiple HR in one other inning (2 HR in 4th inn.). Batters are hitting .319 (22-69) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (61.8%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.*** As a starting pitcher (479.1 IP), Pallante's 58.9 career groundball pct. currently is the 10th highest in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 450.0 IP as starter).

PALLANTE VS. PITTSBURGH

- Making his 7th career start (20th app.) vs. the Pirates. Last 6 are starts following 13 relief appearances.
- Earned his 1st career decision with a win in his last start at PNC Park on 4/29, going 6.0 IP with 1 run allowed on 5 hits and no walks with 6 strikeouts in a 5-4 victory.
- **Has yet to allow more than 1 run in any of his 4 starts at PNC Park, the longest streak by any Cardinals SP to begin their career in road contests at Pittsburgh, while his 3 combined runs allowed are the fewest of any Cardinals SP through their 1st 4 road starts at PIT.**
- Makes his 12th career appearance at PNC Park, his most outside of Busch Stadium, and his .157 opp. BA (18-115) at PNC is his lowest at any ballpark.
- Holding the Pirates to a .200 career BA, T-3rd lowest with Seattle among all opponents behind Cleveland (.154), Los Angeles-NL (.163).
- Held the Pirates to one run or less in his first four starts including a 17-inning scoreless streak (7/22/24-7/1/25) before getting hit for eight runs (7 ER) both career-highs in an 8-3 loss at Busch Stadium (8/26/25).
- Faced Paul Skenes in two starts against the Pirates, out-dueling him in a 4-0 win with 7.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with a career-high nine strikeouts at Busch Stadium on Sept. 16, 2024 & taking a no decision at PNC Park (7/1/25) with 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball in a 1-0 Cardinals loss.
- Has a career record of 2-2 with a 3.12 ERA over his 19 appearances. Had an 0.67 ERA in his first four starts that was the lowest ERA by a Cardinals starting pitcher in his first four starts vs. PIT since **Jaime Garcia** (0.64) from 2010-15.
