RAY REPORT—The Rays open a five-game homestand against the Reds (3 to play) and Marlins (2 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...their 18-12 (.600) mark since June 19 is tied with the Rangers for second best in the AL behind the Astros (20-9/.690)...including off days, this marks their 37th consecutive day occupying fourth place in the AL East...are 4.0 games behind the Royals for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...have been within two games of .500 each day since June 23.

- Yesterday, Tampa Bay won its ninth straight rubber game, setting a new club record (prev. 8, 3x, last: July–Sept. 2018)...according to Elias, it marks the longest single-season streak in the majors since the Yankees won 10 straight from May 5–Sept. 12, 2019.
- The Rays recorded their sixth shutout victory, four of which have come in their last 21 games (July 14 vs. CLE, July 12 vs. CLE, June 30 vs. WSH)...was their first shutout on the road since April 29 at Milwaukee (1-0).
- Tampa Bay plated a season-high 13 runs in the win, marking its most since Aug. 19, 2023 (G2) at Los Angeles-AL (18)...it marked the third time in franchise history the Rays scored 13+ runs in a shutout win, joining July 29, 2021 vs. NYY (14-0) and April 30, 2009 vs. BOS (13-0).
- The Rays went 8-for-17 (.471) with runners in scoring position, their most RISP hits since the aforementioned Aug. 19, 2023 (G2) game at LAA (9H).
- With a win tonight, Tampa Bay can improve to two games over .500 for the first time since entering play on May 20 (25-23).
- The Rays 17-9 (.654) mark in Interleague play is tied with the Dodgers (also 17-9) for the best in the majors.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays traded **OF Randy Arozarena** to the Mariners in exchange for **RHP Brody Hopkins**, **OF Aidan Smith** and a player to be named later...in a corresponding move, Tampa Bay activated **1B Yandy Díaz** from the restricted list. Prior to tonight's game, Tampa Bay acquired right-handed pitcher **Jackson Baumeister**, outfielder **Matthew Etzel** and infielder **Mac Horvath** from Baltimore in exchange for right-handed pitcher **Zach Eflin** and cash considerations.

TAJ THE TERRIFIC—Taj Bradley tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in yesterday's win, scattering two hits and one walk with seven strikeouts...his major league-leading 23.0 scoreless inning streak is tied for the third-longest single-season stretch in club history (Elias), trailing only **J.P. Howell** (27.1IP, June 14–Aug. 30, 2012) and **Alex Cobb** (24.2IP, April 1–May 27, 2014). He has thrown 6.0 scoreless innings in three straight starts, tied with six others for the longest run by an MLB starter this season...Bradley and **SD Dylan Cease** are the only hurlers with active streaks...the three-start stretch is tied for the longest streak in franchise history, joining **Ryan Yarbrough** (July 20–Aug. 17, 2019), **Jake Odorizzi** (July 22–Aug. 3, 2016) and **Alex Cobb** (April 6–May 22, 2014).

DAWGS GOTTA EAT—**Brandon Lowe** (4-for-4, 2 2B, HR, 3RBI, 2BB, 2R) hit his 117th career homer yesterday...Lowe 1 HR shy of tying **B.J. Upton** for fourth on Tampa Bay's all-time home run list. He reached base safely a career-high six times, tying the single-game franchise record along with **Richie Palacios** (April 27, 2024 at CWS), **Daniel Robertson** (July 3, 2018 at MIA), **Ben Zobrist** (July 20, 2012 vs. SEA) and **José Cruz** (June 24, 2004 at TOR)...the Rays join the Giants as the only clubs to have two different players reach base safely six times in a games this year (**H. Ramos/L. Wade Jr.**). He also matched career highs in hits (4, 3x, last: July 17 vs. BAL) and extra-base hits (3, 4x, last: Oct. 2, 2021 at NYY). In 26 games since June 16, Lowe is slashing .307/.386/.670 (27-for-88) with 5 2B, 9 HR, 15 RBI and 11 BB.

LEFT SIDE, STRONG SIDE—The Rays are 17-9 (.654) against left-handed starters this season, the third-best clip in the majors behind the Guardians (21-8/.724) and Dodgers (26-11/.703). **Yandy Díaz** is slashing .483/.516/.759 (14-for-29) 5 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI against left-handed pitching since June 7. **Amed Rosario** is batting .347 (17-for-49) with 6 2B off southpaws since May 30, the seventh-highest mark in the AL (min. 40AB). **Jose Siri** is 10-for-30 (.333) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 4 RBI vs. LHP since June 14...during that same stretch, he is 14-for-78 (.179) with 2 2B, 5 HR and 8 RBI vs. RHP. **Curtis Mead** is a career .313 (21-for-67) hitter vs. southpaws compared to .204 (22-for-111) against righties.

START ME UP—Tampa Bay starting pitchers have turned in an MLB-best 2.93 ERA (160.OIP, 52ER) since June 19, outpacing Pittsburgh (3.10) and Kansas City (3.11)...the Rays rotation also ranks among MLB during that stretch in opp. OPS (2nd, .652), HR/9.0 IP (3rd, 0.90), opp. AVG (4th, .228) and hits/9.0 IP (5th, 7.65).

RUNNIN' RAYS—Tampa Bay has recorded multiple steals in a season-high-tying three straight games (3x, last: May 4-6)...the Rays have not done so in four straight games since July 25-28, 2010...they have stolen a base in 12 of their last 13 games and 17 of 19 in July...their 106 SB overall pace the AL and are fourth in the majors behind the Reds (146), Brewers (138) and Nationals (137). Despite recording just 1 SB in his last 22 games, **José Caballero's** 25 SB are still tied for the AL lead with **BOS David Hamilton**.

THE MAGIC NUMBER—The Rays have won 13 consecutive games when plating 4+ runs, their longest single-season streak since a 21-game run to open the 2023 campaign...since the start of June, they are 18-2 in games scoring 4+ times, second best in the majors behind the Padres (21-2/.913)...this, compared to 6-19 with three runs or fewer. Scoring the first run has also dictated the Rays success as of late...the team that has scored first has won in each of their last eight games.

POWER SUPPLY—Tampa Bay's 12 HR since the All-Star break are tied for second most in the majors behind Oakland (13HR)...over the Rays last 33 games since June 15, their 45 HR (1.4 HR/G) are fifth most in the AL—the club entered that stretch with majors-low 53 HR (0.8 HR/G).

TRENDING UP—The Rays went 14-for-35 (.400) with runners in scoring position during their three-game set at Toronto...this, following a stretch from July 5-22 in which Tampa Bay posted a .189 (25-for-132) RISP AVG, third lowest in the majors during that stretch.

RETURN OF THE REDLEGS—The Rays and Reds open a three-game set tonight in St. Petersburg...it marks the fourth time in franchise history Tampa Bay will host Cincinnati at Tropicana Field (June 19-21, 2017; June 27-29, 2011; June 10-12, 2003)...the clubs have met 21 times overall, with the Reds holding a 14-7 advantage...the 21 games vs. Cincinnati are tied for Tampa Bay's second fewest against any opponent (SF), ahead of only the Los Angeles-NL (20G).

CONNECTIONS

- Rays OF **Jose Siri** was originally signed by the Reds as an international free agent in 2012... he was part of Cincinnati's organization until being claimed off waivers by Seattle in 2020.
- The Reds have three Sunshine State natives on their active roster: **INF Jonathan India** (Ft. Lauderdale), **RHP Nick Martinez** (Miami) and **OF Austin Slater** (Jacksonville).
- Cincinnati OF **Jake Fraley** was selected by the Rays in Competitive Balance Round B (77th overall) of the 2016 first-year player draft... was later dealt to Seattle in 2018, a trade involving **C Mike Zunino**.
- Reds Television Network broadcaster **Jim Day** had a three-year stint working for WFTS-TV in Tampa.
- Cincinnati Bullpen Coach **Matt Tracy** resides in Tampa during the offseason, as does **RHP Rhett Lowder**, selected by the Reds with the No. 7 overall pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft.
- On Nov. 11, 1997, the Devil Rays acquired **OF Mike Kelly** from the Reds for a player to be named later... Kelly became the first player to be added to the 40-man major league roster in club history and marked Tampa Bay's first trade involving a major league player.
- Tampa Bay selected Cincinnati 1B/**OF Dmitri Young** in the first round (No. 8) in the 1997 Expansion Draft.
- The Rays played in the Venezuelan Summer League (VSL) in 2007 as part of a co-op team with the Reds before forming a team of their own in 2008.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will take the ball for his fourth start of the campaign and second at home...marks his fourth career Interleague start...is seeking his first win since July 3, 2022 at Toronto, 748 days ago...missed the 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022...has a 4.00 ERA (54.0IP, 24ER) in 12 career MLB starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Baz did not permit a run, but was limited to 3.1 frames after issuing a career-high five walks on July 21 at Yankee Stadium (ND, 3.1IP, 4H, OR, 5BB, 1SO)...escaped bases-loaded jams in the 1st and 2nd frames, stranding nine baserunners on the afternoon...in the 2nd, induced a **Juan Soto** inning-ending GIDP...walked at least one batter in every frame...the five walks matched **Aaron Civale** (April 21 at NYY) for the most by a Ray this season...Baz became the first Ray to issue 5+ walks in a scoreless start since **Chris Archer** (5BB) on May 16, 2014 at LAA.

SEEING RED—Baz will be making his second career start vs. Cincinnati, joining a July 10, 2022 outing in which he allowed career highs in hits (8), runs (7) and homers (3) while being chased in the 3rd inning...that outing marked his final MLB appearance before undergoing Tommy John surgery...in three career Interleague starts, he is 1-1 with a 5.27 ERA (13.2IP, 8ER).

TROP TALK—Baz is 2-0 with a 2.49 ERA (25.1IP, 7ER), 0.95 WHIP and .194 (18-for-93) opp. average in five career home starts, holding opponents hitless (0-for-8) with RISP...excluding openers, it marks the second-lowest ERA through five home starts in Rays history, trailing **Drew Rasmussen** (1.96).

BACK IN BUSINESS—Through his first three starts, Baz's slider has been his most effective offering...opponents are 1-for-18 (.056) with no extra-base hits in at-bats ending with the pitch...opposing hitters are batting a combined .421 (16-for-38) with 2 2B and 2 HR against his other three pitches (four-seamer, curveball, changeup).

✦ Baz has had the most success against right-handed hitters, holding them to 5-for-23 (.217) with 5 SO and no walks...righties are hitless (0-for-11) against his slider.

ALL THE ACCOLADES—Despite missing nearly two years of MLB action, Baz was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 96 overall prospect in the game in its July 3 updated rankings...following the 2023 season, Baz was tabbed by the publication as having the best slider among Rays prospects for the sixth consecutive year...after the 2022 season, he was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 32 overall prospect in baseball and the top-ranked farmhand in the Rays system...he peaked at No. 8 on the list at the conclusion of the 2021 campaign.

THE ROAD BACK—Baz began his rehab assignment with Triple-A Durham on May 5...in 10 starts with the Bulls, he went 3-3 with a 4.12 ERA (39.1IP, 18ER) and 44 SO against 23 BB...in five June starts, however, he went 3-0 with a 1.57 ERA (23.0IP, 4ER) and 35 SO.

✦ Baz was slowed early in spring due to two bouts with oblique soreness, one coming as the result of picking up a weight, and the other after experiencing soreness following a simulated game appearance.

CAREER RUNDOWN—Baz made six starts in 2022, going 1-2 with a 5.00 ERA (27.0IP, 15ER) with 30 strikeouts and nine walks...in four starts from June 17-July 3, he went 1-0 with a 1.21 ERA (22.1IP, 3ER) and 26 strikeouts...the four-start run was bookended by two outings (June 11 at MIN & July 10 at CIN) in which he went a combined 0-2 with a 23.14 ERA (4.2IP, 12ER).

✦ He was on the Rays active roster from June 11-July 12...underwent arthroscopic surgery on March 21 to remove loose bodies from his right elbow...placed on the 15-day IL on July 14 with a right elbow strain...following a rest, treatment and rehab program, continued to feel discomfort and underwent Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28.

✦ In 2021, he made his MLB debut on Sept. 20 vs. TOR (W, 5.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 0BB, 5SO)...went on to make two additional starts, finishing the season 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (13.1IP, 3ER)...he became the second pitcher in major league history to start a postseason game with three or fewer career regular season appearances up to that point, joining **TB Matt Moore** in Game 1 of the 2011 ALDS at Texas.

✦ On June 17 at BAL, he started on his 23rd birthday and yielded two hits across 6.0 scoreless innings...he became the third Ray to make a scoreless start on his birthday, joining **Corey Kluber** (4.2 IP) on April 10, 2022 vs. Baltimore and **Jeremy Hellickson** (8.2 IP) on April 8, 2012 vs. New York-AL.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP ZACK LITTELL (3-7, 4.46)

LAST START—Permitted a career-high-tying 3 HR in a 9-1 loss at Yankee Stadium on July 22 (L, 5.2IP, 9H, 5ER, 2BB, 6SO)...struck out the side in the opening frame, but the first two batters in the 2nd frame (Wells/Volpe) homered...has gone 0-2 with a 7.47 ERA (15.2IP, 13ER) over his last three starts.

vs. REDS—In three career relief appearances opposite Cincinnati, Littell has posted a 3.00 ERA (3.0IP, 1ER) with 4 SO, recording a pair of holds...will mark his second career start against an NL Central foe, joining Aug. 10, 2023 vs. St. Louis (6.0IP, 7H, 3ER, 5SO, HR).
