**TODAY'S GAME:** The Atlanta Braves and Milwaukee Brewers today commence a three-game weekend series with the first of six scheduled games between the clubs this season...The Braves will travel to Milwaukee as part of a three-city road trip from August 17-23...Atlanta will play three games in Minnesota and one game on the south side of Chicago before departing for Milwaukee.

- A** On Wednesday versus San Francisco, the Braves dropped both the resumption of Game 1 of the series as well as the regularly-scheduled Game 2... Matt Olson and Austin Riley each had three hits in the second game.
- A** The Braves have lost their last six games to Milwaukee inside Truist Park, with their last win occurring on July 30, 2023...The Brewers and Orioles are the only teams in MLB that Atlanta hasn't beaten at home in that time.
- A** RH Jacob Misiorowski has never faced the Braves, but he pitched from Truist Park's rubber on July 15, 2025 as a National League All-Star...He hurled a scoreless eighth inning and earned a hold...The 6-foot-7, 201-pound right-hander became the first player in MLB history to earn an All-Star nod with five-or-fewer career starts under his belt.

**MARTÍN PÉREZ:** Has made four starts (five appearances against the Brewers, going 0-3 with an 8.54 ERA (25 ER/26.1 IP) – the highest mark he's posted against any single team...Pérez allowed a career-high nine earned runs to Milwaukee on May 15, 2024 as a member of the Pittsburgh Pirates...Overall this season, the 6-foot-0, 210-pound native of Guanare, VZ, is 5-3 with a 2.90 ERA (20 ER/62.0 IP).

- A** This year, the 2022 All-Star has completed at least 5.0 innings in all 10 of his starting assignments, tied for the eighth-longest streak in the National League...The native of Guanare, VZ, has limited opponents to two earned runs-or-fewer in seven of those turns.
- A** Among the 15 active starting pitchers that are at least 35 years old (min. 10 starts), Pérez' ERA (2.90) is fourth-best in MLB behind Zack Wheeler (PHI, 2.01), Chris Sale (ATL, 2.30) and Nick Martinez (TB, 2.60).

**MAURICIO DUBÓN:** Went 1-for-4 on Wednesday night and belted his seventh home run of the season, already matching his 2025 total...The utility player needs just three more home runs to match his career high (10 HR, 2023).

- A** Last season, Atlanta shortstops combined for 0.4 fWAR...Dubón has accumulated 1.1 fWAR while playing shortstop, already more than double last year's production...His 1.6 fWAR overall only trail Matt Olson (2.7), Michael Harris II (2.2) and Ozzie Albies (1.7) on Atlanta's club.
- A** Defensively, Dubón has been worth eight outs above average, according to Statcast, tied for ninth in MLB regardless of position.

**DRAKE BALDWIN:** Returned from the injured list prior to Game 1 of the series versus San Francisco...The catcher went 1-for-5 in his first game back after missing 23 games due to a strained right oblique muscle.

- A** In his first at-bat since May 18, Baldwin belted the fifth pitch for a 473-foot home run...The ball left the bat at 112.8 mph and landed at the base of the batter's eye in center field.
- A** The longball stands as the farthest in MLB this season, and deepest since Mike Trout hit a 485-foot homer on September 20, 2025.
- A** Baldwin became just the fifth catcher in the Statcast era (since 2015) to hit a home run of that length, and the first to do so since Travis d'Arnaud hit a 474-footer in Atlanta exactly three years prior – June 16, 2023...Gary Sánchez (3), Chris Iannetta (1) and Jorge Alfaro (1) are the other backstops with homers 473 feet-or-longer.
- A** The home run is tied for the seventh-longest by a Brave in the Statcast era behind homers from Ronald Acuña Jr. (495 ft., 481 ft.), Adam Duvall (483 ft., 477 ft.), Marcell Ozuna (479 ft.) and Travis d'Arnaud (474 ft.).

**AUSTIN RILEY:** On Wednesday logged four hits between the two games, collecting a 111.0-mph double in Game 1 (1-for-4) before hitting three singles in Game 2 (3-for-5)...The singles carried exit velocities of 96.3 mph, 104.3 mph and 110.3 mph – all categorized as "hard hits."

- A** Riley also had a 100.0-mph flyout in the second game, giving him four "hard-hit" balls (exit velocity 95+ mph) in the contest – his most in a single game this season...Atlanta's third baseman hadn't had three hard-hit balls in a game since May 18 versus Miami.
- A** Riley's three-hit effort tied his season high, which he also accomplished on March 27 versus Kansas City and May 22 versus Washington.

**ON LOSING:** The Braves today will attempt to avoid losing four games in a row for the first time the season...The Chicago White Sox are the only other team in MLB yet to endure a four-game skid.

- A** Atlanta's five series losses this season are still the fewest in MLB...The Dodgers, Brewers and Yankees have all lost the second-fewest series – six apiece.
- A** The Braves have lost three consecutive series for the first time since August 31-September 14, 2025, when they lost five in a row...The team has lost six-of-seven games for the first time since September 6-13 last season.

**TRADE:** The Braves last night acquired C Joey Bart from the Pittsburgh Pirates in exchange for RHP Hunter Stratton...To make room on the 40-man roster, Atlanta designated C Sandy León for assignment.

- A** Bart will wear jersey No. 16 and be active for tonight's game...Should he appear for Atlanta, he will become the eighth different catcher to play for the Braves this season – a modern franchise record.

#### Today's Game

Makes his 11th start of the season and the 290th of his career in the opener of a three-game series against Milwaukee at Truist Park...In his most recent turn June 13 at New York (NL), the 35-year-old Venezuelan earned the win, allowing one run over 5.1 innings in Atlanta's 3-1 victory at Citi Field.

Owns an 0-3 record and an 8.54 ERA (25 ER/26.1 IP) in five career appearances against Milwaukee, four of them starts...Has yet to record a win against the Brewers in his career.

Has allowed five hits or fewer in 20 consecutive starts dating to March 31, 2025, the longest active streak of its kind by a left-handed starting pitcher...The run is the second-longest by a left-handed starter since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game streak from 2013-14.

The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters with a 5-3 record and a 2.90 ERA (20 ER/62.0 IP) over 14 total appearances - 10 starts and four relief outings - with 51 strikeouts against 21 walks.

Owns a 2.90 ERA (20 ER/62.0 IP) through his first 14 games of the season, the second-lowest mark he has posted over a season-opening 14-game span in his career, trailing only the 1.96 ERA (19 ER/87.1 IP) he recorded to begin 2022 with Texas...His next-lowest such span was a 3.38 ERA over his first 14 games of 2016, also with the Rangers.

Right-handed batters are hitting .203 (31-for-153) with four homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .200 (13-for-65) with two homers.

#### 2026

Won his most recent start June 13 at New York (NL), allowing one run on four hits over 5.1 innings with one walk and four strikeouts on 71 pitches in Atlanta's 3-1 victory at Citi Field...Bichette's double was the only extra-base hit he surrendered.

Earned the win in his most recent start June 5 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs on three hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and five strikeouts on 85 pitches in Atlanta's 6-3 victory at Truist Park...All three runs scored in the third inning.

Earned the win May 30 at Cincinnati, allowing two runs on four hits over 5.0 innings with three walks and two strikeouts on 81 pitches in Atlanta's 5-2 victory at Great American Ball Park...Bleday's two-run homer in the second was the only home run he surrendered

Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985)...At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).

Received a no-decision May 19 at Miami, working 5.0 innings with two walks, a career-high 10 strikeouts and a home run on 78 pitches in Atlanta's 8-4 win at loanDepot park...Set a career high in strikeouts and recorded his first career 10-strikeout game.

Tossed a perfect inning of relief on May 16 vs. Boston, striking out a pair on 14 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in the Braves' 3-2 loss at Truist Park.

Worked a perfect inning of relief on May 13 vs. the Cubs, striking out two on 12 pitches in Atlanta's 4-1 win at Truist Park.

Took the loss in his start on May 6 at Seattle, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.2 innings with one walk, five strikeouts and a home run on 84 pitches in a 3-1 defeat at T-Mobile Park...The home run was a solo shot by Julio Rodríguez in the sixth.

Earned his second win as a Brave on April 28 vs. Detroit, working 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with four walks and five strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 5-2 victory at Truist Park.

Tossed 3.0 innings of relief on April 22 at Washington, allowing a pair of solo home runs in a span of three batters in the sixth inning, but did not factor in the decision in the 8-6 win.

Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.

Took the loss in his second start with Atlanta on April 11 vs. Cleveland, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings with three walks, two strikeouts and a home run on 86 pitches in a 6-0 defeat...The lone run came on a solo home run by José Ramírez in the fourth inning.

Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.

Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.

Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17...Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.
