**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Padres meet play game two of this three-game series... SF has won 14 of its last 18 games overall entering play today and hold a 1.0 game lead over the Dodgers for the NL West with 11 games remaining on the regular season schedule...SF's magic number to clinch the NL West stands at 11.

**ROSTER MOVES:** LHP Scott Kazmir (#16) selected from Triple-A Sacramento...RHP Jay Jackson has been optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

**NATIONAL LEAD:** The Giants' 98-53 current record puts them in contention for the best record by an NL team in the divisional era...their 98 wins through their first 151 games are tied for the third-most in the NL since 1969...the 1975 Reds and 1986 Mets each finished the year with 108 wins, which is the best mark for any NL team since 1969.

**BEST IN THE BIGS:** The Giants (98-53, .649) enter tonight with the best record in the Majors, one game ahead of the Dodgers (97-54, .642)...the .649 winning percentage through 151 games is the club's best in the SF-era and the best by a Giants team since 1913.

**CLOSE TO THE CENTURY MARK:** The Giants need just two more victories for 100 this year...just seven Giants teams in franchise history have won 100 games: 1904 NY Giants (106), 1905 NY Giants (105), 1912 NY Giants (103), 1962 SF Giants (103), 1993 SF Giants (103), 1913 NY Giants (101) and 2003 SF Giants (100)...this 2021 club is on pace for 105 wins.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** San Francisco is 49-27 (.645) away from home this season, its fifth-best road win percentage in franchise history...SF has won 13 of its last 15 road games...beginning July 2, the Giants' 25-8 (.758) road record is tops in MLB.

**LATE INNING LAMONTE:** OF LaMonte Wade Jr. recorded his MLB-best sixth go-ahead hit in the 9th inning or later last night to give the Giants a 6-5 win...according to ESPN Stats & Info, Wade Jr. is hitting .625 (15-for-24) after the 8th inning this season, on pace to be the second-best such batting average in the last 40 years (min. 20 AB) behind Joe Crede, who went 14-for-20 (.700) in 2002.

**MOON SHOTS:** The Giants have reached 228 home runs this season, surpassing the 2000 club (226) for second-most all time by a Giants team in a single season...the team needs just seven more homers to match a franchise-best 235 home runs done by the 2001 club...the Giants have hit at least one home run in 13 of 14 games against the Friars this season, including all seven games at Petco.

**REACHING BASE:** IF/OF Kris Bryant has reached base safely in each of his last 19 games entering play today, his longest streak since a 23-game on-base streak from June 2-26, 2019 with the Cubs...Bryant's streak is the third-longest active on-base streak in MLB behind the Rays Wander Franco (39) and Royals Nicky Lopez (31).

**ONE RUN WINS:** The Giants are 29-15 (.659) in one-run games this year, tops in MLB.

**GETTING CLOSER TO 1,500:** C Buster Posey is just 12 hits away from reaching the 1,500 hit milestone...he enters tonight's game with a current 14-game hit streak against San Diego, batting .415 (22-for-53) with three home runs and seven RBI.

**PINCH ME:** The Giants have hit 16 pinch-hit home runs this season, one shy of matching the 2016 St. Louis Cardinals for the most in MLB history.

**ON DECK:** SF's final regular-season road trip concludes with a three-game set at Colorado this weekend...the Giants are 12-4 against the Rockies this year, going 4-2 at Coors Field.

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

**RHP Vince Velasquez** is scheduled to make his second start in a Padres uniform since signing a minor league deal with SD on Sept. 15...Velasquez faced the Giants earlier this year as a member of the Phillies and was tagged for the loss after allowing four runs on four hits in 4.0 innings...overall, he's 1-4 with a 4.02 ERA in six starts against SF.

**LHP Scott Kazmir** will make his third start for the Giants this year and his fourth appearance...the last time he faced the Padres was back on July 8, 2016...in five career starts against SD, he's 1-0 with a 4.91 ERA.

### GIANTS HOME RUNS

The Giants enter today with 228 homers, second-most in the Majors behind Toronto (241)...SF has scored 50.5% of their runs off home runs (375 of 742 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 228 homers are second-most in team history behind the 2001 club, who hit a franchise-best 235 homers.

# SCOTT KAZMIR LHP #16

**2021 RECORD: 0-1, 6.43 ERA**

**TODAY'S OUTING:** 37-year-old left-hander is slated to make his fourth appearance with the Giants this season and his third start... was selected from Triple-A Sacramento today...last pitched Thursday vs. Las Vegas and allowed three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings.

**2021 SEASON:** Kazmir has pitched for Triple-A Sacramento (3-3, 4.61 ERA), the Giants (0-1, 6.43 ERA) and for the USA Team (1-0, 0.00 ERA) in the Olympics this year.

**CALL IT A (SECOND) COMEBACK:** Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in February and had his contract purchased May 22...marked his first time on a Major League roster since 2016 when he was with the Dodgers, going 10-6 with a 4.56 ERA in 26 starts...made his first comeback in 2013Z after injuries kept him out of most of the 2011 season and the entirety of the 2012 campaign.

**300TH START:** Is scheduled to make his 300th career start today...will become the 13th active pitcher with 300-or-more starts, joining Zack Greinke (488), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (449), Cole Hamels (422), Max Scherzer (396), Ervin Santana (386), Clayton Kershaw (374), Adam Wainwright (356), Johnny Cueto (329), J.A. Happ (326), David Price (322) and Madison Bumgarner (319).

**TEAM USA:** Led Team USA to a 3-1 win over the Dominican Republic to advance to the semifinals at the Olympic Games in Tokyo last month...escaped a bases-loaded jam with one out in the top of the 1st inning, then retired 12 of the next 13 batters faced over 5.0-scoreless innings...the U.S. fell short in the gold medal game and wound up with a silver medal.

**THE ENERGIZER BUNNY:** Kazmir has spent parts of 12 seasons in the Major Leagues, racking up 11+ years of service time in The Show...he's 108-97 with a 4.02 ERA in 301 games (299 starts)...he made his Major League debut on August 23, 2004 at 20 years old, earning the win with 5.0 shutout innings for Tampa Bay...he was a three-time All-Star (2006, 2008, 2014) and finished ninth in the Rookie of the Year voting in 2005 as a 21-year-old.

**CONNECT FOUR:** Kazmir is playing for **Gabe Kapler** after playing with Kapler in 2009 with Tampa Bay along with current Giants third baseman **Evan Longoria**...Kapler was 2-for-11 with a double and four strikeouts in his career vs. Kazmir while Longoria ended up having more success, going 5-for-15 with a homer and five RBI off him.

## DICK TIDROW 1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children—Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
