**THE BREAKFAST CLUB:** The Giants wrap up their three-city, 10-game road trip today as they play the series finale against the Cubs...a win tonight would give SF its first series win on the road since May 15-17 at the A's (2-1) and put the Giants at .500 on the road trip (5-5), their best record on a road trip since going 2-1 at Petco Park on their first road trip of the season on March 30-April 1.

- ▶ Yesterday's 3-2 defeat in extras was the Giants' sixth walk-off loss of the season, tied with the Royals for second-most in MLB behind the Tigers (seven)...the Giants were walked off seven times all of last season.
- ▶ Still, SF enters today winners of four of its last seven games and are averaging 8.1 runs per game in the six games...prior to this stretch, the Giants had dropped each of their previous five games and nine of their previous 11.
- ▶ Giants batters are slashing .328/.369/.578 with 27 doubles, 17 homers, 66 runs scored and a .948 OPS through nine games on the road trip...the last time SF has hit .348 or better on a road trip of six or more games was in 2021, when they hit .33 in six games from Sept. 6-12 while also visiting the Rockies and Cubs.
- ▶ SF is 4-5 on the road trip so far, visiting the Rockies (1-2), Brewers (2-2) and Cubs (1-1).

**YOU MESS WITH THE BULL, YOU GET THE HORNS: IF Rafael Devers** hit his eighth homer of the season yesterday to put SF on the board in the 6th...the solo shot extended the Giants' current home run streak to eight games, matching their longest such streak this season (also done May 4-12) and ranking as the fourth-longest active home run streak in MLB behind the Phillies (11), Braves and Mariners (both at nine).

- ▶ SF's 17 home runs this road trip are their most on any road trip since 2024, when they also hit 17 on their trip to Baltimore, Arizona and Kansas City (Sept. 17-25).
- ▶ A home run today would give SF their most homers on a road trip in over 15 years...the last time SF homered 18 times on the road was on July 1-10, 2010 on their trip to Colorado, Milwaukee and Washington.
- ▶ Exactly a month ago, the Giants entered the day in last place with 23 total home runs...since the start of play on May 7, however, their 43 homers trail only the Nationals (44) and White Sox (44) across MLB.
- ▶ Lastly, Devers himself has homered twice off Cubs starter RHP Jameson Taillon...he's 4-for-13 with the two homers, six RBI, three walks and a sac fly vs. Taillon in his career.

**ARE WE GONNA BE LIKE OUR PARENTS?:** With another pair of hits yesterday, **OF Jung Hoo Lee** extended his current hitting streak to a career-best 14 games, the longest active hitting streak in MLB and fifth-longest of any Major League player overall this season.

- ▶ He is 27-for-54 (.500) during the streak with 13 runs scored, four doubles, a triple, a home run and seven RBI...Lee's batting average increased from .265 before the streak started on May 14 to his current .324 mark.
- ▶ Lee's .324 average this season is fourth-best in the Majors, trailing only PHI's Brandon Marsh (.335), MIA's Otto Lopez (.333) and TB's Yandy Díaz (.326).
- ▶ Over his last nine games dating to May 29, Lee is 22-for-37 (.595) with 10 runs scored...the last Giant to record 22 hits in a nine-game span was **Willie Mays**, who hit 23 times in almost the same exact dates as Lee in 1958 (May 28-June 6).
- ▶ Lastly, Lee's 27 hits during his current streak are the most by a Giants player in any 14-game span since **Buster Posey** had 29 hits from August 22-September 6, 2014.

**COULD YOU DESCRIBE THE RUCKUS, SIR?:** The Giants enter play today with the third-best batting average in the Majors at .258, trailing only the Dodgers (.262) and the Braves (.258).

- ▶ SF has two of the top five hitters in baseball this season in terms of average, with Lee ranking fourth as mentioned above and **IF Luis Arraez** following him in fifth place at .324.
- ▶ The last time the Giants had an average this high as a club in their first 65 games of the season was in 2018, when they ranked second in MLB with a .264 clip...they trailed only the Red Sox (.265), who went on to win the World Series.

**WE'RE ALL PRETTY BIZARRE, SOME OF US ARE JUST BETTER AT HIDING IT:** Since May 10, the Giants lead the Majors with a .282 batting average and have gone 11-15 in the 26 games...in the 11 wins, the team is averaging 9.64 run per game...in the 15 losses, however, they're averaging just 2.73 runs/game.

# TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

2026 RECORD: 2-3, 4.50 ERA

**T-MAC:** Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his third consecutive defeat Tuesday night in the Giants' 8-3 loss to the Brewers at American Family Field...he walked two in the 1st inning and was burned by Jake Bauers for a three-run homer...he settled in after that, blanking Milwaukee over his final four innings of work...all told he allowed the three runs on five hits with a career-high three walks and four strikeouts.

**LEAKY SINK?:** McDonald has heavily relied upon his sinker since being recalled to SF's roster in early May and opponents have had success against it in his last two starts...in those two games, the D-Backs (5-for-16, .313) and Brewers (5-for-13, .385) have combined to go 10-for-29 (.345) off the pitch...the sinker is his most used pitch with him throwing it 59.1% of the time...Cubs hitters have the best batting average (.330), on-base percentage (.430) and OPS (.928) against sinkers this year...the Cubs' .499 SLG vs. the pitch is second only to the D-Backs (.501).

**WHY DON'T YOU...SLIDE?:** Conversely, hitters have gone 1-for-14 off his slider (his most used secondary pitch) in his last three starts...after his slider was his most used pitch in his brief action with SF last year, he's used it 27.4% of the time this year (50.5% last year)...hitters are 3-for-32 (.094) with 12 strikeouts off that pitch this year.

**VS. CHICAGO-NL:** Is facing the Cubs for the first time in his young career.

**INFLATION:** McDonald's 4.50 ERA heading into this outing is largely because of his tough 4th inning against the White Sox on May 22...after opening that game with three perfect innings, he allowed seven runs (all earned) on three hits, a walk and two hit batters before departing...his ERA with the Giants outside of that one inning this year is 2.70 (10er, 33.1ip).

**IN THE MAJORS:** When his number has been called at the Major League level he's been effective except for his aforementioned rough 4th inning vs. the White Sox on May 22...he made his MLB debut on the last day of the season in 2024, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...in three games (two starts) last year he went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3er, 15.0ip) with SF winning both of his starts...in his brief MLB career thus far he owns a 3.46 ERA (20er, 52.0ip) with 46 strikeouts in 10 games (eight starts)...the Giants are 5-3 in McDonald's eight career starts.

**GROUNDING:** The 25-year-old owns a 61.6% groundball rate in his six starts, which ranks in the 99th percentile in the Majors...the Phillies Christopher Sánchez currently leads the Majors with a 58.3% groundball rate.

**ORDER UP...:** He's been at his best the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 7-for-50 (.140) with a .524 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .271 with a .664 OPS the second time through and .300 with a .805 OPS the third time through

**TOMORROW'S STARTER**

- Is coming off his best start of the season...was perfect through 5.0 innings and didn't give up his first hit until after 6.1 innings on Wednesday at Milwaukee.
- Overall, earned his third win of the year after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings with one hit, a walk and seven K's.
- Since returning from the IL on May 29, he has a 0.79 ERA (2er, 11.1ip) with nine strikeouts, a .105 BAA and 0.71 WHIP in two starts...Webb had missed 20 games with right knee bursitis.
- Will face the Nationals for the eighth time in his career...is 5-1 with a 4.29 ERA in the seven starts but is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA in three starts at Oracle Park.

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has surrendered seven runs in 3.0ip in three games since his recall and has a 10.50 ERA in five appearances (6.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25...left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

- ▶ Has a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) in his last eight games.
- ▶ Has a 1.62 ERA (3er, 16.2ip) in 12 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 21 contests (4.8 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .212 (7-for-33) off his slider, .224 (11-for-49) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

### #31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/6 at CHC; 0.0ip, h, r (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has made 11 appearances with SF, logging 8.2 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits with 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has walked 11 batters in 8.2 innings (11.42 BB/9ip).
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 6/6 at CHC; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (17 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0 innings in May but has thrown 3.2 scoreless inning with three hits and 4K's in his last four games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-58 (.190) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 9-for-45 (.200) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/6 at CHC; 0.2ip, 2h, hb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 14 walks in his 18.1ip (6.87 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 63.1 innings pitched dating back to August 14, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-34 (.176) off him while left-handers are 8-for-34 (.176).
- ▶ Holding opponents 3-for-25 (.120) off his slider and 6-for-34 (.176) off his sinker.

### #77 CARSON SEYMOUR ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Slider, Changeup

**Last Game:** 6/5 at CHC; 3.0ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, hr, bb, k (45 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Friday.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA (22er, 49.0ip) and 23 strikeouts in 11 games (nine starts) with the River Cats this season.
- ▶ In his last three starts with Sacramento leading up to his recall, Seymour was 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3er, 16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.38 ERA (10er, 26.2ip) in 13 games out of the bullpen for SF in 2025...also made three starts, posting a 8.68 ERA (9er, 9.1ip) and .325 BAA as a starter.
- ▶ His most effective pitch last season was his four-seamer...batters were 5-for-31 against it (.161) with eight strikeouts.

### #66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 6/5 at CHC; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday, his second recall of the season...has made two appearances so far for SF, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings with a walk and two strikeouts.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with Detroit last season...in seven games at the Major League level last year, the righty went 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2er, 13.0ip), four strikeouts, a 0.85 WHIP and .150 BAA.
