TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 4-game series vs David Gene Parker's Pirates and the sixth game (2-2) of a 7-day trip that includes a 2-1 series win at Chc.
- This road trip does not officially include the 2 days (8/2-8/3) the Redlegs spent in Bristol, TN playing the Braves in the inaugural MLB Speedway Classic, as Cin served as the home team in that contest.
- The Reds haven't had a day off since 7/24.
- Following tomorrow's game, the Reds return home for a 7-day, 6-game homestand vs Phi (8/11-8/13) and Mil (8/15-8/17).

HARD TO SWALLOW: The Reds have lost 26 games this season in which they held a lead, including yesterday at Pit (up 2-1, lost 3-2).

- Yesterday's was Cin's fifth loss of the season when leading after 7 inn.
- Are 2-49 when trailing after 8 innings.
- The Redlegs are 14-16 in 1-run games (.467) this season and 29-44 (.397) in 1-run games since the beginning of last year...had won 9 of their previous 14 such affairs prior to yesterday's loss.
- Have scored 2 runs or fewer in 39 games this season, including each of their last 3 games and 4 of their last 6.
- Last night fell to 45-15 on the season when holding opponents to 3 runs or fewer (.750)...those 15 losses rank seventh-most in the majors.
- Have lost 8 of their last 13 road series.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 37 series of 2025, including the recently-completed 3-game set at Chc (2-1).

- This 37-series, in-season streak without being swept is the longest run in club history, eclipsing the 1970 National League championship team, which opened its season with 32 straight series without getting swept.
- Cin is the only Major League team not to have been swept this season.
- On 6 occasions avoided being swept with a win in the final game of a set (4/23 at Mia, 5/15 vs CWS, 6/22 at StL, 7/2 at Bos, 7/23 at Wsh, 7/30 vs LAD).
- Cin hasn't been swept in a series of at least 2 games since 9/24-9/25, 2024 at Cle (2g), a span of 38 straight series...per Elias, that marks the fifth-longest streak of sweepless series in team history (see below).

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD: The Reds are in the midst of a final 59-game stretch in which 38 games have been/will be played against opponents with records at or above .500 (3-0 vs TB, 1-2 vs LAD, 2-1 at Chc, 3g vs Phi, 3g vs Mil, 3g at LAD, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Tor, 3g vs NYM, 3g at SD, 3g at StL, 4g at Chc, 3g at Mil).

- As of today, the Reds have the toughest remaining schedule in the Major Leagues, based on opponents' winning percentage (.529).
- NYM has the ninth-toughest remaining schedule (.509) while Chc (.479) and SD (.477) have the third- and second-easiest remaining schedules in the league, respectively.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds lost 2 of 3 at Pit in their last meeting (5/19-5/21) and swept the Pirates in 3 games at Great American Ball Park in the first series this year between the clubs (4/11-4/13)...it was Cin's first sweep of Pit since 8/5-8/8, 2021 at GABP (4g).

- Cin has played the Pirates 503 times since both teams became charter members of the National League Central in 1994 (261-242, .519), more than any other Pit opponent.
- The 2-0 loss at Pit on 4/23/23 was the Reds' 100th loss at PNC Park... are 96-109 overall here...the Reds and Pirates played the first regularseason game at PNC Park on 4/9/01 (8-2 Reds triumph).
- The Redlegs have lost 45 of the last 64 and 14 of the last 19 games they've played at PNC Park, including an 11-game losing streak spanning 9/3/18 to 9/27/19 and an 8-game losing streak to begin the 2019 season (4/4-9/27, 2019).

CHASING HISTORY: In yesterday's 3-2 loss at PIT, RHP Chase Burns produced his fourth 10-strikeout game of his young career to become the first Major League pitcher since 1893 with at least 10 strikeouts in 4 of his first 8 apps.

- Is also just the third Major League pitcher since 1893 with double-digit strikeouts in 4 of his first 8 career starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (1981) and Bob Feller (1936)...courtesy Elias.
- Is the first Reds pitcher to begin his career with at least 57 strikeouts over his first 8 games since Gary Nolan (60k, 1967).

MAN OF STEAL: SS Elly De La Cruz stole his 30th base of the season in Sun's MLB Speedway Classic, becoming the ninth Major Leaguer in the live-ball era (since 1920) with at least 30 steals in each of his first 3 career seasons, the first since KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (2022-24).

His 132 career stolen bases are fifth-most by any Major Leaguer through their first 3 career seasons in the live-ball era (since 1920), behind only Vince Coleman (326, 1985-87), Rickey Henderson (189, 1979-81), Delino DeShields (144, 1990-92), and Kenny Lofton (138, 1991-93).

- Was his third relief appearance of the season, his first since 6/23 vs NYY...was his first relief app since moving to the bullpen following the acquisition of starter Zack Littell at the trade deadline...is filling Lodolo's spot in the rotation while Lodolo is on the 15-day IL recovering from a blister on his left index finger.
- Was his longest relief outing since 7/30/24 vs Chc (4.0ip).

JULY 30: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-2 win vs LAD on 7/30 (6.0ip, 4h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 7k, 1hr, 103TP).

- Was his ninth quality start of the season.
- Issued 2 walks or fewer in a start for the 20th time this season
- Eclipsed the 900.0 inning mark for his career (901.1)

JULY 25: Earned the 7-2 win vs TB on 7/25 (5.0ip, 4h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 5k, 93TP).

- Issued 2 walks or fewer for the 19th time this season.
- Was his third straight start in which he was the winning pitcher of record.

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 120 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .359 ranks among the best in the majors...hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches <u>put in play</u> at an exit velocity over 95 mph...league avg is .413.

1-2-3 BATTERS: Is holding batters at the top of the order (1, 2, 3) to a .196/.248/.349 slash line with 11 walks (202 BF)...his 1-2-3 batters have reached safely just 50 times.

QUALIFIED: On November 19, 2024, Martinez accepted the club's qualifying offer to return for the 2025 season after opting out of his original 2-year contract he signed in 2023.

- Became the fifth Reds pitcher over the last 125 years to post at least 7.0 innings and allow 1 run or none, with 8 or more strikeouts in his team debut (Also: Brady Singer 3/31/25 vs Tex, Johnny Cueto 4/3/08 vs AZ, Mo Sanford 8/9/91 at SD, and Tom Seaver 6/18/77 at Mon).
- Was his 14th quality start of 2025, the 28th of his career.
- His 8 strikeouts were a season high and his most since striking out a career-high 9 batters on 5/28/24 vs Oak.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 17 of the 26 batters he faced... improved his first-pitch strike pct. to 65.8% which ranks among Major League leaders.
