### Today's Headlines

Connor Van Scoyoc (LAA) pitched five scoreless innings for the Scottsdale Scorpions on Friday, leading his team to a 2-0 victory over the Glendale Desert Dogs. Van Scoyoc did not allow a walk and worked around three hits while collecting three strikeouts.

Russell Smith (MIL) pitched three innings for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Friday, holding the Scottsdale Scorpions scoreless. He worked around four hits and two walks, collecting four strikeouts. Smith has not allowed a run in the Fall League (6 IP).

Matt Mervis (CHC) hit his fourth AFL home run on Friday, giving him sole possession of the league lead. Mervis collected two RBI in a 9-2 win over the Surprise Saguaros, and he now holds a .273/.320/.909 batting slash through six AFL games (6-for-22).

Denzel Clarke (OAK) went 2-for-3 with the Mesa Solar Sox on Friday with a home run and double. He reached base safely in three of his four plate appearances, scoring twice in a 9-2 victory over the Surprise Saguaros. Clarke held an OPS of .834 in the Minors this year.

Tyler Myrick (SF) pitched two scoreless innings of relief for the Scottsdale Scorpions on Friday, earning his second Fall League save. He collected four strikeouts and retired every opposing hitter he faced, preserving his 0.00 ERA with the Scorpions (5 1/3 IP).

The Glendale Desert Dogs currently hold the best run differential in the Fall League (+21). The Surprise Saguaros have allowed the fewest runs (57), while Glendale is tied with the Mesa Solar Sox for the most runs scored

## Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Jonny Gomes (Mesa Solar Sox, 2003) was selected in the 18th round of the 2001 MLB Draft out of Santa Rosa Junior College. He made his way to the Fall League during his third year as a professional, just weeks after making his MLB debut on September 12, 2003. Gomes played in a combined 13 MLB seasons between the Rays, Reds, Red Sox, Athletics, Royals, Nationals and Braves, posting a career .242/.333/.436 batting slash in 1,203 career games. He won a World Series championship with the Boston Red Sox in 2013.
