TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rangers close out their three-game series this afternoon...they have won the first two games in Texas by the scores of 5-2 and 3-1, respectively.

- ▶ SF is now 5-5-1 in road series this season, and have won four of its last five road series...a win today would give SF its first road series sweep since July 14-16, 2023 at Pittsburgh.
- ▶ The Giants have won 13 of their last 21 games, even with a six-game losing streak from May 29-June 4...their 5.52 runs per game ranks second, .619 winning percentage is tied for fifth and their .760 OPS ranks fourth over that span (since May 15).
- ▶ Following today's game, the Giants will fly back to the Bay Area to begin a six-game homestand against two more AL West teams in the Astros (June 10-12) and the Angels (June 14-16) with an off day in between.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants announced the following moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **RHP Keaton Winn** (#67) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.
- ▶ **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

RANGER DANGER: The Giants are 27-16 (.628) all-time vs. the Rangers with a 197-177 (+20) run differential...according to *Stats, LLC*, SF is one of two teams (also LAD) to hold an all-time winning percentage greater than .600 against Texas.

- ▶ This marks SF's first regular season series win at Texas since SF took two of three July 15-17, 2001.
- ▶ This series is just SF's second at Globe Life Field...SF split a two-game series June 8-9, 2021 with a 12-8 run differential.

BAY AREA TRAFFIC: Rangers RHP Nathan Eovaldi has a daunting .458 opposing OPS against the first batter of an inning...SF has been one of the best teams in MLB when leading off an inning as shown in the chart below.

VAMOS RAMOS: OF Heliot Ramos powered SF's offense yesterday with all three RBI, two of which came on a two-run home run...he is batting .462 (12x26) with six runs, a double, four home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.538 OPS in seven June games.

- ▶ He has reached base in 26 of his 28 games this year, and is slashing .327/.419/.554 with 13 runs, five doubles, six home runs and 23 RBI.
- ▶ Ramos' .973 OPS this season is sixth-best in MLB, while his and .419 on-base percentage ranks seventh (min 100 PA).
- ▶ The 23 RBI are the most by a Giant in their first 28 games of a season since the 23 RBI by **OF Hunter Pence** from April 4-May 3, 2016.

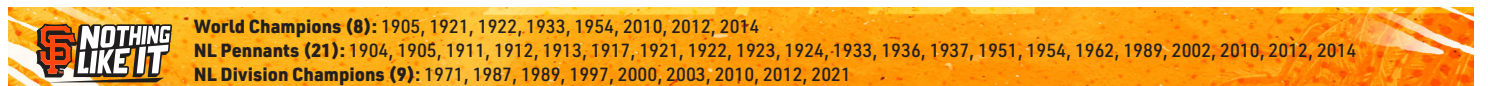
INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Last weekend's series against NYY kicked off a stretch in which SF will face AL teams for four of its next five series, including its current nine-game stretch.

- ▶ The Giants are 4-7 in interleague play early this season...they had only faced two American League opponents (Tampa Bay and Boston) all season prior to this stretch.

ADIÓS PELOTA: The Giants scored two of their three runs on Ramos' homer yesterday, and four of their five runs on Friday via homers by **IF Wilmer Flores** and **OF Michael Conforto**.

- ▶ After scoring nine of its 12 runs on home runs in its last three games, in Wednesday's game at Arizona, SF has now scored 13 of its last 17 runs via homers.
- ▶ The Giants have 42 home runs as a visiting team, which are the most in the National League and third-most in MLB behind New York-AL (51) and Baltimore (49).
- ▶ SF's 12 home runs in June, regardless of venue, are also most in the National League, and rank fourth in MLB behind Baltimore (21), Houston (15) and Chicago-AL (13).

CHAPSTICK: IF Matt Chapman extended his on-base streak to 25 games yesterday with a 6th-inning single...the streak is tied with STL's Paul Goldschmidt for the longest active on-base streak in the NL, and fourth-longest active in MLB.

- ▶ The 25-game streak is the longest by a Giant since **IF Eduardo Núñez** reached base in 33 straight games from May 12-July 16, 2017.
- ▶ Chapman has a slash line of .295/.407/.526 with 22 runs, four home runs and 14 RBI over the streak...his 10 doubles in that span (since May 11) are tied for most in MLB.

THREE'S COMPANY: SF has done well winning low-scoring games this season...the Giants are 23-1 (.958) when allowing three or fewer runs, which is the fewest number of losses, and best winning percentage in the Majors.

IT'S WINNSDAY: RHP Keaton Winn is set to make his first start since exiting vs. the Dodgers on May 14.

- ▶ He had a strong first month of the season, going 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA (12er, 34.0ip), 28 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP in April...in three May starts, Winn went 0-3 with an 18.36 ERA (17er, 8.1ip) with five strikeouts and a 2.64 WHIP.
- ▶ Winn relies on his splitter with usage rates of 41.7% this season, and 55.4% in 2023...Texas has done well vs. splitters in 2024, leading the Majors with a .244 batting average, .449 slugging percentage and .734 OPS vs. the pitch.

This Date in Giants History

June 9, 2015 - Chris Heston threw the first no-hitter of the season in his 14th career start in the Giants' 5-0 victory over the Mets. He struck out 11 and walked none, but had three hit batters. It was the fifth no-hitter by a Giants pitcher in seven years.

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 15-day IL earlier today after missing SF's last 20 games with a right forearm strain...Winn, who landed in the IL on May 17, sustained the injury during his last start on May 14 against the Dodgers...he is set to face the Rangers for the first time in his career.

FROM THE TRAINING ROOM: Made one rehab appearance with the Arizona Complex League on Tuesday and worked 3.2 innings out of the 'pen...struck out six in the outing and gave up just one run (solo home run) on two hits with two walks.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third consecutive loss in his last Major League appearance on May 14 against the Dodgers...worked 3.0 hitless innings before giving up four runs on three hits in the 4th inning...exited the game with right forearm tightness before recording an out the 5th inning, eventually surrendering five runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts.

SECOND THOUGHTS: Over his last two MLB starts, Winn has allowed 10 earned runs over 2.2 innings in his second time through the lineup (33.75 ERA)...batters were 9-for-15 with two homers and two walks in those situations...prior to this stretch, the right-hander had not given up a hit in the 4th inning in six starts to begin the year, issuing just one walk with four strikeouts in that inning.

IN THE FAST LANE: Batters are just 4-for-30 (.133) with 11 strikeouts off his four-seam fastball this season...Winn's .133 opposing average with the four-seamer is sixth-lowest in the NL (min. 25 PAs).

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 41.7% of the time this season...15 of his 33 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .239 clip with six extra-base hits...Winn's 41.7% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

KEEP THEM GROUNDED: Winn has been successful at inducing ground balls early in his career...his 55.2% ground ball rate this season is sixth-best in MLB among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings this season and just behind teammate **RHP Logan Webb** (56.6%, 6th).

UNDERLYING DATA: Batters have been hitting the ball hard off Winn this year...his 92.9mph average exit velocity this season is the highest figure in MLB among qualified pitchers...his 50.4% hard hit rate also ranks in the bottom 3% of the league.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties are 14-for-70 (.200) off him this season with 19 strikeouts...however, they are 10-for-their-last-24 with four extra-base hits off him over his last four starts.

DYNAMIC DUO: Winn has a 2.12 ERA in three starts this season with **C Patrick Bailey** behind the plate...he has a 8.88 ERA in his other six starts.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 6/8 at TEX, SV, 1.0ip, h, bb (22 pitches)

- ▶ Converted his 11th save of the season last night...has a save both games of the series.
- ▶ Issued 18 walks in 25.1ip...his 15.4% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Has struck out 31 batters over 25.1 innings of work (11.01 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 17 of his 31 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Lefties are hitting .294 (15-for-51) off him.
- ▶ In 13 non-save situations, he is 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), eight hits allowed (two homers), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

Last Game: 6/5 at ARI; W, 1.1ip, h, r, er, hr, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last four outings, he's thrown 6.2 innings and allowed just one run (solo HR) on two hits with four strikeouts.
- ▶ Has recorded at least five outs in 10 of his 17 games w/SF.
- ▶ Since April 30, Hjelle has a 2.11 ERA (5er, 21.1ip) with 23 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has a 64.4% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 6/4 at ARI; 0.2ip, 4h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed nine runs in 8.2ip over his last nine games.
- ▶ Righties were 4-for-5 off him on Tuesday...they were just 5x35 off him prior to that.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.
- ▶ Lefties are 9-for-27 (.333) off him with six RBI...righties are just 9x40.
- ▶ Has a 10.08 ERA on the road (8.1ip) and a 2.08 ERA at home (8.2ip).
- ▶ Was drafted by the Rangers in the supplemental round (45th overall) in 2010 out of high school...appeared in 15 games for the Rangers at the MLB level between 2015-16 (8.50 ERA) before being dealt to Atlanta following the 2016 season.
