TODAY'S GAME: Is the second of 2 Spring Breakout games featuring prospects from the Reds' minor league system...today's 7-inning Prospect game between the Reds and Guardians at Goodyear Ballpark follows this afternoon's Cactus League game between Cincinnati and Seattle.

THURSDAY'S SPRING BREAKOUT GAME: The Redlegs played their first of 2 Spring Breakout games Thu at Surprise...prospects from the Reds' minor league system defeated prospects from the Rangers' organization, 4-1...**3B Cam Collier** belted a 2-run homer...**SS Carlos Sanchez** had 2 hits and 2 RBI...starter **RHP Julian Aguiar** gave up a run on 4 hits in 3.0 innings to earn the win (1bb, 2k)...**RHP Rhett Lowder** pitched 2.0 hitless innings in relief (2k)...**RHP Hunter Parks** earned the save with 2.0 scoreless innings (1h, 3k).

ABOUT SPRING BREAKOUT: MLB Spring Breakout is a 4-day event (3/14-3/17) showcasing baseball's minor league stars during Spring Training.

- 2024 marks the inaugural edition of the Spring Breakout event.
- Today's game is 1 of 16 Prospect games to be played at Cactus and Grapefruit League stadiums.
- All games will be played between teams comprised of each MLB organization's top prospects.
- The **Reds** and **Cardinals** are the only 2 teams scheduled to play multiple Spring Breakout games.
- Each Spring Breakout game is intended to be 7 innings unless it's not part of a doubleheader and both clubs agree to extend the game to 9 innings (today's game is scheduled for 7 innings).
- There will be no 3-batter minimum for pitchers upon entry into the game.
- If a pitcher is removed from a Spring Breakout game, he may re-enter later.
- Position players will only be permitted to re-enter games in the event of an injury.
- All Spring Breakout games will use a pitch timer...the 2024 Triple-A pitch timer regulations apply.
- All teams will be limited to 7 mound visits per Spring Breakout game.
- The Triple-A baseball will be used in all Spring Breakout games.
- Pitchers and catchers will be permitted to use PitchCom.
- Roster limits consist of a maximum of 27 players and a minimum of 23 players...any player with remaining rookie eligibility is eligible to represent his organization.

ABOUT THE MANAGER: AA-Chattanooga skipper **Jose Moreno** will manage the Reds prospects this afternoon...he'll be accompanied by his Chattanooga coaching staff: **Todd Naskedov** (pitching coach), **Daryle Ward** (hitting coach), **Dick Schofield** (coach), and **Francisco Rodriguez-Castillo** (performance coach).

- Moreno is in his fifth season in the organization and his third at Class AA Chattanooga.
- His 2023 club won the Southern League's North Division first-half championship to qualify for the playoffs for the first time since 2013.
- He spent the 2021 season as manager at Class A Dayton after working in 2020 assigned as manager of the Reds' rookie Arizona League affiliate in Goodyear.
- Prior to joining the Reds, Jose spent 19 years with the Mariners organization, managing at multiple levels (most recently at short-season Class A Everett) and serving as Latin American field coordinator for 4 seasons.
